

Commandments

Exod-20:1-3	K/V- 3.	1 And God spake all these words, saying, 2 I am the LORD thy God, which have brought thee out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage. 3 Thou shalt have <u>no other gods before me.</u> (Deut-5:6-7.)
Exod-20:4-6	K/V- 4.	4 <u>Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image,</u> or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: 5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; 6 And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. (Deut-5:8-10.)
Exod-20:7	K/V- 7.	7 <u>Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain;</u> for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. (Deut-5:11.)
Exod-20:8-11	K/V- 8.	8 Remember the <u>sabbath day, to keep it holy.</u> 9 Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: 10 But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates: 11 For in six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them is, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it. (Deut-5:12-15.)
Exod-20:12	K/V- 12.	12 <u>Honour thy father and thy mother:</u> that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. (Deut-5:16.)
Exod-20:13	K/V- 13.	<u>13 Thou shalt not kill.</u> (Deut-5:17.)
Exod-20:14	K/V- 14.	14 <u>Thou shalt not commit adultery.</u> (Deut-5:18.)
Exod-20:15	K/V- 15.	15 <u>Thou shalt not steal.</u> (Deut-5:19.)
Exod-20:16	K/V- 16.	16 <u>Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.</u> (Deut-5:20.)
Exod-20:17	K/V- 17.	17 Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, <u>nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.</u>
Lev-19:16-18	K/V- 18.	16 Thou shalt not go up and down as a talebearer among thy people: neither shalt thou stand against the blood of thy neighbour: I am the LORD. 17 Thou shalt not hate thy brother in thine heart: thou shalt in any wise rebuke thy neighbour, and not suffer sin upon him. 18 <u>Thou shalt not avenge,</u> nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, <u>but thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself:</u> I am the LORD.
Deut-6:4-6	K/V- 5.	4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: 5 <u>And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.</u> 6 And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart:
Matt-5:17-20	K/V- 17.	17 <u>Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets:</u> I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. 18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. 19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven. 20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven. (John-19:30.) "It is finished!"

Matt-15:1-6	K/V- 3.	<p>1 Then came to Jesus scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying,</p> <p>2 Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread.</p> <p>3 But he answered and said unto them, <u>Why do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition?</u></p> <p>4 For God commanded, saying, Honour thy father and mother: and, He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death.</p> <p>5 But ye say, Whosoever shall say to his father or his mother, It is a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me;</p> <p>6 And honour not his father or his mother, he shall be free. Thus have ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition. (Exod-20:12.) (Eph-6:1-2.)</p>
Matt-15:7-9	K/V- 9.	<p>7 Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying,</p> <p>8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.</p> <p>9 <u>But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.</u></p>
Matt-19:16-21	K/V- 17.	<p>16 And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?</p> <p>17 And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: <u>but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.</u></p> <p>18 He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness,</p> <p>19 Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.</p> <p>20 The young man saith unto him, All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet?</p> <p>21 Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me. (Mk-10:17-21.) (Lk-18:18-22.)</p>
Matt-22:34-40	K/V- 40.	<p>34 But when the Pharisees had heard that he had put the Sadducees to silence, they were gathered together.</p> <p>35 Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying,</p> <p>36 Master, which is the great commandment in the law?</p> <p>37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.</p> <p>38 This is the first and great commandment.</p> <p>39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.</p> <p>40 <u>On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.</u> (Lev-19:18.) (Deut-6:5-6.) (Mk-12:28-31.) (Rom-13:9.)</p>
John-13:34-35	K/V- 34.	<p>34 <u>A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.</u></p> <p>35 By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another. (1-John-4:7-13.) (1-John-4:20-21.)</p>
John-14:15-18	K/V- 15.	<p>15 <u>If ye love me, keep my commandments.</u></p> <p>16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;</p> <p>17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.</p> <p>18 I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. (1-John-2:4.)</p>
John-14:20-21	K/V- 21.	<p>20 At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.</p> <p>21 <u>He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me:</u> and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. (Matt-5:8.) (John-14:22-24.)</p>
John-15:9-11	K/V- 10.	<p>9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.</p> <p>10 <u>If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love;</u> even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.</p> <p>11 These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.</p>

