

Healing – Whole.

Matt- 4: 23-25	K/V- 23.	And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.
Matt- 8: 1-4	K/V- 3.	Then Jesus put out His hand and touched him, saying, “I am willing; be cleansed.” Immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
Matt- 8: 5-13	K/V- 7.	(Centurion) And Jesus said to him, “I will come and heal him.” (Lk-7:1-10.)
Matt- 8: 13-15	K/V- 15.	So He touched her hand, and the fever left her. And she arose and served them.
Matt- 8: 16-17	K/V- 16.	When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick,
Matt- 9: 20-22	K/V- 21.	For she said to herself, “If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made well. ” (Mk-5:25-38.) (Lk-8:43.)
Matt- 9: 35-38	K/V- 35.	Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.
Matt- 10: 1-4	K/V- 1.	And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits. To cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease. (Mk-3:14-15.) (Lk-9:1-4.)
Matt- 10: 5-8	K/V- 8.	“Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.
Matt- 12: 9-15	K/V- 13.	Then He said to the man, “Stretch out your hand.” And he stretched it out, and it was restored as whole as the other. (Mk-3:5.) (Lk-6:10.)
Matt- 12: 22-32	K/V- 22.	Then one was brought to Him who was demon-possessed, blind and mute; and He healed him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw.
Matt- 13: 13-15	K/V- 15.	For the hearts of this people have grown dull. Their ears are hard of hearing, And their eyes they have closed, Lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, Lest they should understand with their hearts and turn, So that I should heal them. (Jn-12:37.) (Acts-28:25-28.) (Heb-5:11.)
Matt- 14: 13-14	K/V- 14.	And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.
Matt- 14: 34-36	K/V- 36.	And begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched it were made perfectly well. (Mk-6:54-56.)
Matt- 15: 21-28	K/V- 28.	Then Jesus answered and said to her, “O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire.” And her daughter was healed from that very hour. (Mt-7:6-8.) (Mk-7:24-30. ²⁷ .)
Matt- 15: 29-31	K/V- 30.	Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus’ feet, and He healed them.
Matt- 19: 1-2	K/V- 2.	And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them there.
Mark- 1: 32-34	K/V- 34.	Then He healed many who were sick with various diseases, and cast out many demons; and He did not allow the demons to speak, because they knew Him. (Mk-1:25.) (Lk-4:35.)
Mark- 5: 21-24	K/V- 23.	And begged Him earnestly, saying, “My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live.”
Mark- 5: 25-34	K/V- 29.	Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed. (Lk-8:43-48.)

Mark- 5: 35-43	K/V- 41.	Then He took the child by the hand, and said to her, “Talitha cumi,” which is translated, “Little girl, I say to you, arise.” (Matt-9:25.)
Mark- 6: 1-7	K/V- 5.	Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.
Mark- 6: 12-13	K/V- 13.	And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them. (Jam-5:14.)
Mark- 16: 15-20	K/V- 18.	“They will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”
Luke- 4: 17-19	K/V- 18.	“The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the broken hearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; ¹⁹ To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.”
Luke- 5: 15-26	K/V- 17.	Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was present to heal them. (Jn-6:36-37. ³⁷)
Luke- 6: 17-19	K/V- 19.	And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.
Luke- 8: 1-2	K/V- 2.	And certain woman who had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities- Mary called Magdalene, out of whom had come seven demons,
Luke- 8: 26-39	K/V- 36.	They also who had seen it told them by what means he who had been demon-possessed was healed; (Legion.)
Luke- 8: 41-42 & 50-56	K/V- 50.	But when Jesus heard it, He answered him, saying, “Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well.”
Luke- 9: 11-17	K/V- 11.	But when the multitudes knew it, they followed Him; and He received them and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who had need of healing.
Luke- 9: 37-42	K/V- 42.	And as he was still coming, the demon threw him down and convulsed him. Then Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, healed the child and gave him back to his father.
Luke- 10: 2-12	K/V- 9.	“And heal the sick there, and say to them, The kingdom of God has come near to you.’
Luke- 13: 10-17	K/V- 11. K/V- 12.	¹¹ And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up. ¹² But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, “Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity.”
Luke- 14: 1-5	K/V- 2. K/V- 4.	² And behold, there was a certain man before Him who had dropsy. He took him and healed him. ⁴ But they kept silent. And He took him and healed him, and let him go.
Luke- 17: 11-19	K/V- 12.	Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off.
Luke- 22: 46-53	K/V- 51.	But Jesus answered and said, “Permit even this.” And He touched his ear and healed him.
John- 4: 47-53	K/V- 50.	Jesus said to him, “Go your way; your son lives.” So the man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and went his way.
John- 5: 1-16	K/V- 6.	When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, “Do you want to be made well?”
Acts- 3: 1-12	K/V- 6.	Then Peter said, “Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk. ” (Acts-4:10.) (Acts-4:14.) (Acts-4:22.)
Acts- 4: 27-37	K/V- 30.	“By stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.”
Acts- 5: 1-16	K/V- 15.	So that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them.

Acts- 8: 5-8	K/V- 6.	And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.
Acts- 9: 32-35	K/V- 34.	And Peter said to him, “ Aeneas, Jesus the Christ heals you. Arise and make your bed.” Then he arose immediately.
Acts- 14: 7-18	K/V- 9. K/V- 10.	⁹ . This man heard Paul speaking. Paul, observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed, ¹⁰ . Said with a loud voice, “Stand up straight on your feet!” And he leaped and walked.
Acts- 19: 11-12	K/V- 11. K/V- 12.	¹¹ . Now God worked unusual miracles by the hands of Paul, ¹² . So that even handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out of them.
Acts- 28: 1-10	K/V- 8.	And it happened that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and dysentery. Paul went into him and prayed, and he laid his hands on him and healed him.
1-Cor- 12: 7-11	K/V- 9	To another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit,
1-Cor- 12: 27-31	K/V- 28.	And God has appointed these in the church: first apostle, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues.
James- 5: 13-16	K/V- 16.	Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.
1-Pet- 2: 18-25	K/V- 24.	Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness- by whose stripes you were healed.
3 John: 2		Beloved I pray that you will prosper in all things and be in health just as your souls prosper.
Rev- 22: 1-4	K/V- 2.	In the middle of its streets, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.
Luke- 6: 46-49	K/V- 46.	“ But why do you call Me ‘Lord, ‘Lord,’ and not do the things which I say? ”
Acts- 10: 38-39	K/V- 38.	“How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.
Acts- 19: 13-17	K/V- 13.	(Warning.) Then some of the itinerant Jewish exorcists took it upon themselves to call the name of the Lord Jesus over those who had evil spirits, saying, “We exorcise you by the Jesus whom Paul preaches.”
