Matt-6: 25-34	K/V- 30.	“Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will He not much more clothe you, O you of little faith? ”
Matt-8: 5-13	KV- 10.	When Jesus heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, “Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith , not even in Israel! (Lk-7:1-9. ⁹)
Matt-8: 23-27	K/V- 26.	But He said to them, “Why are you fearful, O you of little faith? ” (Mk-4:35-41. ⁴⁰)
Matt-9: 1-8	KV- 2.	Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith , He said to the paralytic, “Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you.” (Mk-2:3-5. ⁵) (Lk-5:17-20. ²⁰)
Matt-9: 18-19 & 23-26	K/V- 24.	He said to them, “Make room, for the girl is not dead, but sleeping.” And they ridiculed Him. (Mk-5:22-24, Mk-5:35-43. ³⁶) (Jn-11:11-46. ⁴⁰) (1-Cor-11:27-34. ³⁰)
Matt-9: 27-31	K/V- 29.	Then He touched their eyes, saying, “ According to your faith let it be to you. ”
Matt-14: 22-33	K/V- 31.	And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, “ O you of little faith, why did you doubt? ”
Matt-15: 21-28	K/V- 28.	Then Jesus answered and said to her, “ O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire.” (Mk-7:24-30. ²⁹)
Matt-16: 5-12	K/V- 8.	But Jesus, being aware of it, said to them, “ O you of little faith , why do you reason among yourselves because you have brought no bread? (Lk-12:1-3. ¹)
Matt-17: 14-21	K/V- 20.	So Jesus said to them, “Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed , you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.
Matt-21: 18-22	K/V- 21.	So Jesus answered and said to them, “Assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt , you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ it will be done. (Mk-11:22-26. ²³)
Matt-23: 23-26	K/V- 23.	“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithes of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith . These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.
Mk-10: 46-52	K/V- 52.	Then Jesus said to him, “ Go your way; your faith has made you well. ” And immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus on the road.
Mark-11: 22-26	K/V- 22.	So Jesus answered and said to them, “ Have faith in God. ”
Luke-7: 36-50	K/V- 50.	Then He said to the woman, “ Your faith has saved you. Go in peace.”
Luke-17: 11-19	K/V- 19.	10-Leper: And He said to them, “Arise, go your way, Your faith has made you well. ”
Luke-18: 1-8	K/V- 8.	“I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of man comes, will He really find faith on earth? ”
Luke-18: 35-43	K/V- 42.	Then Jesus said to him, “Receive your sight; your faith has made you well. ”
Luke-22: 31-32	K/V- 31. K/V- 32.	³¹ And the Lord said, “Simon, Simon! Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat. ³² But I have prayed for you; that your faith shall not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren.”

