

## Doctrines

Matt-15: 1-9	K/V- 9.	And in vain they worship Me, Teaching as <b>doctrines</b> the commandments of men.’ “ (Mk-7:7.)
Matt-16: 5-12	K/V- 12.	Then they understood that He did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the <b>doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees.</b>
Mark-1: 23-28	K/V- 27.	Then they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, “What is this? <b>What new doctrine is this?</b> For with authority He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him.”
John-7: 14-18	K/V- 16.	Jesus answered them and said, “ <b>My doctrine is not Mine,</b> but His who sent Me. (Deut-18:18.) (John-1:45.) (Acts-3:22-23.) (Jer-31:31-34. <sup>33</sup> ) (Gal-4:6.)
John-18: 19-23	K/V- 19.	The high priest then asked Jesus about His disciples and <b>His doctrine.</b>
Acts-2: 42-47	K/V- 42.	<b>And they continued steadfastly in the apostles’ doctrine and fellowship,</b> in the breaking of the bread, and in prayers. (1-John-1:7.)
Acts-5: 27-29	K/V- 28.	Saying, “Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? And look, <b>you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine,</b> and intend to bring this man’s blood on us!”
Acts-17: 18-20	K/V- 19.	And they took him and brought him to the Areopagus, saying, “ <b>May we know what this new doctrine is of what you speak?</b> ”
Rom-6: 13-18	K/V- 17.	But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, <b>yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered.</b>
Rom-16: 17-19	K/V- 17.	Now I urge you, brethren, note those who cause divisions and offenses, <b>contrary to the doctrine you have learned, and avoid them.</b>
Eph-4: 11-16	K/V- 14.	That we should no longer be children, <b>tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine by the trickery of men,</b> in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting.
Col-2: 20-23	K/V- 22.	Which all concern things which perish with the using- <b>according to the commandments and doctrines of men?</b>
1-Tim-1: 1-8	K/V- 3.	As I urged you when I went into Macedonia- <b>remain in Ephesus that you may charge some that they teach no other doctrine,</b>
1-Tim-1: 9-11	K/V- 10.	For fornicators, for sodomites, for kidnappers, for liars, for perjurers, <b>and there is any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine.</b>
1-Tim-4: 1-3	K/V- 1.	Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, <b>giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrine of demons.</b>
1-Tim-4: 4-7	K/V- 6.	If you instruct the brethren in these things, <b>you will be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished in the words of faith and of the good doctrine which you have carefully followed.</b>
1-Tim-4: 12-14	K/V- 13.	Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, <b>to doctrine.</b>
1-Tim-4: 14-16	K/V- 16.	<b>Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them,</b> for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you.
2-Tim-3: 10-17	K/V- 16.	<b>All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and his profitable for doctrine,</b> for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.
2-Tim-4: 1-5	K/V- 3.	<b>-For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine.</b> But according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers;
Titus-2: 1-7	K/V- 1.	<b>But as for you, speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine:</b>

Titus-2: 8-10	K/V- 10.	Not pilfering, but showing all good fidelity, <b>that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.</b>
Heb-6: 1-3	K/V- 2.	<sup>1</sup> . Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, <sup>2</sup> <b>of the doctrine of baptisms</b> , of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. <sup>3</sup> . And this we will do if God permits.
Heb-13: 7-10	K/V- 9.	<b>Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines.</b> -For it is good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.
2-John: 9-11	K/V- 10.	<b>If anyone comes to you and does not bring this doctrine, do not receive him into your house nor greet him;</b>
Rev-2: 14-15	K/V- 14.	“But I have a few things against you, because you have there those who hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality. <sup>15</sup> . <b>“Thus you also have those who have the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.</b>
Gal-1: 6-11	K/V- 8.	But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed
2-Pet-3: 16-18	K/V- 16.	As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction, as they do also the rest of the scriptures.
