| Isa-14: 1-32 | K/V- 15. | Yet you shall be brought down to (She'ol, Hell.) To the lowest depths of the Pit. |
| Matt-5: 21-24 | K/V- 22. | “But I say to you that whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, (‘Ra’ca!’ Greek: 4469- O empty one, thou worthless, as a term of utter vilification.) Shall be in danger of the council. But whoever says, ‘You fool!’ shall be in danger of hell fire. (Gen-1:26-27.) (Jam-3:9.) |
| Matt-5: 29-30 | K/V- 29. | “If your right eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast it from you; for it is more profitable for you that one of your members perish, than for your whole body to be cast into hell. (Matt-18:8-9.) (Mk-9:43-48.) |
| Matt-10: 26-28 | K/V- 28. | “And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul, But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. (Lk-12:5.) (Jn-5:22-23.) (Jn-5:26-29.) |
| Matt-11: 21-24 | K/V- 23. | “And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to hell: for if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. |
| Matt-23: 13-15 | K/V- 15. | “Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you travel land and sea to win one proselyte, and when he is won, you make him twice as much a son of hell as yourselves. |
| Matt-23: 29-33 | K/V- 33. | “ Serpents, blood of vipers! How can you escape the condemnation of hell? |
| Matt-25: 13-30 | K/V- 30. | ‘ And cast the unprofitable servant into outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. ’ |
| Matt-25: 31-46 | K/V- 41. | “Then He will also say to those on the left hand, ‘ Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: |
| Luke-8: 26-39 | K/V- 31. | And they begged Him that He would not command them to go out into the (depthless, infernal, abyss”- deep, bottomless pit.) |
| Luke-16: 19-31 | K/V- 24. | “Then he cried and said, ‘Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. |
| Luke-19: 12-27 | K/V- 27. | ‘But bring here those enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, and slay them before me. |
| John-8: 39-47 | K/V- 44. | “You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it. (Rev-21:27.) (Rev-22:15.) |
| Acts-20: 29-32 | K/V- 29. | “For I know this, that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock. |
| James-3: 5-11 | K/V- 6. | And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell. (Matt-12:36-37.) |
| 2-Pet-2: 1-5 | K/V- 4. | For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment; |
| Rev-14: 9-11 | K/V- 11. | “ And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.” (Rev-13:14-18.) |

| Rev-19: 19-21 | K/V- 20. | Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worship his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. |
| Rev-20: 10-15 | K/V- 15. | And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire. |
| Rev-21: 7-8 | K/V- 8. | “But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.” |

Hell in Hebrew

7585- Sheh-ole’; from 7582; hades or the world of the dead (as if a subterranean retreat), include. Its accessories and inmates:-
grave, hell, pit.

Hell in Greek

- 86 Hades, departed souls, grave, hell**
 - 1067 Place (or state) of everlasting punishment-hell**
 - 5020 The deepest abyss of Hades, to incarcerate in eternal Torment, cast down to hell**