Acts-3: 14-16	K/V- 16.	“And His name, through faith in His name , has made this man strong, whom you see and know. Yes, the faith which comes through Him has given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.
Acts-6: 5-8	K/V- 8.	And Stephen, full of faith and power , did great wonders and signs among the people.
Acts-13: 8-12	K/V- 8.	But Elymas the sorcerer (for so his name is translated) withstood them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the faith.
Acts-14: 7-11	K/V- 9. K/V- 10.	⁹ . This man heard Paul speaking. Paul, observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed , ¹⁰ . said with a loud voice, “Stand up straight on your feet!” And he leaped and walked.
Acts-14: 21-23	K/V- 22.	Strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting them to continue in the faith , and saying, “We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom God.”
Acts-14: 27-28	K/V- 27.	Now when they had come and gathered the church together, they reported all that God had done with them, and that He had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles.
Acts-15: 5-11	K/V- 8. K/V- 9.	⁸ . “So God, who knows the heart, acknowledged them by giving them the Holy Spirit, just as He did to us, ⁹ . -“and made no distinction between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.
Acts-16: 4-5	K/V- 5.	So the churches were strengthened in the faith , and increased in number daily.
Acts-20: 20-21	K/V- 21.	“Testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance towards God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.
Acts-26: 14-18	K/V- 18.	- ‘to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.’
Rom-1: 1-6	K/V- 5.	Through Him we have received grace and apostleship for obedience to the faith among all nations for His name,
Rom-1: 11-12	K/V-11. K/V- 12.	¹¹ . For I long to see you, I may impart to you some spiritual gift, so that you may be established- ¹² .-that is, that I may be encouraged together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me.
Rom-1: 16-18	K/V- 17.	For in it the righteousness of God is revealed by faith to faith ; as it is written, The just will live by faith.”
Rom-3: 19-31	K/V- 31.	Do we then make void the law through faith? Certainly not! On the contrary, we establish the law.
Rom-4: 5-9	K/V- 5.	But to him who does not work but believes on Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted for righteousness.
Rom-4: 13-20	K/V-14. K/V- 15. K/V- 16.	¹⁴ . For if those who are of the law are heirs, faith is made void and the promise made of no effect , ¹⁵ . Because the law brings about wrath; for where there is no law there is no transgression. ¹⁶ . Therefore it is of faith that it might be according to grace , so that the promise may be sure to all the seed, not only to those who are of the law, but also to those who are of the faith of Abraham , who is the father of us all
Rom-5: 1-2	K/V-1. K/V- 2.	¹ . Therefore, having been justified by faith , we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, ² . -through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.
Rom-10: 6-11	K/V- 6.	But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way , “Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’” (that is, to bring Christ Down from above)
Rom-11: 16-23	K/V- 20.	Well said, Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith , Do not be haughty, but fear.
Rom-12: K/V- 3.		For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of

1-5		himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.
Rom-14 1-2	K/V- 1.	Receive one who is weak in the faith, but not to disputes over doubtful things.
Rom-14: 22-23	K/V- 22.	Do you have faith? Have it to yourself before God. Happy is he who does not condemn himself in what he approves.
1-Cor-2: 4-7	K/V- 4. K/V- 5.	^{4.} And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, ^{5.} -that your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God. (Gal-1:12.)
1-Cor-12: 4-11	K/V- 9.	To another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit,
1- Cor-13: 1-13	K/V- 2.	And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.
1- Cor-14: 1-40	K/V- 1.	Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.
1- Cor-15: 12-18	K/V- 14.	And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty.
1- Cor-16: 13-14	K/V- 13. K/V- 14.	^{13.} Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong. ^{14.} Let all that you do be done with love. (Eph-6:10.)
2- Cor-1: 20-24	K/V- 24.	Not that we have dominion over your faith, but are fellow workers for your joy; for by faith you stand.
2- Cor-4: 11-15	K/V- 13.	And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, “I believed and therefore I spoke,” we also believe and therefore speak,
2- Cor-5: 5-10	K/V- 7.	For we walk by faith, not by sight.
2- Cor-8: 7-9	K/V- 7.	But as you abound in everything- in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us-see that you abound in this grace also.
2- Cor-10: 12-18	K/V- 15.	Not boasting of things beyond measure, that is, in other men’s labors, but having hope, that as your faith is increased, we shall be greatly enlarged by you in our sphere,
2-Cor-13: 1-6	K/V- 5.	Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves that Jesus Christ is in you? - Unless you are disqualified. (1-John-4:4.)
Gal-3: 1-6	K/V- 2.	This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of the faith?
Gal-3: 7-13	K/V- 7.	Therefore know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham.
Gal-5: 1-10	K/V- 5.	For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
Eph-2: 8-9	K/V- 8.	For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. <u>(John-1:17.)</u>
Eph-3: 10-14	K/V- 12.	In whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him. (Heb-10:19.) (Heb-10:35.)
Eph-3: 16-20	K/V- 17.	That Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <u>(Gal-4:6.)</u>
Eph-4: 1-8	K/V- 5. K/V- 6.	^{5.} One Lord, one faith, one baptism; ^{6.} One God and Father of all, and through all, and in you all.
Eph-4: 11-14	K/V- 13.	Till we all come to the <u>unity of the faith</u> and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;

