Isa-41: 4-6	K/V- 4.	Who has performed and done it, Calling the generations from the beginning? ‘I, the Lord, am the first; And with the last I am He. <u>(Lk-1:50.) (Rev-1:8.) (Rev-1:11.) (Rev-1:17-18.)</u> <b>(The red writing is Jesus speaking.)</b>
Matt-1: 18-19	K/V-18. Lk-1:35.	Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, <b>she was found with child of the Holy Spirit.</b>
Matt-1: 22-23	K/V- 23.	“Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear <b>a Son</b> , and they shall call <b>His name Immanuel</b> ,” which is translated, <b>“God with us.”</b> ( <b>Immanuel: God with us.”</b> )

Matt-14: 31-33	K/V- 33.	Then those who were in the boat came and <b>worshiped Him</b> , saying, “ <b>Truly You are the Son of God.</b> ”

( <u>John-13:13.</u> ) You call Me teacher and Lord, ( <u>John-14:26.</u> ) Holy Spirit He will teach you all things. John-17: 1-5	K/V- 5.	"And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, <b>with the glory which I had with You before the world was.</b> <u>(Did you see that: before the world was?)</u>
John-18: 36-37	K/V- 36.	Jesus answered, " <b>My kingdom is not of this world</b> , If My kingdom were of this world, My servants would fight, so that I should not be delivered to the Jews; but now My kingdom is not from here." <u>(This is Jesus speaking.)</u>

But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to <b>lie to the Holy Spirit</b> and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself? <sup>4</sup> . Why have you conceived this thing in your heart? <b>You have not lied to men but to God.</b> " <u>(Did you notice that Peter called the Holy Spirit God.)</u>
Acts-7: 55-60	K/V- 59.	And they stoned Stephen as <b>He was calling on God and saying, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit."</b> <u>(Did you see who Stephen called God?)</u>
Acts-10: 34-42	K/V- 36.	"The word which God sent to the children of Israel, <b>preaching peace through Jesus Christ- He is Lord of all-</b> <u>(Rom-3:21-24.<sup>22</sup>.)</u>
Rom-6: 22-23	K/V- 23.	For the wages of sin is death, <b>but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.</b>
Rom-8: 37-39	K/V- 39.	-nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the <b>love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.</b>
1-Cor-1: 9-10	K/V- 9.	<b>God is faithful</b> , by whom you were called into the <b>fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.</b> <u>(1-John-1:3.)</u>

2-Pet-1: 16-17	K/V- 17.	For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: " <b>This is My beloved Son</b> , in whom I am well pleased."
1-John-1: 1-3	K/V- 3.	-that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; <b>and truly our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ.</b>
1-John-2: 18-19	K/V- 18.	Little children, it is the last hour; and as you have heard that the Antichrist is coming, <b>even now many antichrists have come</b> , by which we know that it is the last hour.
1-John-2: 21-22	K/V- 22.	<b>Who is a liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son. Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either;</b> he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also.
1-John-2: 23-24	K/V- 23.	<b><u>Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either;</u></b> he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also.
1-John-3: 8-11	K/V- 8.	He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the <b>Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.</b>

1-John-5: 1-4	K/V- 1.	<b>Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God</b> , and everyone who loves Him who begot also loves him who is begotten of Him.
1-John-5: 5-10	K/V- 5.	<b>Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that <u>Jesus is the Son of God?</u></b>
1-John-5: 7-9	K/V- 7. K/V- 8.	<sup>7</sup> <b>For there are three</b> that bear witness in heaven: the <b>Father</b> , the <b>Word</b> , and the <b>Holy Spirit</b> ; and <b>these three are one.</b> <sup>8</sup> <b>And there are three</b> that bear witness on earth: the <b>Spirit</b> , the <b>water</b> , and the <b>blood</b> ; and <b>these three agree as one.</b> <sup>9</sup> If we receive the witness of men, <b>the witness of God is greater</b> ; for this is <b>the witness of God which He has testified of His Son.</b>
1-John-5: 10-13	K/V- 12.	<b>He who has the Son has life</b> ; he who <b>does not have the Son of God does not have life.</b> (John-3:36.)
1-John-5: 18-21	K/V- 20.	And we know that the Son of God has come and has given us an understanding, that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, <b>in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.</b>
2-John-1: 7	K/V- 7.	<b>For many deceivers have gone out into the world who do not confess Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.</b> (Gal-4:6.) (Heb-13:8.)
2-John-1: 9-11	K/V- 9	Whoever transgresses and <b>does not abide in the doctrine of Christ does not have God. He who abides in the doctrine of Christ has both the Father and the Son.</b>
Rev-1: 7-8	K/V- 8.	"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty." (Rev-1:11.) <b>(Oops- Red writing? Jesus calls Himself the Almighty.)</b>
Rev-4: 8	K/V- 8.	The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: " <b>Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!</b> " (Heb-13:8.) (Rev-11:17.)
Rev-5: 13-14	K/V- 13. K/V- 14.	<sup>13</sup> And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: " <b>Blessing and honor and glory and power Be to Him who sits on the throne, And to the Lamb, forever and ever!</b> " <sup>14</sup> Then the four living creatures said, "Amen!" <b>And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever.</b> (Rev-7:9-12. <sup>10</sup> )
