Matt-8: 5-13.	KV-13.	13. And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.
Matt-9: 27-31.	KV-28. KV-29.	28. And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. 29. Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.
Matt-18: 1-6.	KV-6.	6. But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and <i>that</i> he were drowned in the depth of the sea. (MK-9:42.)
Matt-21: 21-22.	KV-22.	22. And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.
Matt-21: 23-32..	KV-25.	25. The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him? (MK-11:31.) (LK-20-5.)
Matt-24: 23-26.	KV-23.	23. Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not. (MK-13-21.)
Matt-27: 41-44.	KV-42.	42. He saved others; himself he cannot save. If he be the King of Israel, let him now come down from the cross, and we will believe him. (MK-15:32.)
Mark-1: 14-15.	KV-15.	15. And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel. (ROM-11-20-22.) (HEB-3:12.)
Mark-5: 35-43.	KV-36. KV-41.	36. As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe. 41. And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise. (LK-8:50.)
Mark-9: 14-29.	KV-23.	23. Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.
Mark-11: 22-26.	KV-24.	24. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. (JAM-5:15.)
Mark-16: 7-14.	KV-14.	14. Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.
Mark-16: 15-20.	KV-17. KV-18.	17. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18. They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
Luke1: 45-50.	KV-45.	45. And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.
Luke-8: 11-18.	KV-12.	12. Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

Luke-22: 67-71.	KV-67.	67. Art thou the Christ? tell us. And he said unto them, If I tell you, ye will not believe: (John-1:11.)
Luke-24: 25-26.	KV-25. KV-26.	25. Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: 26. Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?
Luke-24: 36-49.	KV.41.	41. And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, he said unto them, Have ye here any meat?
John-1: 6-10.	KV-7.	7. The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe.
John-1: 11-12.	KV-12.	11. He came unto his own, and his own received him not. 12. But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:
John-1: 50-51.	KV-50.	50. Jesus answered and said unto him, Because I said unto thee, I saw thee under the fig tree, believest thou? thou shalt see greater things than these. 51. And he saith unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Hereafter ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man.
John-2: 11-12.	KV-11.	11. This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.
John-3: 14-16.	KV-15.	15. That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life.
John-3: 18-21.	KV-18.	18. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
John-3: 33-36.	KV-36.	36. He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
John-4: 5-42.	KV-21.	21. Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father.
John-4: 46-48.	KV-48.	48. Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.
John-5: 22-27.	KV-24.	24. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

John-6: 47-51.	KV-47.	47. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.
John-6: 68-71.	KV-69.	69. And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.
John-7: 1-5.	KV-5.	5. For neither did his brethren believe in him. <u>(MT-13:57.) (MK-6:4.)</u>
John-7: 30-34.	KV-31.	31. And many of the people believed on him, and said, When Christ cometh, will he do more miracles than these which this <i>man</i> hath done?
John-7: 46-53.	KV-48.	48. Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed on him?
John-8: 20-27.	KV-24.	24. I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am <i>he</i>, ye shall die in your sins. <u>(Acts-4:10-12.)</u>
(John-8: 30-32.	KV-30.	30. As he spake these words, many believed on him.
John-8: 39-47.	KV-45.	45. And because I tell <i>you</i> the truth, ye believe me not. <u>(Galatians-4:16.)</u>
John-9: 1-35.	KV-35.	35. Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the Son of God? <u>(Pool Siloam.)</u>
John-9: 36-41.	KV-38.	38. And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.
John-10: 23-34.	KV-26.	26. But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you. 27. My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:
John-11: 11-15.	KV-15.	15. And I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him. <u>(Lazarus)</u>
John-11: 25-27.	KV-25. KV-26.	25. Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: 26. And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?
John-11: 40-50.	KV-40.	40. Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?
John-12: 33-39.	KV-36.	36. While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. <u>(John-8:12.)</u>
John-12: 41-50.	KV-44.	44. Jesus cried and said, He that believeth on me, believeth not on me, but on him that sent me. <u>(John-8:28-29.)</u>
John-13: 17-20.	KV-19.	19. Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may believe that I am <i>he</i>.
John-14: 1-4.	KV-1.	1. Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. <u>(Deut-18:15-19.) (JN-5:18.) (JN-10:30.) (Phili-2:6.)</u>
John-14: 10-11.	KV-10.	10. Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. <u>(Deut-18:18.) (JN-1:1.) (JN-14:8-9.) (Colo-2:9-10.)</u>

John-14: 12-15.	KV.12.	12. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. (MK-9:23.) (Phili-4:13.) (1-JN-2:6.)
John-16: 7-11.	KV-9.	8. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9. Of sin, because they believe not on me; (JN-8:24.) (Rom-3:21-24.) (Rom-14:23.)
John-16: 22-33.	KV-27.	27. For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God. (JN-17:8.)
John-17: 20-21.	KV-20.	20. Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; (Mat-10:32-33.) (Rom-1:16.) (Rom-10:9-11.)
John-20: 19-31.	KV-29.	29. Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed. (Rom-1:17.)
Acts-2: 38-47.	KV-44.	44. And all that believed were together, and had all things common; (MT-18:19-20.) (Acts-4:32.) (1-Cor-2:16.)
Acts-4: 1-4.	KV-4.	4. Howbeit many of them which heard the word believed; and the number of the men was about five thousand.
Acts-5: 1-16.	KV-14.	14. And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) (After Ananias & Sapphira Died)
Acts-8: 26-40.	KV-37.	37. And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. (A man of Ethiopia.)
Acts-11: 15-18.	KV-17.	16. Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost. 17. Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God?
Acts-11: 20-23.	KV-21.	21. And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and turned unto the Lord. (Acts-14:1.)
Acts-13: 9-12.	KV-12.	12. Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord.
Acts-13: 36-39.	KV-39.	39. And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses.
Acts-13: 46-49.	KV-48.	48. And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.
Acts-15: 5-11.	KV-11.	11. But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they. (Eph-2:8-9.)

