## **Do Not Be Ignorant Of Satan's Devices**

(2-Cor-2:10-11.KV-11.) 10. To whom ye forgive anything, I forgive also: for if I forgave anything, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ; 11. Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

Gen 3:1-7 (KV-1)	1. Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? 2. And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: 3. But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. 4. And the serpent said unto the woman, Yeahl not surely die: 5. For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. 6. And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. 7. And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. Comment: Brethren when we obey the serpent rather than obey GOD we come under a curse and the curse ends in death.

Either three years' famine; or three months to be destroyed before thy foes, while that the sword of thine enemies overtaketh thee; or else three days the sword of the LORD, even the pestilence, in the land, and the angel of the LORD destroying throughout all the coasts of Israel. Now therefore advise thyself what word I shall bring again to him that sent me. 14. So the LORD sent pestilence upon Israel: and there fell of Israel seventy thousand men. Comment: As soon as David listened to Satan 70,000 men died.

And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause. 4. Hold not thy peace, O God of my praise;</li> <li>For the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a lying tongue.</li> <li>They compassed me about also with words of hatred; and fought against me without a cause.</li> <li>For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer.</li> <li>And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my love.</li> <li>Set thou a wicked man over him: and let Satan stand at his right hand.</li> <li>When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin.</li> <li>Connecting Scripture: (Romans-12:17) (Matthew-12:36-37)</li> <li>Comment: Brethren love your enemies.</li> </ol>

But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. 5. Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple, 6. And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. 7. And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19. Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. 20. Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.</li> <li>Comment: Do you believe that you have power over all the power of the enemy?</li> </ul>

Luke 13:10-17 (KV-16)	<ul> <li>10. And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath. 11. And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up <i>herself</i>. 12. And when Jesus saw her, he called <i>her to him</i>, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity. 13. And he laid <i>his</i> hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. 14. And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day. 15. And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people. 3. Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve. 4. And he went his way, and communed with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray him unto them. 5. And they were glad, and covenanted to give him money.</li> <li>And he promised, and sought opportunity to betray him unto them in the absence of the multitude.</li> <li>Connecting Scriptures: (Matthew-24:10.) And he said, I tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before that thou shalt thrice deny that thou knowest me. Connecting Scriptures: (Romans-8:27-34.) (Hebrews-7:25.) Comment: We need to stand as soldiers. Pray for one another.
John13:21-27 (KV-26,27)	<ul> <li>21 When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me.</li> <li>22 Then the disciples looked one on another, doubting of whom he spake.</li> <li>23 Now there was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of his disciples, whom Jesus loved.</li> <li>24 Simon Peter therefore beckoned to him, that he should ask who it should be of whom he spake.</li> <li>25 He then lying on Jesus' breast saith unto him, Lord, who is it?</li> <li>26 Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon.</li> <li>27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Acts 5:1-11 (KV-3)	<ol> <li>But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession,</li> <li>And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet.</li> <li>But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?</li> <li>Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God.</li> <li>And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.</li> <li>And it was about the space of three hours after, when his wife, not knowing what was done, came in.</li> <li>And Peter answered unto her, Tell me whether ye sold the land for so much? Acts-26:13-18 (KV-17-18)	<ul> <li>13 At midday, O king, I saw in the way a light from heaven, above the brightness of the sun, shining round about me and them which journeyed with me.</li> <li>14 And when we were all fallen to the earth, I heard a voice speaking unto me, and saying in the Hebrew tongue, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks.</li> <li>15 And I said, Who art thou, Lord? And he said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest.</li> <li>16 But rise, and stand upon thy feet: for I have appeared unto thee for this purpose, to make thee a minister and a witness both of these things which thou hast seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto thee;</li> <li>17 Delivering thee from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send thee,</li> <li>18 To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.</li> <li>Comment: From Darkness to Light. From Satan to God. Have faith in Jesus Christ.</li> </ul>
Rom-16:17-20 (KV-19, 20)	<ul> <li>17 Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.</li> <li>18 For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.</li> <li>19 For your obedience is come abroad unto all men. I am glad therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil.</li> <li>20 And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen. Connecting Scripture: (Luk-10:18-19.) And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19. Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Comment: Brethren is Satan under your feet?</li> </ul>
1Cor-5: 1-7 (KV- 4,5)	1. It is reported commonly that there is fornication among you, and such fornication as is not so much as named among the Gentiles, that one should have his father's wife. 2. And ye are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, that he that hath done this deed might be taken away from among you. 3. For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed, 4. In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ, 5. To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. 6. Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leavenet the whole lump? 7. Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:

1Cor-7:1-5 (KV-5)	1. Now concerning the things whereof ye wrote unto me: <i>It is</i> good for a man not to touch a woman. 2. Nevertheless, <i>to avoid</i> fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband. 3. Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband. 4. The wife hath not power of her own body, but the husband: and likewise also the husband hath not power of his own body, but the wife. 5. Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency. Comment: Satan tempts you to lust. Pray that you overcome evil.
2Cor-2:10-11 (KV- 11)	<ul> <li>10. To whom ye forgive anything, I forgive also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ;</li> <li>11. Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.</li> <li>Comment: If you believe and love Jesus you will obey Him. Forgive you will Be Forgiven.</li> </ul>
2 Cor-11:1-4 (KV-3,4)	1. Would to God ye could bear with me a little in my folly: and indeed bear with me. 2. For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. 3. <b>But I fear, lest by any means, as the <u>serpent beguiled</u> Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. 4. For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or <u>another gospel</u>, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him. Comment: Jesus Christ makes it simple men make it hard. Watch for false brethren.</b>
2 Cor 11:12-15 (KV- 13,14,15)	12. But what I do, that I will do, that I may cut off occasion from them which desire occasion; that wherein they glory, they may be found even as we. 13. For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. 14. And no marvel; for <u>Satan</u> himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works. Comment: Many are wearing mask. Discern.
2 Cor-12:7-10 (KV-7,8,9)	7. And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure, 8. For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9. And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. 10. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong. Connecting Scripture (1-Cor-11:27-31) Comment: Brethren when we mess up the Lord Jesus will chasten us so we are not condemn with the world.
1 Thes-2:14-18 (KV-18)	14. For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they <i>have</i> of the Jews: 15. Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men: 16. Forbidding us to speak to the Gentiles that they might be saved, to fill up their sins alway: for the wrath is come upon them to the uttermost. 17. But we, brethren, being taken from you for a short time in presence, not in heart, endeavoured the more abundantly to see your face with great desire. 18. Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but Satan hindered us. Comment: Brethren be wise Satan does try to hinder our walks. Keep your armour on.
2 Thes 2:7-12 (KV- 8, 9, 10)	7. For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. 8. And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: 9. Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10. And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: 12. That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. Comment: Brethren Satan will do signs and wonders but he will never glorify Jesus Christ.
1 Tim 1:15-20 (KV-18-20)	<ul> <li>15. This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. 16.
