Luke-2: 40-52	K/V- 40.	And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom, <b>and the grace of God was upon Him. (Jn-1:13.)</b>
John-1: 12-14	K/V- 14.	And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, <b>full of grace and truth.</b>
John-1: 16-17	K/V- 17.	For the law was given through Moses, <b>but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.</b>
Acts-4: 33-35	K/V- 33.	And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. <b>And great grace was upon them all.</b>
Acts-11: 23-24	K/V- 23.	<b>When he came and had seen the grace of God,</b> he was glad, and encouraged them all that with purpose of heart they should continue with the Lord.
Acts-13: 42-44	K/V- 43.	Now when the congregation had broken up, many of the Jews and devout proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas, who, speaking to them, <b>persuaded them to continue in the grace of God.</b>
Acts-14: 1-7	K/V 3	Therefore they stayed there a long time, speaking boldly in the Lord, <b>who was bearing witness to the word of his grace,</b> granting signs and wonders to be done by there hands.
Acts-14: 26-28	K/V- 26.	From there they sailed to Antioch, <b>where they had been commended to the grace of God for the work which they had completed.</b>
Acts-15: 10-11	K/V- 11.	<b>“But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved in the same manner on they.”</b>
Acts-18: 27-28	K/V 27.	And when he desired to cross to Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him; and when he arrived, <b>he greatly helped those who had believed through grace;</b>
Acts-20: 21-24	K/V- 24.	“But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, <b>to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.</b>
Acts-20: 30-32	K/V- 32.	“So now, brethren, <b>I commend you to God and to the word of His grace,</b> which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified.
Rom-1: 5-9	K/V- 5.	<b>Through Him we have received grace and apostleship for obedience to the faith among all nations for His name,</b>
Rom-3: 19-25	K/V- 24.	<b>Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.</b>
Rom-4: 1-8	K/V- 4.	Now to him who works, <b>the wages are not counted as grace but as debt.</b>
Rom-5: 1-6	K/V- 1. K/V- 2.	<sup>1</sup> Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup> <b>Through whom also we have access by faith into his grace in which we stand,</b> and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Rom-5: 14-19	K/V- 15.	But the free gift is not like the offence. For if by the one man's offence many died, <b>much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.</b>
Rom-6: 1-10	K/V- 1. K/V- 2.	<sup>1</sup> . What shall we say then? <b>Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound?</b> <sup>2</sup> . Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it?
Rom-6: 13-18	K/V- 14.	For sin shall not have dominion over you, <b>for you are not under law but under grace.</b>
Rom-11: 5-7	K/V- 6.	<b>And if by grace, then it is no longer of works;</b> otherwise grace is no longer grace. But if it is of works, it is no longer grace; otherwise work is no longer work.
Rom-12: 3-15	K/V- 6.	<b>Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us,</b> let us use them: if prophecy, let us prophesy in proportion to our faith;
1-Cor-1: 3-8	K/V- 4.	<b>I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus,</b>
1-Cor-15: 9-10	K/V- 10.	<b>But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain;</b> but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.
2-Cor-1: 12-14	K/V- 12.	For our boasting is this: the testimony of our conscience that we conducted ourselves in the world in simplicity and godly sincerity, <b>not with fleshly wisdom but by the grace of God,</b> and more abundantly toward you.
2-Cor-4: 15-18	K/V- 15.	For all things are for your sakes, <b>that grace, having spread through the many,</b> may cause thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God.
2-Cor-6: 1-2	K/V- 1.	<b>We then, as workers together with Him also plead with you not to receive the grace of God in vain.</b>
2-Cor-9: 5-9	K/V- 8.	<b>And God is able to make all grace abound towards you,</b> that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have abundance for every good work.
2-Cor-12: 7-11	K/V- 9.	And He said to me, <b>"My grace is sufficient for you,</b> for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. ( <u>Eph-6:10.</u> )
Gal-1: 15-16	K/V- 15.	But when it pleased God, <b>who separated me from my mother's womb and called me through His grace.</b>
Gal-2: 20-21	K/V- 21.	<b>"I do not set aside the grace of God;</b> for if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died in vain."
Gal-5: 1-5	K/V- 4.	You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; <b>you have fallen from grace.</b>
Gal- 6: 17-18	K/V- 18.	<b>Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.</b>
Eph-1: 1-8	K/V- 7.	In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, <b>according to the riches of His grace.</b>
Eph-2: 1-9	K/V- 8.	<sup>8</sup> . <b>For by grace you have been saved through faith,</b> and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, <sup>9</sup> . Not of works, lest anyone should boast.
Eph-3: 1-9	K/V- 7.	<b>Of which I became a minister according to the gift of the grace of God given to me by the effective working of His power.</b>
Eph-4: 1-8	K/V- 7.	<b>But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift.</b>
Eph-6: 23-24	K/V- 24.	<b>Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.</b>
Philip-1: 1-11	K/V- 7.	Just as it is right for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart, inasmuch as both in my chains and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel, <b>you all are partakers with me of grace.</b>

Col-3: 16-17	K/V- 16.	Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, <b>singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.</b>
Col-4: 5-6	K/V- 6.	<b>Let your speech always be with grace</b> , seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.
2-Thes-1: 11-12	K/V- 12.	That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, <b>according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.</b>
2-Thes-2: 16-17	K/V- 16.	Now may our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope by <b>grace.</b>
1-Tim-1: 12-15	K/V- 14.	<b>And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant</b> , with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.
1-Tim-6: 20-21	K/V- 21.	By professing it some have strayed concerning the faith, <b>Grace be with you. Amen.</b>
2-Tim-1: 8-9	K/V- 9.	Who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, <b>but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time, began.</b>
2-Tim-2: 1-4	K/V- 1.	You therefore, my son, <b>be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.</b>
Titus-2: 9-15	K/V- 11.	<b>For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,</b>
Titus-3: 4-8	K/V- 7.	<b>That having been justified by His grace</b> we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.
Heb-2: 9-10	K/V- 9.	But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, <b>by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.</b>
Heb-4: 14-16	K/V- 16.	Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of <b>grace that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.</b> (Heb-12:25-29. <sup>28</sup> )
Heb-10: 28-31	K/V- 29.	Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, <b>and insulted the Spirit of grace?</b>
Heb-12: 14-15	K/V- 15.	<b>Looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God;</b> lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled;
Heb-13: 8-14	K/V- 9.	Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. <b>For it is good that the heart be established by grace</b> , not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.
James-4: 1-7	K/V- 6.	But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resist the proud, <b>But gives grace to the humble.</b> "
1-Pet-1: 1-5	K/V- 2.	Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ. <b>Grace to you and peace be multiplied.</b> (2-Pet-1:2-4.)
1-Pet-1: 9-11	K/V- 10.	Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, <b>who prophesied of the grace that would come to you?</b>
1-Pet-1: 13-15	K/V- 13.	Therefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, <b>and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ;</b>
1-Pet-3: 7-9	K/V- 7.	Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as to the weaker vessel, <b>and being heirs together of the grace of life</b> , that your prayers may not be hindered.
1-Pet-4: 8-11	K/V- 10.	As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, <b>as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.</b>

1-Pet-5: 10-11	K/V- 10.	<b>But may the God of all grace,</b> who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.
2-John-2: 1-4	K/V- 3.	<b>Grace, mercy, and peace will be with you from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.</b>
Jude-1: 1-5	K/V- 4.	For certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, <b>who turn the grace of our God into lewdness and deny the only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ.</b>
Rev-1: 4-6	K/V- 4.	John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: <b>Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come,</b> and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne,
