Are you ready to meet Jesus Christ?

(Matt-7:17-23.) 17. Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. 18. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither *can* a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit. 19. Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire. 20. Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them. 21. Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? 23. And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work (iniquity-lawlessness-sin) Comment: These scriptures do not tell you and me that you cannot prophesy, cast out devils, or do many wonderful works in His name. Jesus is saying to us you are doing these things but you are still wilfully sinning and with your sin you can mock God's truth, do not be luke warm. I have noticed that many people use this scripture to say the power of God is not for today, the truth is you could be an unbeliever, have a look at these scriptures.

(Heb-13:8.) Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and for ever.

(2-Tim-3:5.) Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. (Titus-1:15-16.) 15. Unto the pure all things *are* pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving *is* nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled. 16. They profess that they know God; but in works they deny *him*, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

(Heb-13:20.) Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the (everlasting-eternal-covenant,)

(Matt-10:7-8.) 7. And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. 8. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

(Mark-16:15-20.) 15. And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18. They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. 19. So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the

right hand of God. **20.** And they went forth, and preached everywhere, **the Lord working with** *them*, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

(John-14:12.) Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

(John-7:6.) Then Jesus said unto them, My time is not yet come: but your time is always ready.

(Matt-25:1-13.) 1. Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom. 2. And five of them were wise, and five were foolish. 3. They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them: 4. But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. 5. While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept.
6. And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him.
7. Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. 8. And the foolish said unto the wise, Give

us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. **9.** But the wise answered, saying, *Not so;* lest there be not enough for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves. **10.** And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut. **11.** Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us. **12.** But he answered and said, **Verily I say unto you, I know you not. 13.** Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh. **Comment: Watch and Pray.**

(1-Cor-6:9-11.) 9. Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10. Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. 11. And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. Comment: This scripture means when you're washed you become a virgin. Stay clean.

(Luke-14:15-27.) 15. And when one of them that sat at meat with him heard these things, he said unto him, Blessed is he that shall eat bread in the kingdom of God. 16. Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many: **17.** And sent his servant at supper time to say to them that were bidden, Come; for all things are now ready. 18. And they all with one consent began to make excuse. The first said unto him, I have bought a piece of ground, and I must needs go and see it: I pray thee have me excused. 19. And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused. 20. And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come. 21. So that servant came, and shewed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being angry said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind. 22. And the servant said, Lord, it is done as thou hast commanded, and yet there is room. 23. And the lord said unto the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled. 24. For I say unto you, That none of those men which were bidden shall taste of my supper. 25. And there went great multitudes with him: and he turned, and said unto them, 26. If any man come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple. 27. And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

(Matt-24:48-51.) 48. But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; 49. And shall begin to smite his fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; 50. The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for him, and in an hour that he is not aware of, 51. And shall cut him asunder, and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. <u>Comment:</u> Brethren do not Gamble with SALVATION.

(Ephesians-5:25-27.) 25. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; 26. That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, 27. That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. Comment: <u>Are you washed by the word and obeying the word?</u> (Luke-6:46-49.) (John-15:3.) (Hebrews-9:14.) (1-Peter-3:7.)

(Hebrews-9:14-15.) 14. How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? 15. And for this cause he is the mediator of the <u>new testament</u> that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions *that were* under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

<u>(1-Timothy-2:4-5.)</u> 4. Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. 5. For *there is* one God, and **one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;** <u>(Jn-14:14.)</u> If ye shall ask any thing **in my name,** I will do *it.*

(1-Peter-1:13-19.) 13. Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

14. As obedient children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance:
15. But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;
16. Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.
17. And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning *here* in fear:
18. Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, *as* silver and gold, from your vain conversation *received* by tradition from your fathers;
19. But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

(Revelation-21:5-8.) 5. And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. 6. And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. 7. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. 8. But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. Comment: Are you overcoming? (John-16:32-33.) 32. Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me. 33. These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. Comment: If Jesus has overcome the world who do you think we should Follow?

<u>(2-Corinthians-5:10.)</u> For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things *done* in *his* body, according to that he hath done, whether *it be* good or bad. (Matthew-5:8.) Blessed *are* the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

(Matthew-26:28.) For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

(1-John-1:7.) But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

Comment: So to be ready to stand before Jesus Christ we need to believe Him, Follow Him, Obey Him, Love Him, We need to overcome the world, We need to be pure.
