Matt-7: 28-29.	KV-29.	28. And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine: 29. For he taught them as <i>one</i> having authority, and not as the scribes.
Matt-8: 5-13.	KV-9.	9. For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this <i>man</i> , Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth <i>it</i> . (LK-7:1-9.KV-8.)
Matt-20: 20-28.	KV-25.	25. But Jesus called them <i>unto him</i> , and said, Ye know that the princes of the Gentiles exercise dominion over them, and they that are great exercise authority upon them. 26. But it shall not be so among you: but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister (MK-10:42.) (LK-22:25-27.)
Matt-21: 17-32.	KV-23.	23. And when he was come into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came unto him as he was teaching, and said, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority? (MK-11:28.)
Matt-28: 16-20.	KV-18.	18. And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All (power-authority) is given unto me <u>in heaven and in earth.</u>
Mark-1: 21-27.	KV-27.	27. And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine <i>is</i> this? for with authority commandeth he even the unclean spirits, and they do obey him. (LK-4:33-36.)
Mark-13: 33-37.	KV-34.	34. <i>For the Son of man is</i> as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch. (MK-16:15-20.)
Luke-4: 5-8.	KV-6.	5. And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. 6. And the devil said unto him, All this (power-authority) will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it. 7. If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine. 8. And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
Luke-4: 31-36.	KV-36.	36. And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word <i>is</i> this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.
Luke-9: 1-6.	KV-1.	1. Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases. (LK-14:27.)
Luke-10: 18-20.	KV-19.	18. And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19. Behold, I give unto you (power-authority) to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by

		any means hurt you. 20. Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.
Luke-12: 11-12.	KV-11. KV-12.	11. And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and <i>unto</i> magistrates, and (powers-authorities) take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say: 12. For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.
Luke-19: 11-28.	KV-17.	17. And he said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities.
Luke-20: 1-8.	KV-2.	2. And spake unto him, saying, Tell us, by what authority doest thou these things? or who is he that gave thee this authority? (MT-17:5.) (JN-5:24.)
Luke-20: 19-26.	KV-20.	20. And they watched <i>him</i> , and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves just men that they might take hold of his words, that so they might deliver him unto the power and authority of the governor.
John-5: 25-31.	KV-27.	27. And hath given him <u>authority</u> to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man. (JOHN-5:22.) For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:
John-7: 15-18.	KV-17.	17. If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or <i>whether</i> I speak of (myself. My own authority)
John-12: 46-50. JN-8:28.	KV-49.	46. I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness. 47. And if any man hear my words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. 48. He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day. 49. For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father which sent me, he gave me a (commandment-authority) what I should say, and what I should speak. 50. And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak.
John-16: 13-14.	KV-13.	13. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of (himself-his own authority) but whatsoever he shall hear, <i>that</i> shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. 14. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew <i>it</i> unto you.
John-17: 1-5.	KV-2.	2. As thou hast given him (power-authority) over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.
Acts-1: 7-8.	KV-7.	7. And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own (power-authority) (1-Thes-5:1-5.)
Acts-9: 11-16.	KV-14.	14. And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name.
Acts-26: 10-15.	KV-12.	12. Whereupon as I went to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests,
Rom-13:	KV-1.	1. Let every soul be subject unto the higher (powers-authorities) For there

1-Cor-7: 1-6.	KV-4.	4. The wife hath not (power-authority) of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not (power-authority) of his own body, but the wife.
1-Cor-9: 18.	KV-18.	18. What is my reward then? <i>Verily</i> that, when I preach the gospel, I may make the gospel of Christ without charge, that I abuse not my (power-authority) in the gospel.
1-Cor-11: 8-12.	KV-10.	10. For this cause ought the woman to have (power-authority) on <i>her</i> head because of the angels.
1-Cor-15: 20-26.	KV-24.	24. Then <i>cometh</i> the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father ; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.
2-Cor-10: 7-9.	KV-8.	8. For though I should boast somewhat more of our authority, which the Lord hath given us for edification , and not for your destruction, I should not be ashamed: <u>(2-Cor-13:10.)</u>
2-Thes-3: 7-10.	KV-9.	9. Not because we have not (power-authority) but to make ourselves an ensample unto you to follow us.
1-Tim-2: 1-6.	KV-2.	2. For kings, and <i>for all that are in authority</i> ; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
1-Tim-2: 11-15.	KV-12.	12. But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence. <u>(Gen-3:16.) (1-Cor-14:34-36.)</u>
Titus-2: 11-15.	KV-15.	15. These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee.
Titus-3: 1-3.	KV-1.	1. Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and (powers-authority) to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, 2. To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, <i>but</i> gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men. 3. For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, <i>and</i> hating one another. <u>(Gal-6:9.) (2-Thes-3:13.)</u>
1-Pet-3: 21-22.	KV-22.	22. Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.
2-Pet-2: 9-11.	KV-10.	10. But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise (government-authorities.) Presumptuous <i>are they</i> , self-willed, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.
Jude-1: 5-13.	KV-8.	8. Likewise also these <i>filthy</i> dreamers defile the flesh, despise (dominion-authorities) and speak evil of dignities.
Rev-13: 1-7.	KV-4.	4. And they worshipped the dragon which gave (power-authority) unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who <i>is</i> like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?

Rev-13: 12-13.	KV-12.	12. And he exerciseth all the (power-authority) of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.
Rev-17: 12-15.	KV-12.	12. And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive (power-authority) as kings one hour with the beast.
Rev-18: 1	KV-1.	1. And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great (authority-power;) and the earth was lightened with his glory. 2. And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird. 3. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.
