| Luke-9: 44-45 | K/V- 45. | But they did not understand this saying, and it was <u>hidden</u> from them so that they did not perceive it; and they were afraid to ask Him about this saying. (<u>Lk-18:31-34.</u>) |
| Luke-10: 21-24 | K/V- 21. | In that hour Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, “I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have <u>hidden</u> these things from the wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. (<u>Matt-15:12-14.</u>) |
| Luke-12: 1-3 | K/V- 2. | “For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed, nor hidden that will not be known. (<u>Mk-4:22.</u>) |
| Luke-19: 41-48 | K/V- 42. | Saying, “If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. |
| 1-Cor-2: 1-8 | K/V- 7. | But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for our glory, |
| 1-Cor-4: 1-5 | K/V- 5. | Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each one’s praise will come from God. (<u>Lk-2:35.</u>) (<u>1-Cor-12:10.</u>) (<u>2-Cor-10:4-6.</u> ^{6.}) |
| Eph-3: 8-12 | K/V- 9. | And to make all see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Jesus Christ; |
| Col-2: 1-6 | K/V- 2. K/V- 3. | ^{2.} That their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of god, both of the Father and of Christ, ^{3.} in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge, |
| Col-3: 1-3 | K/V- 3. | For You died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. (<u>1-Cor-2:2.</u>) |
| Heb-4: 13 | K/V- 13. | And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account. |
| 1-Pet-3: 1-6 | K/V- 4. | Rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God. |
| Rev-2: 15-17 | K/V- 17. | “He who has an ear let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. <u>To him who overcomes</u> I will give some of the <u>hidden manna</u> to eat. And I will give him a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except him who receives it.” ‘ |