John-15:12-17	K/V- 14.	<p>12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.</p> <p>13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.</p> <p>14 <u>Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.</u></p> <p>15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.</p> <p>16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.</p> <p>17 These things I command you, that ye love one another.</p>
Acts-1:1-5	K/V- 2.	<p>1 The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,</p> <p>2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that <u>he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:</u></p> <p>3 To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God:</p> <p>4 And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.</p> <p>5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.</p>
Acts-15:21-26	K/V- 24.	<p>21 For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day.</p> <p>22 Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; namely, Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:</p> <p>23 And they wrote letters by them after this manner; The apostles and elders and brethren send greeting unto the brethren which are of the Gentiles in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia:</p> <p>24 <u>Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment:</u></p> <p>25 It seemed good unto us, being assembled with one accord, to send chosen men unto you with our beloved Barnabas and Paul,</p> <p>26 Men that have hazarded their lives for the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.</p> <p>(Rom-7:4.) (1-Cor-2:2.) (2-Cor-3:6.) (Gal-5:4.)</p>
Rom-7:7-11	K/V- 8.	<p>7 What shall we say then? Is the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet.</p> <p>8 <u>But sin, taking occasion by the commandment,</u> wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin was dead.</p> <p>9 For I was alive without the law once: but when the commandment came, sin revived, and I died.</p> <p>10 And the commandment, which was ordained to life, I found to be unto death.</p> <p>11 For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me.</p> <p>(Rom-3:4.) (Rom-3:10.) (Rom-3:19.) (Rom-7:10.)</p>
Rom-16:24-27	K/V- 26.	<p>24 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.</p> <p>25 Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,</p> <p>26 But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the <u>commandment of the everlasting God,</u> made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:</p> <p>27 To God only wise, be glory through Jesus Christ for ever. Amen.</p>

2-Cor-3:1-6	K/V- 3.	<p>1 Do we begin again to commend ourselves? or need we, as some others, epistles of commendation to you, or letters of commendation from you?</p> <p>2 Ye are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men:</p> <p>3 Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, <u>written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.</u></p> <p>4 And such trust have we through Christ to God-ward:</p> <p>5 Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;</p> <p>6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life. (Gal-4:6.)</p>
Gal-3:10-14	K/V- 10.	<p>10 <u>For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse:</u> for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.</p> <p>11 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith.</p> <p>12 And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them.</p> <p>13 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:</p> <p>14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.</p>
Eph-2:14-17	K/V- 15.	<p>14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;</p> <p>15 <u>Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances;</u> for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;</p> <p>16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:</p> <p>17 And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh. (1-Cor-2:2.)</p>
Eph-6:1-3	K/V- 2.	<p>1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.</p> <p>2 <u>Honour thy father and mother;</u> (which is the first commandment with promise;)</p> <p>3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.</p>
Colo-2:13-17	K/V- 14.	<p>13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;</p> <p>14 <u>Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us,</u> which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;</p> <p>15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.</p> <p>16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days:</p> <p>17 Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ.</p>
Colo-2:20-23	K/V- 22.	<p>20 Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances,</p> <p>21 (Touch not; taste not; handle not;</p> <p>22 Which all are to perish with the using;) <u>after the commandments and doctrines of men?</u></p> <p>23 Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh. (Titus-1:12-16.14.)</p>

1-Tim-1:1-8	K/V- 5.	<p>1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our hope;</p> <p>2 Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.</p> <p>3 As I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that thou mightest charge some that they teach no other doctrine,</p> <p>4 Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.</p> <p>5 <u>Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart,</u> and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:</p> <p>6 From which some having swerved have turned aside unto vain jangling;</p> <p>7 Desiring to be teachers of the law; understanding neither what they say, nor whereof they affirm.</p> <p>8 But we know that the law is good, if a man use it lawfully;</p>
Heb-8:6-13	K/V- 6.	<p>6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the <u>mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.</u></p> <p>7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.</p> <p>8 For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:</p> <p>9 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.</p> <p>10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:</p> <p>11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.</p> <p>12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.</p> <p>13 In that he saith, A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.</p>
Heb-8:12-13	K/V- 13.	<p>12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.</p> <p>13 In that he saith, <u>A new covenant, he hath made the first old.</u> Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.</p>
2-Pet-2:19-22	K/V- 21.	<p>19 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.</p> <p>20 For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.</p> <p>21 For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, <u>to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them.</u></p> <p>22 But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.</p>
1-John-2:3-8	K/V- 4.	<p>3 And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.</p> <p>4 <u>He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.</u></p> <p>5 But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.</p> <p>6 He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.</p> <p>7 Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning.</p> <p>8 Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth.</p>

1-John-3:21-24	K/V- 22.	<p>21 Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God.</p> <p>22 <u>And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.</u></p> <p>23 And this is his commandment, That we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment.</p> <p>24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.</p>
1-John-4:20-21	K/V- 21.	<p>20 If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?</p> <p>21 <u>And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.</u></p>
1-John-5:1-5	K/V- 2.	<p>1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.</p> <p>2 <u>By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.</u></p> <p>3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.</p> <p>4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.</p> <p>5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?</p>
Rev-12:17	K/V- 17.	<p>17 And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, <u>which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.</u></p>
Rev-14:12-13	K/V- 12.	<p>12 Here is the patience of the saints: <u>here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.</u></p> <p>13 And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them.</p>
Rev-22:12-14	K/V- 14.	<p>12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.</p> <p>13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.</p> <p>14 <u>Blessed are they that do his commandments,</u> that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.</p>
Deut-18:15-19	K/V- 19.	<p>15 The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;</p> <p>16 According to all that thou desiredst of the LORD thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not.</p> <p>17 And the LORD said unto me, They have well spoken that which they have spoken.</p> <p>18 I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.</p> <p>19 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which <u>he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.</u></p> <p><u>(John-5:46-47.) (John-14:10-11.) (Acts-3:19-23.23.)</u></p>
