

Husbands.

Matt-1: 16-21	K/V- 16.	And Jacob begot Joseph the husband of Mary , of whom was born Jesus who is called Christ.
Mark-10: 11-12	K/V- 12.	“And if a woman divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery.” (Matt-5:31-32.)
Luke-2: 36-40	K/V- 36.	Now there was one, Anna, a prophetess, the daughter of Phanuel, of the tribe of Asher. She was of great age, and had lived with a husband seven years from her virginity;
Luke-16: 18	K/V- 18.	“Whoever divorces his wife and another commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced from her husband commits adultery.
John-4: 16-19	K/V- 18.	“For you have had five husbands , and the one whom you now have is not your husband; in that you spoke truly.”
Acts-5: 1-11	K/V- 9.	Then Peter said to her, “How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door , and they will carry you out.”
Rom-7: 1-3	K/V- 2.	For the woman who has a husband is bound by the law to her husband as long as he lives. But if the husband dies, she is released from the law of her husband. (1-Cor-7:39-40. ³⁹ .)
1-Cor-7: 1-7	K/V- 3.	Let the husband render to his wife the affections due her , and likewise also the wife to her husband.
1-Cor-7: 10-11	K/V- 10.	Now to the married I command, yet not I but the Lord: A wife is not to depart from her husband.
1-Cor-7: 12-17	K/V- 13.	And a woman who has a husband who does not believe , if he is willing to live with her, let her not divorce him.
1-Cor-7: 34-35	K/V- 34.	There is a difference between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman cares about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit. But she who is married cares about the things of the world- how she may please her husband.
1-Cor-14: 34-36	K/V- 35.	And if they want to learn something, let them ask their <u>own husbands</u> at home ; for it is shameful for woman to speak in church. (1-Tim-2:11-15.)
2-Cor-11: 1-4	K/V- 2.	For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy. For I have betrothed you to one husband , that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. (Jn-3:29.) (Rom-7:4.)
Gal-4: 27-31	K/V- 27.	For it is written: “Rejoice, O barren, You who do not bear! Break forth and shout, You who are not in labor! For the desolate has many more children, than she who has a husband. ” (Isaiah-54:1.)
Eph-5: 22-33	K/V- 23.	For the husband is head of the wife , as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body.
Eph-5: 25-28	K/V- 25.	²⁵ . Husbands, love your wives , just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, ²⁶ . That He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, (John-6:63.) (John-15:3.)
Col-3: 18-21	K/V- 18. K/V- 19.	¹⁸ . Wives, submit to your <u>own husbands</u> , as is fitting in the Lord. ¹⁹ . Husbands, love your wives and do not be bitter towards them.
1-Tim-3: 1-5	K/V- 2.	A Bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife , temperate, sober-minded, of good behavior, hospitable, able to teach;
1-Tim-3: 12-13	K/V- 12.	Let deacons be husbands of one wife , ruling their children and their own houses well.
Titus-1: 5-9	K/V- 6.	If a man is blameless, the husband of one wife , having faithful children not accused of dissipation or insubordination.
Titus-2: 1-5	K/V- 4.	That they admonish the young women to love their husbands , to love their children, ⁵ . To be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their <u>own husbands</u> , that the word of God may not be blasphemed.

1-Pet-3: 1-6	K/V- 1.	Wives, likewise be submissive to your <u>own husbands</u> , that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives,
1-Pet-3: 7	K/V- 7.	Husbands, likewise, dwell with them with understanding, giving honor to the wife, as the weaker vessel , and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered. (1-Cor-7:14.)
Rev-21: 1-7	K/V- 2.	Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. (Gal-4:26.) (Rev-3:12.)
