Do you believe Hell is real?

Strong's Concordance: Hell in Hebrew and Greek:

<u>Hell in Hebrew-</u>7585- Sheh-ole"; from 7582; hades or the world of the dead

(as if a subterranean retreat), It's accessories and inmates:- grave, hell, pit.

Hell in Greek- 86- Hades, departed souls, grave, hell.

- " 1067- Place (or state) or everlasting punishment- hell.
- " 5020- The deepest abyss of Hades, to incarcerate in eternal
- " Torment, cast down to hell. WARNING= don't go there.

The reason I am doing this study is because I have heard many opinions on this matter even by those who claim to be Christians. The word Christian in the Greek is a follower of Christ not of man. (Romans-8:14.) It is common sense that people do not want to believe hell exists, because if hell is real they know that they have to stop sinning. People have said "God is love and he won't send people to hell" I say to them God is love that's why He gave us His Son so that we don't need to go to hell, but if we reject His Son Jesus who offers salvation it's not Gods fault if we go there it's ours. After you have done this study you may stop having yourself on and REPENT.

(Isaiah-14:9-17.) 9. Hell from beneath is moved for thee to meet *thee* at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead for thee, *even* all the chief ones of the earth; it hath raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations. 10. All they shall speak and say unto thee, Art thou also become weak as we? art thou become like unto us? 11. Thy pomp is brought down to the grave, *and* the noise of thy viols: the worm is spread under thee, and the worms cover thee. 12. How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! *how* art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! 13. For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: 14. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. 15. Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit. 16. They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms; 17. That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners?

Comment: Scripture tells us Hell from beneath and down to hell.

Beneath and down and not up, think about it please.

(Matthew-5:22.) But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.

Comment: Don't call the Lord child names.

(Matthew-5:29-30.) 29. And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell. 30. And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast it from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell.

Connecting Scripture: (Mark-9:43-47.)

Comment: Stay pure.

(Matthew-10:28.) And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

Connecting Scripture: (Luke-12:4-5.) **Comment**: So who is it that we should fear?

(Iohn-5:22.) For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:

Connecting Scripture: (Romans-14:10-11.) (John-12:48-49.)

Comment: So we can see that if we reject the words of Jesus Christ, the words that cleanses us, it is this that judges us in the last day.

(Matthew-11:23.) And thou, Capernaum, which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: for if the mighty works, which have been done in thee, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day.

Connecting Scripture: (Luke-18:14.) (Luke-10:15.) **Comment**: *Brothers and Sisters stay humble*.

(Matthew-23:12-15.) 12. And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted. 13. But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in. 14. Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation. 15. Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte (a convert to Judaism), And when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

Connecting Scripture: (John-11:25-26.) (John-14:6.)

Comment: Make sure that you are converted to Jesus Christ no one else. Be wise.

(Matthew-23:33.) Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?

(Luke-3:7-8.) 7. Then said he to the multitude that came forth to be baptized of him, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come? 8. Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.

Connecting Scripture: (Galatians-5:22-23.)

(Luke-16:19-31.) 19. There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day: 20. And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores, 21. And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. 22. And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; 23. And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. 24. And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. 25. But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented. 26. And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence.

Comment: There is no way out of hell don't go!

(<u>James-3:5-9.</u>) **5.** Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth! **6.** And the tongue *is* a fire, a world of iniquity: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell. **7.** For every kind of beasts, and of birds, and of serpents, and of things in the sea, is tamed, and hath been tamed of mankind: **8.** But the tongue can no man tame; *it is* an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. **9.** Therewith bless we God, even the Father; and therewith curse we men, which are made after the similitude of God.

Connecting Scripture: (Proverbs-18:21.)

(Matthew-12:36-37.) 36. But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. 37. For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

(2-Peter-2:4.) For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

(Revelation-6:8.) And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was **Death, and Hell followed with him.** And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.

(Revelation-20:14-15.) 14. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. 15. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

Comment: If you do not believe there is a hell I don't know what kind of Bible you have, it must be a late version that unbelievers brought out? **Comment:** Here is a little study to think about what does the scriptures mean when they say lake of fire. Let us have a look at some scriptures.

(Revelation-19:20.) And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

(Revelation-20:10.) And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Comment: We will now have another little study on torment or tormented.

(Matthew-8:28-32.) 28. And when he was come to the other side into the country of the Gergesenes, there met him two possessed with devils, coming out of the tombs, exceeding fierce, so that no man might pass by that way. 29. And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? art thou come hither to torment us before the time? 30. And there was a good way off from them an herd of many swine feeding. 31. So the devils besought him, saying, If thou cast us out, suffer us to go away into the herd of swine. 32. And he said unto them, Go. And when they were come out, they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters.

Connecting Scripture: (Mark-5:1-19.) (Luke-8:26-39.)

Comment: Did you notice that the presence of Jesus tormented devils? So who is in charge? Not the devils.

(Matthew-18:23-35.) 33. Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee? 34. And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him. 35. So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.

Connecting Scripture: (Matthew-6:14-15.)

Comment: If you do not forgive you will be tormented.

(1-John-4:17-21.) 17. Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

18. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. 19. We love him, because he first loved us. 20. If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? 21. And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.

(Revelation-14:9-11.) 9. And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, 10. The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: 11. And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

(Revelation-18:5-7.) 5. For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities. 6. Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double. 7. How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.

Comment: So Brothers and Sisters we can see by scriptures that hell is real, the lake of fire is real, torment is real. If I were you I would not gamble with our salvation. Did you notice that even the legion of devils didn't want to go to hell. How bad must it be? Brothers and Sisters did you know the meaning of the word hell in Hebrew and Greek mean the same. Look these scriptures up for yourselves.

Note: Some Bible versions have different meanings but still mean the same.

I don't want you deceived by denomination who preach a false gospel.

(Isaiah-14:15.) Hell means: Sheol (Matthew-18:9.) Hell Means: Gehenna (2-Peter-2:4.) Hell Means: Tartarus (Revelation-6:8.) Hell Means: Hades
