

## Doubt - Unbelief

Matt-13: 57-58	K/V- 58.	Now He did not do many mighty works there because of <b>their unbelief.</b> ( <u>Mk-6:4-6.</u> )
Matt-14: 24-36	K/V- 31.	And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, “O you of little faith, <b>why did you doubt?</b> ”
Matt-17: 14-21	K/V- 20.	So Jesus said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.
Matt-21: 18-21	K/V- 21.	So Jesus answered and said to them, “Assuredly, I say to you, <b>If you have faith and do not doubt,</b> you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ it will be done.
Matt-28: 16-20	K/V- 17.	When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; <b>but some doubted.</b>
Mark-9: 17-29	K/V- 24.	Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, “Lord, I believe; <b>help my unbelief!</b> ”
Mark-11; 20-26	K/V- 23.	“For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ <b>and does not doubt in his heart,</b> but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.
Mark-16: 11-14	K/V- 14.	Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; <b>and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart,</b> because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen.
Mark-16: 15-18	K/V- 16.	“He who believes and is baptized will be saved; <b>but he who does not believe will be condemned.</b> ( <u>Rom-14:23.</u> )
Luke-24: 25-26	K/V- 25.	Then He said to them, “O foolish ones, <b>and slow of heart to believe</b> in all that the Prophets have spoken!
Luke-24: 36-45	K/V- 38.	And He said to them, “Why are you troubled? <b>And why do doubts arise in your hearts?</b> ”
John-3: 1-13	K/V- 12.	“ <b>If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe,</b> how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things? ( <u>Rom-8:6-8.</u> )
John-3: 33-36	K/V- 36.	“He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; <b>and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.</b> ”
John-4: 46-54	K/V- 48.	Then Jesus said to him, “Unless you people see signs and wonders, <b>you will by no means believe.</b> ”
John-5: 36-40	K/V- 38.	“But you do not have His word abiding in you, because whom He sent, <b>Him you do not believe.</b>
John-6: 35-37	K/V- 36.	“But I said to you that you have seen Me, <b>and yet do not believe.</b>
John-6: 61-64	K/V- 64.	“ <b>But there are some of you who do not believe.</b> ” For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who would betray Him.
John-7: 1-8	K/V- 5.	<b>For even His brothers did not believe in Him.</b> ( <u>Matt-13:57.</u> )
John-8: 23-26	K/V- 24.	“Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; <b>for if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins.</b> ”
John-8: 42-47	K/V- 45.	“But because I tell the truth, <b>you do not believe Me?</b> ”
John-10: 24-30	K/V- 26.	“ <b>But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you.</b> ”

John-12: 34-40	K/V- 37.	But although He had done so many signs before them, <b>they did not believe in Him.</b>
John-20: 24-31	K/V- 27.	Then He said to Thomas, “Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and put it into My side. <b>Do not be unbelieving, but believing.</b> ”
Acts-4: 17-20	K/V- 19.	But Peter and John answered and said to them, “ <b>Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than God, you judge.</b>
Acts-5: 27-32	K/V- 29.	But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: “ <b>We ought to obey God rather than men.</b>
Acts-11: 11-16	K/V- 12.	“Then the Spirit told me to go with them, <b>doubting nothing.</b> Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered the man’s house.
Acts-13: 38-42	K/V- 41.	‘Behold, you despisers, Marvel and perish! For I work a work in your days, <b>A work which you will by no means believe,</b> Though one were to declare it to you.’ “
Acts-14: 1-6	K/V- 2.	<b>But the unbelieving Jews stirred up the Gentiles and poisoned their minds against the brethren.</b>
Rom-11: 16-25	K/V- 20.	<b>Well said, Because of unbelief they were broken off,</b> and you stand by faith. Do not be haughty, but fear. (John-15:2.)
Rom-14: 1-4	K/V- 1.	Receive one who is weak in the faith, <b>but not to disputes over doubtful things.</b>
Rom-14: 20-23	K/V- 23.	<b>But he who doubts is condemned if he eats because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin. (Mk-16:16.)</b>
1-Cor-6: 1-10	K/V- 6.	But brother goes to law against brother, <b>and that before unbelievers!</b>
1-Cor-7: 10-17	K/V- 14.	<b>For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife,</b> and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy.
1-Cor-14: 22-25	K/V- 22.	Therefore tongues are for a sign, <b>not to those who believe but to unbelievers;</b> but prophesying is not for unbelievers but for those who believe.
2-Cor-4: 1-5	K/V- 4.	<b>Whose minds the God of this age has blinded, who do not believe,</b> Lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.
2-Cor-6: 12-18	K/V- 14.	<b>Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers.</b> For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness?
Eph-4: 11-15	K/V- 14.	That we should no longer be children, <b>tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine,</b> by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting,
2-Thes-2: 9-14	K/V- 12.	<b>That they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.</b>
1-Tim-1: 12-15	K/V- 13.	Although I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and an insolent man; <b>but I obtained mercy because I did it ignorantly in unbelief.</b>
1-Tim-2: 1-8	K/V- 8.	I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, <b>without wrath and doubting;</b>
1-Tim-5: 6-8	K/V- 8.	But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, <b>he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.</b>
2-Tim-3: 1-5	K/V- 5.	<b>Having a form of godliness but <u>denying its power.</u></b> And from such people turn away!
2-Tim-4: 1-5	K/V- 3.	For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers, <sup>4</sup> <b>And they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned to fables.</b>

Titus-1: 15-16	K/V- 15.	<b>To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled.</b> <sup>16.</sup> They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.
Heb-3: 7-13	K/V- 12.	<b>Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God;</b>
Heb-3: 14-19	K/V- 18.	And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey? <sup>19.</sup> <b>So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.</b>
Heb-4: 1-3	K/V- 2.	For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, <b>not being mixed with faith in those who heard it.</b>
James-1: 5-8	K/V- 6.	<b>But let him ask in faith, with no doubting,</b> for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. (Matt-14:28-32. <sup>30.</sup> ) (Eph-4:11-15. <sup>14.</sup> )
1-John-4: 1-3	K/V- 1.	<b>Beloved, do not believe every spirit,</b> but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.
Jude-1: 1-5	K/V- 5.	But I want to remind you, that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, <b>afterward destroyed those who did not believe.</b> (1-John-1:6.) (1-John-5:10.)
Rev-21: 7-8	K/V- 8.	“But the cowardly, <b>unbelieving,</b> abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all lairs shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.”
