| Matt-6:9-13 | K/V.11 | <p>9. After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. 10. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as <i>it is</i> in heaven. 11. Give us this day our <u>daily bread</u>. 12. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 13. | Matt-26:54-56 | K/V.55 | <p>54. But how then shall the scriptures be fulfilled, that thus it must be? 55. In that same hour said Jesus to the multitudes, Are ye come out as against a thief with swords and staves for to take me? I sat <u>daily with you teaching in the temple</u>, and ye laid no hold on me. 56. But all this was done, that the scriptures of the prophets might be fulfilled. | Luke-9:23-26 | K/V.23 | <p>23. And he said to <i>them</i> all, If any <i>man</i> will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross <u>daily</u>, and follow me. 24. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it. 25. For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away? 26. For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and <i>in his</i> Father's, and of the holy angels.</p> |
| Luke-19:47-48 | K/V.47 | <p>47. And he taught <u>daily in the temple.</u> But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy him, 48. And could not find what they might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear him.</p> |
| Luke-22:52-53 | K/V.53 | <p>52. Then Jesus said unto the chief priests, and captains of the temple, and the elders, which were come to him, Be ye come out, as against a thief, with swords and staves? 53. When I was <u>daily with you in the temple</u>, ye stretched forth no hands against me: but this is your hour, and the power of darkness.</p> |
| Acts-2:46-47 | K/V.46 | <p>46. And they, <u>continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,</u> 47. Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.</p> |
| Acts-3:1-2 | K/V.2 | <p>1. Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, <i>being</i> the ninth hour. 2. And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;</p> |
| Acts-16:4-5 | K/V.5 | <p>4. And as they went through the cities, they delivered them the decrees for to keep, that were ordained of the apostles and elders which were at Jerusalem. 5. And so were the churches established in the faith, and increased in number daily.</p> |
| Acts-17:10-11 | K/V.11 | <p>10. And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming <i>thither</i> went into the synagogue of the Jews. 11. These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures <u>daily</u>, whether those things were so.</p> |

| Acts-17:16-17 | K/V.17 | 16. Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry. 17. Therefore disputed he in the synagogue with the Jews, and with the devout persons, and in the market <u>daily</u> with them that met with him. |
| Acts-19:8-9 | K/V.9 | 8. And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of God. 9. But when divers were hardened, and believed not, but spake evil of that way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, disputing daily in the school of one Tyrannus. |
| 1-Cor-15:31-34 | K/V.31 | 31. I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily. 32. If after the manner of men I have fought with beasts at Ephesus, what advantageth it me, if the dead rise not? let us eat and drink; for to morrow we die. 33. Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners. 34. Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame. | 2-Cor-6:1-3 | K/V.2 | 1. We then, <i>as workers together with him</i> , beseech <i>you</i> also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain. 2. (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now <i>is</i> the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.) 3.