Eph-6: 13-19	K/V- 16.	Above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.
Phil-3: 7-9	K/V- 9.	And be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith;
Col-1: 21-23	K/V- 23.	If indeed you continue in the faith , grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.
Col-2: 4-7	K/V- 5.	For though I am absent in the flesh, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good order and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ.
Col-2: 12-15	K/V- 12.	Buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God , who raised Him from the dead.
1- Thes-1: 2-8	K/V- 3.	³ . Remember without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love , and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father,
1-Thes-3: 2-10	K/V- 5.	For this reason, when I could no longer endure it, I sent to know your faith , lest by some means the tempter had tempted you, and our labor might be in vain. (<u>2-Cor-11:3.</u>)
1-Thes-5: 6-10	K/V- 8.	But let us who are of the day be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love , and as a helmet the hope of salvation.
2-Thes-1: 3-6	K/V- 3.	We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly , and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other,
2-Thes-1: 11-12	K/V- 11.	Therefore we also pray always for you that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power. (<u>Rom-15:18-19.</u>) (<u>1-Cor-2:4-5.</u>) (<u>1-Cor-4:20.</u>) (<u>Eph-1:19.</u>) (<u>2-Tim-1:7.</u>) (<u>2-Tim-3:5.</u>)
2-Thes-3: 1-5	K/V- 2.	And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men; for not all have faith. (<u>Heb-3:12.</u>) (<u>Heb-11:6.</u>)
1-Tim-1: 1-6	K/V- 4.	Nor give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which cause disputes rather than godly edification which is in faith.
1-Tim-1: 18-20	K/V- 19.	¹⁹ . Having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the faith have suffered shipwreck , ²⁰ . -of whom are Hy-me-nae'us and Alexander, whom I delivered to Satan that they may learn not to blaspheme.
1-Tim-4: 1-3	K/V- 1.	Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith , giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,
1-Tim-5: 11-12	K/V- 12.	Having condemnation because they have cast off their first faith.
1-Tim-6: 6-11	K/V- 10.	For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness , and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. (<u>Mt-13:22.</u>)
1-Tim-6: 12-14	K/V- 12.	Fight the good fight of faith , lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. (<u>Matt-10:32-33.</u>)
1-Tim-6: 20-21	K/V- 20. K/V- 21.	²⁰ . O Timothy! Guard what was committed to your trust, avoiding the profane and idle babblings and contradictions of what is falsely called knowledge- ²¹ . -by professing it some have strayed concerning the faith. Grace be with you. Amen.
2-Tim-2: 17-21	K/V- 18.	Who have strayed concerning the truth, saying that the resurrection is already past, and they overthrow the faith to some. (<u>Matt-24:34.</u>)
2-Tim-4: 6-9	K/V- 7.	I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.
Titus-1: 10-16	K/V- 13.	This testimony is true. Therefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith.
Heb-4: 1-5	K/V- 2.	For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith. In those who heard it. (<u>1-John-5:5-7.</u> ⁶ .)

