Rom-5: 8-11	K/V- 9.	Much more then, <b>having now been justified by His blood</b> , we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
1-Cor- 10.	K/V- 16.	The cup of blessing which we bless, <b>is it not the communion of the blood of Christ?</b> The

Heb-10: 28-31	K/V- 29.	Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?
Heb-12: 22-29	K/V- 24.	To Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.
Heb-13: 10-12	K/V- 12.	Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate.
Heb-13: 20-21	K/V- 20.	Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, <b>through the blood of the everlasting covenant.</b>
1-Pet-1: 1-3	K/V- 2.	Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in Sanctification of the Spirit, <b>for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ.</b> (Titus-3:5.)
1-Pet-1: 18-20	K/V- 19.	But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish or spot. (Heb-4:15.)
1-John-1: 7-10	K/V-7.	But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have <b>fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.</b>
1-John-5: 6-8	K/V- 6.	This is He who came by <b>water and blood,</b> Jesus Christ; not only by water, but by <b>water and blood.</b> And it is the Spirit who bears witness, because the Spirit is truth.  (John-15:26-27.)
Rev-5: 8-10	K/V- 9.	And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, <b>And have redeemed us to God by Your blood.</b> Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,
Rev-6: 9-11	K/V- 10.	And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

Rev-11: 3-6	K/V- 6.	These have power to shut heaven, so that no rain falls in the days of their prophecy; and they have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to strike the earth with plagues, as often as they desire
Rev-12: 10-12	K/V-11.	"And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death. (1-Cor-1:6.) (1-Jn-5:11.) (Rev-1:2.) (Rev-1:9.) (Rev-12:17.) (Rev-19:10.)
Rev-16: 3	K/V- 3.	Then the second angel poured out his <b>bowl on the sea, and it became blood as of a dead man;</b> and every living creature in the sea died.
Rev-16: 4-6	K/V-4.	Then the third angel poured out his <b>bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became blood.</b>
Rev-17: 5-7	K/V- 6.	I saw the woman, <b>drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus.</b> And when I saw her, I marveled with great amazement. (Rev-18:24.)

Rev-19: 1-2	K/V- 2.	"For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her."
