

Glory- Glorified- Glorify.

Matt-5: 14-16	K/V- 16.	“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.
Matt-15: 29-31	K/V- 31.	So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel.
Mark-2: 1-12	K/V- 12.	Immediately he arose, took up the bed, and went out in the presence of them all, so that all were amazed and glorify God, saying, “we never saw anything like this!” <u>(Lk-5:18-26.²⁶)</u>
Luke-2: 8-20	K/V- 20.	Then the shepherds returned glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them.
Luke-7: 11-17	K/V- 16.	Then fear came upon all, and they glorified God, saying, “A great prophet has risen up among us”; and, “God has visited His people.”
Luke-13: 10-17	K/V- 13.	And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.
Luke-17: 11-19	K/V- 18.	“ Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?”
Luke-18: 35-43	K/V- 43.	And immediately he received His sight, and followed Him, glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God.
Luke-23: 44-49	K/V- 47.	So when the centurion saw what had happened, he glorified God, saying, “Certainly this was a righteous man!”
John-7: 37-39	K/V- 39.	But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified. <u>(Acts-5:32.)</u>
John-11: 1-15	K/V- 4.	When Jesus heard that, He said, “ This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it.”
John-12: 19-33	K/V- 23.	But Jesus answered them, saying, “ The hour has come that the Son of man should be glorified. <u>(Jn-17:1-10.⁴)</u> ”
John-13: 21-38	K/V- 31.	So, when he had gone out, Jesus said, “ Now the Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him. ”
John-14: 8-15	K/V- 13.	“And whatever you ask for in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ”
John-15: 1-12	K/V- 8.	“ By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. ”
John-16: 1-16	K/V- 14.	“ He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is mine and declare it to you. ”
John-21: 1-25	K/V- 19.	This He spoke, signifying by what by what death he would glorify God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him, “Follow Me.”
Acts-3: 13-20	K/V- 13.	“The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His servant Jesus, whom you delivered up and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let Him go.
Acts-4: 18-37	K/V- 21.	So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding no way to punish them, because of the people, since they all glorified God for what had been done. <u>(Matt-10:28.)</u>
Acts-11: 1-18	K/V- 18.	When they heard these things they became silent; and they glorified God, saying, “Then God also granted to the Gentiles repentance to life.”
Acts-13: 46-52	K/V- 48.	Now when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and glorified the word of the Lord. And as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed.
Rom-1: 20-25	K/V- 21.	Because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

Rom-8: 16-19	K/V- 17.	And if children, then heirs- heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.
Rom-8: 28-31	K/V- 30.	Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified.
Rom-15: 1-13	K/V- 6.	That you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. (John-17:20-23.)
Gal-1: 20-24	K/V- 24.	And they glorified God in Me. (2-Cor-13:5.) (Gal-4:6.) (1-John-4:2-3.)
2-Thes-1: 10-12	K/V- 12.	That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
2-Thes-3: 1-4	K/V- 1.	Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may run swiftly and be glorified, just as it is with you,
1-Pet-2: 11-15	K/V- 12.	Having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your good works which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation.
1-Pet-4: 1-19	K/V- 14.	If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rest upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified.
1-Pet-4: 16-19	K/V- 16.	Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter.
Rev-15: 1-4	K/V- 4.	Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested.”