Heb-6: 10-14	K/V- 12.	That you do not become sluggish, but imitate those who through faith and patience inherit the promises. (1-Cor-3:21-23. ²¹)
Heb-10: 35-39	K/V- 38.	Now the just will live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.”
Heb-11: 1-2	K/V- 1.	Now faith is the substance of things hope for, the evidence of things not seen.
Heb-11: 3	K/V- 3.	By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are invisible.
Heb-11: 4	K/V- 4.	By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it he being dead still speaks.
Heb-11: 5	K/V- 5.	By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, “and was not found, because God had taken him”; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God.
Heb-11: 6	K/V- 6.	But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
Heb-11: 7	K/V- 7	By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared the ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.
Heb-11: 8	K/V- 8.	By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.
Heb-11: 9-10	K/V- 9.	By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise;
Heb-11: 11	K/V- 11.	By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age,
Heb-11: 12-16	K/V-13. K/V- 14.	¹³ These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. ¹⁴ For those who say such things declare plainly that they seek a homeland.
Heb-11: 17-20	K/V- 17.	By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son,
Heb-11: 21-22	K/V- 21.	By faith Jacob, when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, and worshiped, leaning on the top of his staff.
Heb-11: 23	K/V- 23.	By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, because they saw he was a beautiful child;
Heb-11: 24-26	K/V- 24.	By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh’s daughter,
Heb-11: 27.	K/V- 27.	By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible.
Heb-11: 28	K/V- 28.	By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them.
Heb-11: 29.	K/V- 29.	By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned.
Heb-11: 30	K/V- 30.	By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they were encircled for seven days.
Heb-11: 31	K/V- 31.	By faith the harlot Rehab did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace.
Heb-11: 32-33	K/V- 33.	Who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

Heb-11: 34.	K/V- 34.	Quenched the violence of fire , escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, became valiant in battle, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.
Heb-11: 35	K/V- 35.	Women receive their dead raised to life again. Others were tortured, not accepting deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection.
Heb-11: 36-40	K/V- 36.	Still others had trial of mocking and scourging , yes, and of chains and imprisonment.
Heb-12: 1-8	K/V- 2.	Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of the faith , who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
Heb-13: 5-8	K/V- 7.	Remember those who rule over you, who have spoken the word of God to you, whose faith follow , considering the outcome of their conduct.
James-1: 1-4	K/V- 2. K/V- 3.	² My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, ³ -knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.
James-1: 5-8	K/V- 6.	But let him ask in faith, with no doubting , for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. (<u>Mk-11:23-26.²³</u>)
James-2: 1-10	K/V- 5.	Listen, my beloved brethren: Has God not chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him?
James-2: 14-18	K/V- 14.	What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? (<u>Matt-7:24.</u>) (<u>John-4:34.</u>)
James-2: 17-26	K/V-17. K/V- 18.	¹⁷ Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead. ¹⁸ But someone will say, You have faith, and I have works.” Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works
James-2: 22-26	K/V- 22.	Do you see that faith was working together with his works , and by works faith was made perfect? (<u>Luke-6:46.</u>)
James 2: 26	K/V- 26.	For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.
James-5: 13-16	K/V- 15.	And the prayer of faith will save the sick , and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.
1-Pet-1: 5-9	K/V- 5.	Who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. (<u>Acts-4:10-12.</u>)
1-Pet-5: 8-11	K/V- 9.	Resist him, steadfast in the faith , knowing that the same sufferings are experienced by your brotherhood in the world. (<u>Jam-4:7.</u>)
2-Pet-1: 1-8	K/V- 5.	But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue , to virtue, knowledge.
1-John-5: 4-5	K/V- 4.	For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world – our faith.
Rev-14: 12	K/V- 12.	Hear the patience of the saints, here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus.

Matt-24: 44-51	K/V- 45.	“Who then is a faithful and wise servant , whom his master made ruler over his household, to give them food in due season?
Matt-25: 14-30	K/V- 21.	“His lord said to him, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.’
Luke-16: 1-13	K/V- 10.	“He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much , and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much.

1-Cor-1: 4-10	K/V- 9.	God is faithful , by whom you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
1-Thes-5: 23-24	K/V- 24.	He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it.
2-Tim-2: 10-13	K/V- 11. K/V- 12. K/V- 13.	¹¹ . This is a faithful saying: For if we died with Him, We shall also live with Him. ¹² . If we endure, We shall also reign with Him. If we deny Him, ¹³ . He also will deny us. If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.

(Rom-14:23.) But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith, for whatever is not from faith is sin. (Mk-16:16.) (Heb-3:18-19.)
