Matt-3: 5-10	K/V- 10.	“And even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore every tree which does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. (Lk-3:7-9.) (Isa-61:3.)
Matt-7: 15-23	K/V- 20.	“ Therefore by their fruits you will know them. (Gal-5:22-26.)
Matt-12: 33-37	K/V- 33.	“ Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or else make the tree bad and its fruit bad; for a tree is known by its fruit. (Lk-6:43.)
Matt-13: 18-23	K/V- 23.	“But he who received seed on the good ground is he who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and produces: some hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. ” (Mk-4:13-20.) (Lk-8:11-15.)
Matt-21: 17-22	K/V- 19.	And seeing a fig tree by the road, He came to it and found nothing on it but leaves, and said to it, “ Let no fruit grow on you ever again. ” Immediately the fig tree withered away. (Mk-11:12-14.)
Matt-21: 33-46	K/V- 34.	“Now when vintage-time drew near, he sent his servants to the vinedressers, that they might receive its fruit. (Mk-12:1-11.) (Lk-20:9-19.)
Matt-26: 26-29	K/V- 29.	“But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father’s kingdom. (Mk-14:22-25.) (Lk-22:17-22.)
Luke-13: 6-9	K/V- 9.	“ And if it bears fruit, well. But if not, after that you can cut it down. ” (John-15:6.) (1-Thes-4:7.) (Heb-17-19.) (Heb-6:7-8.) (Titus-1:16.)
John-4: 34-38	K/V- 36.	“And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together. (Matt-12:30.)
John-15: 1-10	K/V- 2.	“ Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.
John-15: 11-20	K/V- 16.	“You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.
Acts-14: 17-18	K/V- 17.	“Nevertheless He did not leave Himself without witness, in that He did good, gave us rain from heaven and fruitful seasons, filling our hearts with food and gladness.” (Jam-5:18.)
Rom-1: 11-13	K/V- 13.	Now I do not want you to be unaware, brethren, that I often planned to come to you (but was hindered until now), that I might have some fruit among you also, just as among the other Gentiles.
Rom-6: 19-23	K/V- 21.	What fruit did you have then in the things which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death.
Rom-7: 4-7	K/V- 4.	Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another- to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God.
1-Cor-9: 7-14	K/V- 7.	Who ever goes to war at his own expense? Who plants a vineyard and does not eat of its fruit? Or who tends a flock and does not drink of the milk of the flock?
2-Cor-9: 10-11	K/V- 10.	Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness.
Gal-5: 16-26	K/V- 22. K/V- 23.	But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,²³ Gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.
Eph-5: 1-11	K/V- 9.	(for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth),
Philip-1: 9-11	K/V- 11.	Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.
Philip-1: 21-26	K/V- 22.	But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell.

Philip-4: 16-23	K/V- 17.	Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that abounds to your account.
Colo-1: 3-10	K/V- 6.	Which has come to you, as it has also in all the world, and is bringing forth fruit , as it is also among you since the day you heard and knew the grace of God in truth;
Heb-12: 1-13	K/V- 11.	Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterwards it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.
Heb-13: 12-16	K/V- 15.	Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.
James-3: 13-18	K/V- 18.	Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.
James-5: 7-10	K/V- 7.	Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See how the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth , waiting patiently for it until it receives the early and latter rain.
Jude-1: 9-13	K/V- 12.	These are spots in your love feasts, while they feast with you without fear, serving only themselves. They are clouds without water, carried about by the winds; late autumn trees without fruit , twice dead, pulled up by the roots
Rev-18: 11-14	K/V- 14.	“The fruit that your soul longed for has gone from you , and all the things that are rich and splendid have gone from you, and you shall find them no more at all.
Rev-22: 1-4	K/V- 2.	In the middle of its streets, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits , each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.
