Psa-40: 4	K/V- 4.	Blessed is that man who <b>makes the Lord his trust</b> , And does not respect the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.
Psa-118: 8-9	K/V- 8. K/V- 9.	<b>8. It is better to trust in the Lord Than to put confidence in man. 9.</b> It is better to trust in the Lord Than to put confidence in princes.
Psa-146: 3-4	K/V- 3.	<b>Do not put your trust in princes, Nor in a son of man</b> , in whom there is no help.
Prov-29: 25-26	K/V- 25. K/V- 26.	<b>25. The fear of man brings a snare</b> , But whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe. <b>26.</b> Many seek the ruler's favor, But justice for man comes from the Lord.
Jer-17: 5-8	K/V- 5.	Thus says the Lord: " <b>Cursed is the man who trusts in man And makes flesh his strength</b> , Whose heart departs from the Lord.
Matt-7: 15-20	K/V- 15. K/V- 16.	<b>15. "Beware of false prophets</b> , who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. <b>16.</b> You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles? ( <u>Matt-24:11.</u> )
Matt-13: 24-30	K/V- 25.	-but while men slept, <b>his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way.</b> ( <u>Matt-13:36-43.</u> ) <b>39. The enemy who sowed them is the devil</b> , the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels.
Matt-16: 6-12	K/V- 12.	Then they understood that He did not tell them to <b>beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees.</b> ( <u>Mark-8:15.</u> ) ( <u>Luke-12:1.</u> )
Matt-24: 24-25	K/V- 24.	<b>For false christs and false prophets</b> will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect. ( <u>Mark-13:22.</u> )
Mark-8: 14-18	K/V- 15.	Then He charged them, saying, "Take heed, <b>beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the leaven of Herod.</b> "
Luke-6: 22-23	K/V- 22.	<b>Blessed are you when men hate you</b> , And when they exclude you, And revile you, and cast out your name as evil, For the Son of Man's sake.
Luke-6: 26-28	K/V- 26.	<b>Woe to you when all men speak well of you</b> , For so did their fathers to the false prophets.
Luke-16: 15-16	K/V- 15.	And He said to them, "You are those who justify yourselves before men, but God knows your hearts. <b>For what is highly esteemed among men is an abomination in the sight of God.</b>
Acts-5: 28-29	K/V- 29.	But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: " <b>We ought to obey God rather than men.</b>
1-Cor-2: 4-5	K/V- 4. K/V- 5.	<b>4. And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom</b> , but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, <b>5.</b> that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.

1-Cor-6: 11-12	K/V- 12.	<b>11.</b> And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God. <b>12.</b> All things are lawful for me, but all things are not helpful. All things are lawful for me, <b>but I will not be brought under the power of any.</b>
1-Cor-7: 20-24	K/V- 23.	You were bought at a price; <b>do not become slaves of men.</b>
2-Cor-11: 12-15	K/V- 13.	<b>For such are false apostles,</b> deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ.
Gal-1: 6-12	K/V- 10:	For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? <b>For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ.</b>
1-Thes-2: 4-5	K/V- 4.	But as we have been approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel, even so we speak, <b>not as pleasing men, but God who tests our hearts.</b>
1-Tim-4: 1-5	K/V- 1.	Now the Spirit expressly says that in <b>latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,</b>
1-Tim-4: 7	K/V- 1.	<b>But reject profane and old wives' fables,</b> and exercise yourself toward godliness.
2-Tim-4: 1-4	K/V- 3.	<b>For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires,</b> because they have itching ears, <b>they will heap up for themselves teachers;</b>
2-Pet-2: 1-2	K/V- 1. K/V- 2.	<b>1. But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you,</b> who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction. <b>2.</b> And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed.
1-John-4: 1-3	K/V- 1.	Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; <b>because many false prophets have gone out into the world.</b>
		<b>Answer to men's problems, Put Jesus first, God sent Him.</b>
Matt-17: 1-9	K/V- 5.	While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, " <b>This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!</b> " (Mark-9:7.) (Luke-9:35.) <b>Hear Him!"</b>
Luke-4: 18-19	K/V- 18. K/V- 19.	<b>18. "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor;</b> He has sent Me to heal the broken-hearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; <b>19.</b> To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."
Luke-6: 46-49	K/V- 46.	<b>"But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say?</b>
John-6: 53-58	K/V- 53.	Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, <b>unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you.</b> (Matt-6:11.) (Lk-11:3.) (Acts-2:46-47.)
John-10: 27	K/V- 27.	<b>My sheep hear My voice,</b> and I know them, and they follow Me. (John-10:3-9.)
		<b>Jesus said I am.</b>
Mark-14: 61-62	K/V- 61. K/V- 62.	<b>61.</b> But He kept silent and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked Him, saying to Him, " <b>Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?" 62. Jesus said, "I am.</b> And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven."
John-6: 48-51	K/V- 51.	<b>I am the living bread</b> which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the

		world."
John-8: 12	K/V- 12.	Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, " <b>I am the light of the world.</b> He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life."
John-8: 58	K/V- 58.	<b>Jesus said to them,</b> "Most assuredly, I say to you, <b>before Abraham was, I AM.</b> "
John-10: 7-9	K/V- 9.	<b>I am the door.</b> If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.
John-10: 11-14	K/V- 11.	<b>I am the good shepherd.</b> The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.
John-11: 25-26	K/V- 25. K/V- 26.	<b>25.</b> Jesus said to her, " <b>I am the resurrection and the life.</b> He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. <b>26.</b> And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?" ( <u>John-8:52.</u> ) Then the Jews said to Him, "Now we know that You have a demon! Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and You say, ' <b>If anyone keeps My word he shall never taste death.</b> '"
John-14: 6	K/V- 6.	<b>Jesus said to him,</b> " <b>I am the way, the truth, and the life.</b> No one comes to the Father except through Me.
John-15: 1-5	K/V- 1. K/V- 2. K/V- 3. K/V- 4. K/V- 5.	<b>1.</b> " <b>I am the true vine,</b> and My Father is the vinedresser. <b>2.</b> Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. <b>3.</b> You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. <b>4.</b> Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. <b>5. I am the vine,</b> you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; <b>for without Me you can do nothing.</b>
