Matt-7: 13-20	K/V- 16.	"You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles?
Matt-7: 21-29	K/V- 21.	"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. (<u>Matt-17:5.</u>) (<u>John-3:16.</u>)
Matt-25: 1-13	K/V- 12.	"But he answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you. '
Luke-4: 33-37	K/V- 34.	-saying, "Let us alone! What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did you come to destroy us? I know who You are- the Holy One of God!"
Luke-13: 22-30	K/V- 25.	"When once the Master of the house has risen up and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open for us,' and He will answer and say to you, ' I do not know you where you are from, '
John-1: 11-13	K/V- 12.	But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:
John-3: 30-31	K/V- 31.	"He who comes from above is above all; he who is of the earth is earthly and speaks of the earth. He who comes from heaven is above all. (<u>John-3:10-12.</u>) (<u>Heb-12:25.</u>)
John-8: 28-32	K/V- 28.	Then Jesus said to them, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father taught Me, I speak these things. (<u>John-14:6.</u>)
John-10: 1-5	K/V- 4.	"And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.
John-10: 25-30	K/V- 27.	"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. (1-John-2:6.)
John-13: 34-35	K/V- 35.	"By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."
John-14: 1-12	K/V- 7.	If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him."
John-14: 16-17	K/V- 17.	-"the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. (<u>2-Cor-13:5.</u>)
John-14: 20-21	K/V- 20.	"At that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.
John-17: 1-5	K/V- 3.	"And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.
Rom-8: 1-11	K/V- 6.	For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.
1-Cor-2: 1-5	K/V- 2.	For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.

Titus-1: 15-16	K/V- 16.	They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him , being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.
1-John-2: 1-6	K/V- 3. K/V- 4.	³ Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. ⁴ He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar , and the truth is not in him. (<u>John-3:36.</u>) (<u>John-14:6.</u>) (<u>2-Cor-13:5.</u>)
1-John-2: 22-29	K/V- 29.	If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone who practices righteousness is born of Him. (<u>John-3:3-5.</u>) (<u>1-John-5:1-3.</u>)
1-John-5: 17-21	K/V- 18.	We know that whoever is born of God does not sin; but he who has been born of God keeps himself , and the wicked one does not touch him.

Brothers and sisters these scriptures tell us that if our fruit is not glorifying Jesus Christ and the Father we are missing the point, we have met many backsliding Christians that tell us that Christians they know are just like them, some have told us that they sleep around they drink and get drunk they smoke, lie, rubbish each other, backbite each other, and many other things. It is very sad that many who calls themselves Christians are doing these things. Have a look at this scripture. (1-Corinthians-6:9-10.) **9.** Do you not know that the unrighteous **will not inherit the kingdom of God?** Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, **10.** Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. **11.** And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God. Because a person is washed we are not meant to return to our sin. (2-Peter-2:22.) **22.** But it has happened to them according to the true proverb: "A dog returns to his own vomit," and, "a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire." (Jam-4:4.) **4.** Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. Why should you not love the world read this scripture. (1-John-5:19.) **19.** We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one.
