

Brothers & Sisters Do You Love One Another

Matt-5:43-48	K/V. 44,46	<p>43 Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy. 44 <u>But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;</u> 45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust. 46 <u>For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same?</u> 47 And if ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more than others? do not even the publicans so? 48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect. (Luke-6:27-36). Comment: Jesus tells us to love our enemies, you do this by telling them the truth.</p>
Matt-6:24	K/V.24	<p>24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. (Greek: Mammon- Treasure, Riches, Opposed to God.). Comment: Do not put money and riches before God.</p>
Matt-10:34-39	K/V.37	<p>34 Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. 35 For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. 36 And a man's foes shall be they of his own household. 37 <u>He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.</u> 38 And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. 39 He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it. (Luke-14:25-27.). Comment: When we love Jesus Christ first in our lives it's the greatest love for all that knows you. They get saved.</p>
Matt-19:17-19	K/V.19	<p>17 And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. 18 He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, 19 <u>Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.</u> (Mark-10:17-27.) Comment: Jesus truth is the greatest honour.</p>
Matt-22:36-40	K/V.36	<p>36 <u>Master, which is the great commandment in the law?</u> 37 <u>Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.</u> 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like unto it, <u>Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.</u> 40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. Comment: Love God first and your neighbours can be saved, for they see the light. (Mark-10:21.) (Mark-12:29-31.) (Luke-10:27.)</p>
Luke-7:36-50	K/V.47	<p>36 And one of the Pharisees desired him that he would eat with him. And he went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat. 37 And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that Jesus sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment, 38 And stood at his feet behind him weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe them with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed them with the ointment. 39 Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw it, he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman this is that toucheth him: for she is a sinner. 40 And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on. 41 There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty. 42 And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most? 43 Simon answered and said, I suppose that he, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged. 44 And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head. 45 Thou gavest me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet. 46 My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed my feet with ointment. 47 <u>Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.</u> 48 And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven. 49 And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also? 50 And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace. Comment: Do you love Jesus more than your sins?</p>

Luke-11:	K/V.42	42 But woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and <u>pass over judgment and the love of God</u> : these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone. 43 Woe unto you, Pharisees! for ye love the uppermost seats in the synagogues, and greetings in the markets. Comment: Don't forget the love of God. No one can do for you and me what He done for us, He died for you and me. And no one can offer you what He offers us. He offers you and me eternal life.
John-8:42	K/V.42	42 Jesus said unto them, <u>If God were your Father, ye would love me</u> : for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.
John-13:34-35	K/V.34	34 <u>A new commandment I give unto you. That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.</u> 35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
John-14:15-16	K/V.15	15 <u>If ye love me, keep my commandments.</u> 16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;
John-14:23-24	K/V.23	23 <u>Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.</u> 24 He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.
John-15:9-10	K/V.9-10	<u>9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. 10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.</u>
John-17:12-14	K/V.12	12 <u>While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled. 13 And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.</u> 14 I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
John-17:25-26	K/V.26	25 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. 26 <u>And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.</u>
Rom-5:5-6	K/V.5	5 <u>And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.</u> 6 For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
Rom-12:9-10	K/V.9	9 <u>Let love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good.</u> 10 Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another;
1-Cor-2:9-10	K/V.9	9 <u>But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.</u> 10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.
2-Cor-13:11-14	K/V.11	11 <u>Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.</u> 12 Greet one another with an holy kiss. 13 All the saints salute you. 14 <u>The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God</u> , and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen.
Eph-1:3-4	K/V.4	3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: 4 <u>According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:</u>
Eph-3:14-17	K/V.17	14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, 16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; 17 <u>That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,</u>
Eph-4:2-5	K/V.2	2 <u>With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love:</u> 3 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. 4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; 5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism,
Eph-4:15-16	K/V.15	15 <u>But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:</u> 16 From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

Eph-5:1-2	K/V.2	1 Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; 2 <u>And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.</u>
Eph-6:23-24	K/V.23	23 <u>Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.</u> 24 Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.
Colo-1:3-4	K/V.4	3 We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, 4 <u>Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints,</u>
Colo-2:2-3	K/V.2	2 <u>That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;</u> 3 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
Colo-3:12-15	K/V.14	12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; 13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. 14 <u>And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.</u> 15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.
1-Tim-1:5	K/V.5	<u>5 Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:</u>
2-Tim-2:22-24	K/V.22	<u>22. Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.</u> 23. But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes. 24. And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all <i>men</i> , apt to teach, patient,
Heb-10:24-25	K/V.24	<u>24. And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:</u> 25. Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some <i>is</i> ; but exhorting <i>one another</i> : and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.
Heb-13:1-2	K/V.1	1. <u>Let brotherly love continue.</u> 2. Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.
Jam-2:8	K/V.8	<u>8. If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:</u>
1-Pet-1:22-23	K/V.22	<u>22. Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:</u> 23. Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
1-Pet-2:17-18	K/V.17	17. <u>Honour all men. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honour the king.</u> 18. Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward.
1-Pet-4:8-9	K/V.8	<u>8. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves:</u> for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. 9. Use hospitality one to another without grudging.
1-Pet-5:14	K/V.14	<u>14. Greet ye one another with a kiss of charity.</u> Peace <i>be</i> with you all that are in Christ Jesus. Amen.
1-John-2:5-6	K/V.5	<u>5. But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.</u> 6. He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.
1-John-4:7-8	K/V.7	<u>7. Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God.</u> 8. He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.
1-John-4:11-13	K/V.11	<u>11. Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.</u> 12. No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us. <u>13.</u> Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit.
Jude-1:1-2	K/V.2	1. Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, <i>and</i> called: 2. <u>Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied.</u>
Jude-1:20-21	K/V.20-21	<u>20. But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, 21. Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.</u>
Rev-2:4	K/V.4	4. Nevertheless I have <i>somewhat</i> against thee, because <u>thou hast left thy first love.</u>
Rev-3:19-20	K/V.19	<u>19. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.</u> 20. Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.
Rev-12:11	K/V.11	<u>11. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony: and they loved not their lives unto the death.</u>
