1-Tim-6: 3-6.	KV-4.	3. If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ , and to the doctrine which is according to godliness; 4. He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and (strifes-arguing) of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,
