Matt-13: 57-58.	KV-58.	57. And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, save in his own country, and in his own house. 58. And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.
Matt-14: 22-33.	KV-31.	30. But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. 31. And immediately Jesus stretched forth <i>his</i> hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt? <u>Comment: Believe Jesus Words.</u>
Matt-17: 14-21.	KV-20.	20. And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. 21. Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting. (<u>ISA-58:6-11.</u>) (<u>EPH-6:18.</u>) (<u>JAM-1:5-7.</u>)
Matt-21: 18-22.	KV-21.	21. Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and (doubt-unbelief) not, ye shall not only do this <i>which is done</i> to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. 22. And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.
Matt-28: 16-20.	KV-17.	17. And when they saw him, they worshipped him: but some doubted. (<u>JOHN-14:23.</u>)
Mark-6: 1-6.	KV-6.	6. And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching.
Mark-9: 16-29.	KV-24.	24. And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief. <u>Comment: Fast from the world.</u>
Mark-11: 12-14. 19-26.	KV-23.	23. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall (not doubt in his heart,) but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
Mark-16: 14-20.	KV-16.	14. Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen. 15. And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every

		creature. 16. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
John-3: 33-36.	KV-36.	36. He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
John-4: 47-54.	KV-48.	48. Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.
John-5: 36-41.	KV-38.	38. And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not.
John-6: 35-37.	KV-36.	36. But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not. (JN-14:9.)
John-6: 53-71.	KV-64.	63. It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, <i>they</i> are spirit, and <i>they</i> are life. 64. But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him.
John-7: 1-8.	KV-5.	5. For neither did his brethren believe in him. 6. Then Jesus said unto them, My time is not yet come: but your time is always ready. 7. The world cannot hate you; but me it hateth, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil.
John-8: 23-27.	KV-24.	23. And he said unto them, Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world. 24. I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am <i>he</i>, ye shall die in your sins.
John-8: 42-47.	KV-45.	43. Why do ye not understand my speech? <i>even</i> because ye cannot hear my word. 44. Ye are of <i>your</i> father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. 45. And because I tell <i>you</i> the truth, ye believe me not.
John-10: 25-28.	KV-26.	25. Jesus answered them, I told you, and ye believed not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me. 26. But ye believe not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you.
Rom-4: 17-22.	KV-20.	20. He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;
Rom-11: 16-23.	KV-20.	20. Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear:
Rom-11: 29-32.	KV-30.	30. For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief:
Rom-14: 20-23.	KV-23.	23. And he that (doubteth-unbelief) is damned if he eat, because <i>he eateth</i> not of faith: for whatsoever <i>is</i> not of faith is sin. (1-Cor-11:29-32.)

2-Cor-6: 14-18.	KV-14.	14. Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? 15. And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? <u>(1-Corinthians-5:8-13.) (2-Corinthians-6:17-18.)</u>
2-Thes-2: 9-14.	KV-12.	11. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: 12. That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
1-Tim-1: 12-14.	KV-13.	13. Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did <i>it</i> ignorantly in unbelief.
2-Tim-3: 1-5.	KV-5.	5. Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. <u>Comment:</u> Many have unbelief in the power of God today.
Heb-3: 7-14.	KV-12.	12. Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.
Heb-3: 15-19.	KV-18. KV-19.	18. And to whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that believed not? 19. So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.
Heb-4: 1-6.	KV-2. KV-6.	2. For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard <i>it</i>. (Heb-4:6.) 6. Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in because of unbelief: <u>Comment:</u> Many hear the Gospel but don't believe it.
Heb-4: 9-13.	KV-11.	11. Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.
Jude-1: 1-5.	KV-5.	4. For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into (lasciviousness,-Greek: unbridled lust) and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ. 5. I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not. <u>Comment: (John-15:19.) (John-17:16.)</u> Have you and I been called out of the (world-Egypt) yet if we don't believe Jesus we go back to the world.
Rev-21: 7-8.	KV-8.	7. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. 8. But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
Matt-13: 24-26.	KV-25.	24. Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field: 25. But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and

		went his way. 26. But when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then appeared the tares also.
Matt-16: 6-12.	KV-6.	6. Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the (leaven-Doctrine) of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees. (MK-8:15.)
Matt-24: 4-5.	KV-5.	4. And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. 5. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.
Luke-6: 46-49.	KV-46.	46. And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?
Rom-8: 12-16.	KV-14.	14. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
Heb-11: 6.	KV-6.	6. But without faith <i>it is</i> impossible to please <i>him</i> : for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and <i>that</i> he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
Heb-13:	KV-8.	8. Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and for ever.
1-John-2: 6.	KV-6.	6. He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked. <u>(John-15:1-10.)</u>