Acts-16: 30-35.	KV-31.	31. And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
Acts-17: 10-12.	KV-12.	12. Therefore many of them believed; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few.
Acts-18: 1-8.	KV-8.	8. And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized.
Acts-19: 1-7.	KV-4.	4. Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. (Matt-3:11.)
Acts-19: 13-20.	KV-18.	18. And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds.
Acts-21: 18-25.	KV-25.	25. As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written <i>and</i> concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from <i>things</i> offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication.
Acts-22: 1-30.	KV-19.	19. And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat in every synagogue them that believed on thee:
Acts-27: 1-30.	KV-25.	25. Wherefore, sirs, be of good cheer: for I believe God, that it shall be even as it was told me. (23. An angel spoke to Paul)
Rom-1: 16-17.	KV-16.	16. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.
Rom-3: 21-24.	KV-22.	22. Even the righteousness of God <i>which is</i> by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:
Rom-4: 1-5.	KV-5.	5. But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.
Rom-4: 22-25.	KV-24.	24. But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead;
Rom-6: 7-10.	KV-8.	8. Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: (Rom-6:3-4.)
Rom-9: 25-33.	KV-33.	33. As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.
Rom-10: 1-4.	KV-4.	4. For Christ <i>is</i> the end of the law for righteousness to everyone that believeth. (JN-19:30.) (1-Cor-2:2.)
Rom-10: 8-16.	KV-9.	9. That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt <u>believe in thine heart</u> that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.
Rom-10: 8-11.	KV-11.	11. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

Rom-14: 1-4.	KV-2.	2. For one believeth that he may eat all things: another, who is weak, eateth herbs. (Matt-15:11.) (1-Tim-4:1-6.KV-4.)
Rom-15: 12-14.	KV-13.	13. Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.
1-Cor-1: 18-24.	KV-21.	21. For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. (Matt-11:25.) (1-Cor-1:18.) (1-Cor-1:27.)
1-Co-13: 4-13.	KV-7.	7. (LOVE): Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.
1-Co-15: 1-4.	KV-2.	2. By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. (Hebrews-4:2.)
1-Co-15: 8-21.	KV-11.	11. Therefore whether <i>it were</i> I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed. (Romans-10:17.)
2-Co-4: 1-4.	KV-4.	4. In whom the god of this world hath <u>blinded the minds of them which believe not</u>, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. (John-9:39-41.) 39. And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind. 40. And <i>some</i> of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, Are we blind also? 41. Jesus said unto them, If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth. Comment: If we reject Jesus Christ and His truth we become blind, If we receive Him and His truth we can see clearly. Our spiritual eyes are open.
2-Co-4: 13-15.	KV-13.	13. We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak; (MATT-10:32-33.) (MK-8:38.)
2-Co-6: 14-18.	KV-15.	15. And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? (HEB-3:12.) Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.
Gal-2: 15-16.	KV-16.	16. Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.
Gal-3: 1-9.	KV-6.	6. Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. (MATT-17:5.) Comment: Do you believe God?
Gal-3: 20-29.	KV-22.	22. But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe.
Eph-1: 1-14.	KV-13.	13. In whom ye also <i>trusted</i>, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also <u>after that ye believed</u>, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

Eph-1: 15-23.	KV-19.	19. And what is the exceeding greatness of his <u>power to us-ward who believe</u>, according to the working of his mighty power, (MK-9:23.) (MK-16:16-18.) (1-COR-2:4-5.) (1-COR-4:19-21.)
Phili-1: 27-30.	KV-29.	29. For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake; (GAL-4:29.) (2-TIM-3:12.)
1.Thes-2: 9-20.	KV-13.	13. For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received <i>it</i> not <i>as</i> the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.
1-Thes-4: 13-18.	KV-14.	14. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. (JN-11:25-26.) (ROM-10:9-10.) (1-PET-1:20-25.) (REV-14:13.)
2-Thes-1: 10-12.	KV-10.	10. When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day.
2-Thes-2: 13-14.	KV-13.	13. But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: (JN-15:3.) (JN-6:63.) (1-COR-6:11.)
1-Tim-1: 16-17.	KV-16.	16. Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting. (2-TIM-3:12.)
1-Tim-3: 14-16.	KV-16.	16. And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. (JN-14:21.)
1-Tim-4: 1-12.	KV-10.	10. For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe.
Titus-3: 8-11.	KV-8.	8. <i>This is</i> a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men.
Heb-4: 1-6.	KV-2. KV-3.	2. For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard <i>it</i>. 3. For we which have believed do enter into rest , as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.
Heb-10: 35-39.	KV-39.	39. But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.
Heb-11: 6.	KV-6.	6. But without faith <i>it is</i> impossible to please <i>him</i>: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and <i>that</i> he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
James-2: 19-26.	KV-19.	19. Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

1-Pet-1: 8.	KV-8.	8. Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see <i>him</i> not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:
1-Pet-1: 20-23.	KV-21.	21. Who by him do believe in God , that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.
1-Pet-2: 1-8.	KV-7.	7. Unto you therefore which believe <i>he is precious</i>: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner,
1-John-3: 21-24.	KV-23.	23. And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.
1-John-4: 15-19.	KV-16.	16. And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.
1-John-5: 1-5.	KV-1.	1. Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.
