Matt-10: 16-33	K/V- 28.	“And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. (<u>Matt-25:31-46.^{46.}</u>) (<u>Matt-28:18.</u>) (<u>Lk-12:1-5.^{4.}</u>) (<u>Jn-5:22.</u>)
Matt-14: 22-36	K/V- 26.	And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, “It is a ghost!” And they cried out for fear.
Matt-21: 23-27	K/V- 26.	“But if we say, ‘From men,’ we fear the multitudes, for all count John as a prophet.”
Matt-28: 1-10	K/V- 4.	And the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead men.
Matt-28: 5-10	K/V- 8.	So they went out quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to bring His disciples word.
Luke-1: 49-50	K/V- 50.	And His mercy is on those who fear Him From generation to generation. (<u>Matt-5:7.</u>) (<u>Psa-111:10.</u>)
Luke-1: 74-75	K/V- 74.	To grant us that we, Being delivered from the hand of our enemies, Might serve Him without fear, (<u>Heb-4:15-16.</u>)
Luke-5: 18-26	K/V- 26.	And they were all amazed, and they glorified God and were filled with fear, saying, “We have seen strange things today!” (<u>Acts-13:16.</u>) (<u>Acts-13:26.</u>)
Luke-7: 12-17	K/V- 16.	Then fear came upon them all, and they glorified God, saying, “A great prophet has risen up among us”; and, “God has visited His people.”
Luke-8: 26-39	K/V- 37.	Then the whole multitude of the surrounding region of the Gad’arenes asked Him to depart from them, for they were seized with great fear. And He got into the boat and returned. (<u>“Legion cast out.”</u>)
Luke-18: 1-8	K/V- 2.	Saying: “There was a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man.
Luke-21: 25-27	K/V- 26.	“Men’s hearts failing them from fear and the expectations of those things which are coming on the earth, for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (<u>Heb-12:25-29.</u>)
Luke-23: 39-43	K/V- 40.	But the other, answering, rebuked him saying: Do you not even fear God, seeing you are under the same condemnation?
John-7: 12-13	K/V- 13.	However, no one spoke openly of Him, for fear of the Jews. (<u>Jn-19:38.</u>) (<u>Jn-20:19.</u>) (<u>Prov-29:25.</u>)
Acts-2: 40-47	K/V- 43.	Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles.
Acts-5: 1-11	K/V- 11.	So great fear came upon all the church and upon all who heard these things. (<u>Ananias and Sapphira.</u>)
Acts-9: 31-35	K/V- 31.	Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied. (<u>Rev-14:7.</u>) (<u>Rev-19:5.</u>)
Acts-19: 13-18	K/V- 17.	This became known both to all Jews and Greeks dwelling in Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified. (<u>Jewish exorcists.</u>)
Rom-3: 9-18	K/V- 18.	“There is no fear of God before their eyes.”
Rom-8: 10-17	K/V- 15.	For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.” (<u>Jn-8:36.</u>)
Rom-11: 16-25	K/V- 20.	Well said, Because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith, Do not be haughty, but fear. (<u>Heb-4:1-3.</u>)
2-Cor-7: 1-3	K/V- 1.	Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God. (<u>Jam-4:8.</u>)

2-Cor-11.1-4	K/V- 3.	But I fear , lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so you minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
Phili-1:27-30	K/V- 28.	And not in any way terrified by your adversaries , which is to them a proof of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that from God.
Phil-2:12-14	K/V- 12.	Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling;
1-Tim-5:19-22	K/V- 20.	Those who are sinning rebuke in the presence of all, that the rest also may fear. (<u>Matt-23:12-39.</u>) (<u>Acts-13:9-12.^{10.}</u>) (<u>2-Tim-4:2.</u>) (<u>Titus-1:10-16.^{13.}</u>)
Heb-2:14-18	K/V- 15.	And release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. (<u>John-8:36.</u>)
Heb-4:1-3	K/V- 1.	Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it. (<u>2-Cor-13:5.</u>)
Heb-5:5-10	K/V- 7.	Who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of his Godly fear,
Heb-12:25-29	K/V- 28. K/V- 29.	^{28.} Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. ^{29.} For our God is a consuming fire.
Heb-13:5-6	K/V- 6.	So we may boldly say: “The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?” (<u>Rom-8:31.</u>)
1-Pet-1:16-19	K/V- 17.	And if you call on the Father, who without partiality judges according to each one’s work, conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear;
1-Pet-2:17-18	K/V- 17.	Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God, Honor the King.
1-Pet-3:12-16	K/V- 15.	But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear; (<u>Eph-5:26-27.</u>)
1-John-4:15-21	K/V- 18.	There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. (<u>Matt-8:29.</u>) (<u>1-Pet-4:8.</u>)
Jude-1:1-25	K/V- 12.	These are spots in your love feasts, while they feast with you without fear, serving only themselves. They are clouds without water, carried about by the winds; late autumn trees without fruit, twice dead, pulled up by the roots;
Rev-19:5-6	K/V- 5.	Then a voice came from the throne, saying, “Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him, both small and great!”
