John-5:17-18	KV- 18.	(Partner) 17 But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.  18 Therefore the Jews sought the more to kill him, because he not only had broken the sabbath, but said also that God was his Father, making himself equal with God.  Connecting Scriptures: (Phi 2:5-6) (John14:12-15) (John 17:23) (1 John 2:6).  Question: Are you a partner of God and walking as He walked?
Luke-6:46-49	KV-46.	(Participation) 46 And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?  47 Whosoever cometh to me, and heareth my sayings, and doeth them, I will shew you to whom he is like:  48 He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock.  49 But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.  Connecting Scriptures: (Matthew 12:50) (John 4:34) (James 1:22) (Matthew 4:19).  Comment: Brethren we need to walk with Jesus and the Father in the gospel, the works of grace through faith.
1-Thes-5:17-19	KV- 17.	(Communicate) 17 Pray without ceasing.  18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.  19 Quench not the Spirit.  Connecting Scriptures: (Romans 8:26-27) (2 Cor 13:4) (1 Peter 3:12-13).  Comment: First of all before we communicate With people we should commune with the Holy Spirit, then we communicate with people.
Rom-12:11-21	KV-20.	(Distribution) 11 Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; 12 Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; 13 Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality. 14 Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not. 15 Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep. 16 Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits. 17 Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men. 18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men. 19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord. 20 Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head. 21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good. Connecting Scriptures: (John 6:11) (Acts 4:34-35) (Luke 22:27). Comment: Brethren the Lord Jesus supplies our needs and He expects us to do the same serve each other with a pure heart. Remember they need to hear the gospel of Jesus Christ.

1-John-1:1-7	KV-3.	(Fellowship) 1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;  2 (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)  3 That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.  4 And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.  5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.  6 If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:  7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.  Connecting Scriptures: (Acts 2:40-44) (2 Cor 8:4-5) (Phil 2:1-2) (Hebrews 10:23-25)  Comment: Brethren there is no excuse for us not to fellowship it's Biblical, even if we do it by phone, by computer, by revelation, by love.
Rom-12:15-16	KV-16.	(Associate) 15 Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.  16 Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.  Connecting Scriptures: (1 Cor 3:18-19) (James 4:6-8) (James 4:10) (2 Cor 6:14-18)  Comment: Associate with those of low esteem, Ask for Godly wisdom.
1-Cor-9:13-14	KV-13.	(Partakers) 13 Do ye not know that they which minister about holy things live of the things of the temple? and they which wait at the altar are partakers with the altar?  14 Even so hath the Lord ordained that they which preach the gospel should live of the gospel.  Connecting Scriptures: 1 Cor 10:16-17) (Eph 3:5-6) (Col 1:12-13) (Heb 3:1)(2 Peter 1:4)  Comment: Brethren it is such a great honour to be partakers of the body of Jesus Christ.  Don't put anyone or thing before Him.
Matt-26:26-28	KV-28.	26 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, Take, eat; this is my body.  27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, Drink ye all of it;  28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.  Connecting Scriptures: Mark-14:22-24.) (Luke-22:17.) (1-Cor-11:23-31.)  Question: Could unworthy mean knowing the truth but not obeying it?

Luke-24:34-36	KV-35.	34 Saying, The Lord is risen indeed, and hath appeared to Simon. 35 And they told what things were done in the way, and how he was known of them in breaking of bread. 36 And as they thus spake, Jesus himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you.  Connecting Scriptures: (Matthew 6:9-14) (Luke 11:3)  Comment: Eat your daily bread then share it.
John-4:30-35	KV-34.	30 Then they went out of the city, and came unto him. 31 In the mean while his disciples prayed him, saying, Master, eat. 32 But he said unto them, I have meat to eat that ye know not of. 33 Therefore said the disciples one to another, Hath any man brought him ought to eat? 34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work. 35 Say not ye, There are yet four months, and then cometh harvest? behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest. Connecting Scriptures: (Luke6:46) (James 1:22). Comment: Communion is to obey Jesus Christ to eat His bread is to do What He does.

John-6:32-40	KV-32,35	32 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven.  33 For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.  34 Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread.  35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.  36 But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not.  37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.  38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.  39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.  40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.  Comment: Jesus is the TRUE BREAD from heaven.
John-6:47-64	KV-48.	47 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. 48 <u>I am that bread of life.</u> 49 Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. 50 This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. 51 <u>I am the living bread</u> which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world. 52 The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us his flesh to eat? 53 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. 54 Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. 55 For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. 56 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. 57 As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. 58 This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever. 59 These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum. 60 Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard this, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it? 61 When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you? 62 What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before? 63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life. 64 But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him.  Comment: Believe Jesus Do as He Does.
Acts-2:42-44	KV-42.	42 And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.  43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.  44 And all that believed were together, and had all things common;  Connecting Scriptures: (1 John 1:7)  Comment: Fellowship - Breaking bread and prayers.
1-Cor-1:7-10	KV-9.	7 So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ: 8 Who shall also confirm you unto the end, that ye may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. 10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. Connecting Scriptures: (Eph 3:19) (Eph 4:13) (1 John 2:6) Comment: So you don't need to come short in any gift. God wants us to come to the fulness of God.
