Matt-6: 9-13	K/V- 12.	And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors.
Matt-6: 14-15	K/V- 14. K/V- 15.	^{14.} “For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. ^{15.} “But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. (Gal-6:7.)
Matt-9: 1-8	K/V- 5. K/V- 6.	^{5.} “For which is easier, to say, ‘ Your sins are forgiven you, ’ or to say, ‘Arise and walk’? ^{6.} “But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins” – then He said to the paralytic, “Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.” (Mk-2:1-12.)
Matt-18: 21-35	K/V- 21.	^{21.} Then Peter came to Him and said, “Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?” ^{22.} Jesus said to Him, “I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven.
Matt-18: 33-35	K/V- 34. K/V- 35.	^{34.} “And his master was angry, and delivered him to the torturers until he should pay all that was due to him. ^{35.} “So My heavenly Father also will do to you if each of you, from his heart, does not forgive his brother his trespasses.”
Mark-3: 28-29	K/V- 28. K/V- 29.	Assuredly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they may utter; ^{29.} “But he who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness but is subject to eternal condemnation”- (Lk-12:10.)
Mark-4: 11-12	K/V- 12.	“So that ‘Seeing they may see and not perceive, And hearing they may hear and not understand; Lest they should turn, and their sins be forgiven them. ’ “
Mark-11: 24-26	K/V- 25.	^{25.} “And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. ^{26.} “But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses.” (Lk-23:34.) (Eph-6:12.)
Luke-5: 17-26	K/V- 21.	And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, “Who is this who speaks blasphemies? Who can forgive sins but God alone?”
Luke-6: 31-37	K/V- 37.	“Judge not, and you shall not be judged, Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.
Luke-7: 36-50	K/V- 47.	“Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little.”
Luke-11: 1-4	K/V-4.	And forgive us our sins, For we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us.
Luke-17: 1-5	K/V- 3.	“Take heed to yourselves. If your brother sins against you, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him.
Luke-23: 32-47	K/V- 34.	Then Jesus said, “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do.” And they divided His garments and cast lots. (2-Cor-3:14-18. ^{14.}) (2-Cor-4:3-4. ^{4.})
John-20: 21-23	K/V- 22.	^{22.} And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. ^{23.} “If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained.”
Acts-5: 30-32	K/V- 31.	“Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Saviour, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.
Acts-8: 14-24	K/V- 22.	“Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you.
Acts-13: 33-41	K/V- 38.	“Therefore let it be known to you, brethren, that though this Man is preached to you the forgiveness of sins. (Matt-26:28.) (Acts-2:38.) (Acts-10:36-43. ^{43.})

Acts-26: 14-18	K/V- 18.	'to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'
Rom-1: 27-32	K/V- 31. K/V- 32.	³¹ . Undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving , unmerciful; ³² .who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things are deserving of death, not only do the same but also approve of those who practice them. (Rom-6:23.)
Rom-4: 1-8	K/V- 7. K/V- 8.	⁷ . "Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven, And whose sins are covered; ⁸ . Blessed is the man to whom the Lord shall not impute sin."
2-Cor-2: 1-11	K/V- 7.	So that, on the contrary, you ought rather to forgive and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one be swallowed up with too much sorrow.
2-Cor-12: 10-13	K/V- 13.	For what is it in which you were inferior to other churches, except that I myself was not burdensome to you? Forgive me this wrong!
Eph-1: 7-10	K/V- 7.	In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace. (John-1:17.) (Eph-2:8-9.)
Eph-4: 29-32	K/V- 32.	And be kind to one another, Tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you. (Matt-18:21-22.) (Matt-18:23-35. ³³)
Col-1: 13-14	K/V- 14.	In whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. (John-14:6.)
Col-2: 11-15	K/V- 13.	And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses.
Col-3: 12-16	K/V- 13.	Bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.
2-Tim-3: 1-5	K/V- 3.	Unloving, unforgiving , slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good.
James-5: 12-16	K/V- 15.	And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.
1-John-1: 7-10	K/V- 9.	If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
1-John-2: 9-12	K/V- 12.	I write to you, little children, Because your sins are forgiven you for His name's sake.
