Matt-10: 32-42	K/V- 39.	“He who finds his life will lose it, and he loses his life for My sake will find it. (<u>Lk-17:33.</u>)
Matt-10: 32-33	K/V- 33.	“But whoever denies Me before men, Him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven. (<u>Lk-12:8-9.</u>) (<u>1-John-2:23.</u>)
Matt-16: 24-28	K/V- 25.	“For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life <u>for My sake will find it.</u> (<u>Mk-8:35.</u>) (<u>Lk-9:23-27.</u>)
Matt-16: 26.	K/V- 26.	“ For what profit is it for a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?
Luke-12: 4-5	K/V- 4.	“And I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. (<u>Jn-5:22.</u>)
John-11: 25-26	K/V- 25.	Jesus said to her, “ I am the resurrection and the Life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. (<u>Jn-14:6.</u>) (<u>Acts-4:10-12.</u>)
Rom-7: 1-7	K/V- 6.	But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter. (<u>1-Cor-15:33-38.</u>)
Rom-8: 1-10	K/V- 6.	For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.
Rom-8: 10-14	K/V- 13.	For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. (<u>1-Cor-2:2.</u>) (<u>2-Cor-13:5.</u>)
Rom-8: 14-15	K/V- 14.	For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. (<u>Gal-5:18.</u>)
Phil-1: 21-24	K/V- 21.	For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain.
1-Thes-4: 13-18	K/V- 13.	But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen (asleep, die.) lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. (<u>Jn-11:11.</u>) (<u>Jn-11:25-26.</u>)
Heb-9: 26-28	K/V- 27.	-And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment. (<u>Jn-5:29.</u>)
Heb-12: 1-8	K/V- 4.	You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin. (<u>Acts-5:39-41.</u>) (<u>Acts-7:51-60.⁵⁹</u>)
James-1: 25-27	K/V- 27.	Pure and undefiled religion before God and the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their trouble, and to keep oneself unspotted from the world. (<u>1-Jn-2:15-17.</u>)
Rev-3: 1-6	K/V- 2.	“Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before God.
Rev-6: 9-11	K/V- 11.	Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed. (<u>Rev-2:10.</u>)
Rev-13: 7-9	K/V- 7.	It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them. And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation.
Rev-14; 12-13	K/V- 13.	Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, “Write: ‘ Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on. ’” “Yes,” says the Spirit, “that they may rest from their labors, and their works follow them.”
