

Idols – Idolatry

Exodus-20: 1-6	K/V- 4. K/V- 5. K/V- 6.	⁴ “You shall not make for yourself a <u>carved image</u>- any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is on the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; ⁵ You shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, ⁶ But showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments. (John-4:23-24.)
Lev-19: 4	K/V- 4.	“Do not turn to idols, nor make for yourselves <u>molded gods</u>: I am the Lord your God.
Lev-26: 1	K/V- 1.	“You shall not make idols for yourselves; neither a <u>carved image</u> nor a <u>sacred pillar</u> shall you rare up for yourselves; nor shall you set up an <u>engraved stone</u> in your land, to bow down to it; for I am the Lord your God.
Lev-26: 30-31	K/V- 30.	I will destroy your high places, cut down your incense alters, and cast your carcasses on the <u>lifeless forms of your idols</u>;
Deut-29: 14-20	K/V- 17.	And you saw their abominations and their idols which were among them- wood and stone silver and gold);
Deut-32: 20-21	K/V- 21.	They have provoked Me to jealousy by what is not God; They have moved Me to <u>anger</u> by their foolish idols. But I will provoke them to jealousy by those who are not a nation; I will move them to anger by a foolish nation.
Judges-17: 1-6	K/V- .5	The man Micah had a shrine, and made an ephod and household idols; and he consecrated one of his sons, who became his priest.
1-Sam-15: 22-23	K/V- 23.	For <u>rebellion</u> is as the sin of <u>witchcraft</u>, And <u>stubbornness</u> is as iniquity and <u>idolatry</u>. Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, He also has rejected you from being king,” (Gal-3:1-4.) (1-Pet-2:9.)
1-Kings-15: 11-14	K/V- 12.	And he banished the perverted persons from the land, and removed all the idols that his fathers had made. (2-Chron-15:8.)
1-Kings-16: 12-13	K/V- 13.	For all the sins of Ba’a.sha and the sins of E’lah his son, by which they had sinned and by which they made Israel sin, in <u>provoking the Lord God of Israel to anger with their idols.</u> (Jer-8:19.)
2-Kings-17: 9-15	K/V- 12.	For they served idols, of which the Lord had said to them, “You shall not do this thing.”
1-Chron-16: 25-26	K/v 26	For all the gods of the peoples are idols, But the Lord made the heavens. (Psalm-96:5.)
2-Chron-11: 14-15	K/V- 15.	Then he appointed for Himself priests for the high places, <u>for the demons, and the calf idols which he had made.</u>
2-Chron-24: 18-22	K/V- 18.	Therefore they left the house of the Lord God of their fathers, and served wooden images and idols; and wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem because of their trespass.
Psalms-24: 1-5	K/V- 4.	He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, Nor sworn deceitfully.
Psalms-26: 1-5	K/V- 4.	I have not sat with idolatrous mortals, Nor will I go in with <u>hypocrites.</u>
Psalms-31: 6	K/V- 6.	I have hated those who regard useless idols; But I trust in the Lord.
Psalms-97: 7-8	K/V- 7.	Let all be put to shame who serve carved images, Who boast of idols. Worship Him, all you gods.
Psalms-106: 34-38	K/V- 36.	They serve their idols, Which became a snare to them.

Psalms-115: 1-9	K/V- 4.	Their idols are silver and gold, The work of men’s hands. (Psalm-135:15-18.) (Isa-2:8.) (Hos-8:4.) (Hos-13:2.) (Amos-5:26-27.)
Isa-2: 17-18	K/V- 20.	But the idols He shall utterly abolish.
Isa-2: 19-22	K/V- 20.	In that day a man will cast away his idols of silver And his idols of gold, Which they made, each for himself to worship, To the moles and bats, (Isa-31:7.)
Isa-10: 10-11	K/V- 10.	As my hand has found the kingdom of idols, Whose carved images excelled those of Jerusalem and Samaria,
Isa-19: 1-4	K/V- 1.	The burden against Egypt. Behold the Lord rides on a swift cloud, And will come into Egypt; The idols of Egypt will totter at His presence, And the heart of Egypt will melt in its midst.
Isa- 45: 16-17	K/V- 16.	They shall be ashamed And also disgraced, all of them; They shall go in <u>confusion</u> together, Who are makers of idols.
Isa-66: 15-18	K/V- 17.	“Those who sanctify themselves and purify themselves, To go to the gardens After an idol in the midst, Eating swine’s flesh and the abomination and the mouse, Shall be consumed together,” says the Lord.
Jer-2: 5-7	K/V- 5.	Thus says the Lord: “What injustice have your fathers found in Me, That they have gone far from Me, Have followed idols, And have become idolaters?
Jer-8: 19	K/V- 19.	Listen! The voice, The cry of the daughter of my people From a far country: “Is not the Lord in Zion? Is not her King in her?”
Jer-10: 8	K/V- 8.	But they are altogether <u>dull-hearted</u> and foolish; A <u>wooden idol</u> is a worthless doctrine.
Jer-14: 22	K/V- 22.	Are there any among the idols of the nations that can cause rain? Or can the heavens give showers? Are You not He, O Lord our God? Therefore we will wait for You, Since You have made all these.
Jer-16: 17-18	K/V- 18.	“And first I will repay double for their iniquity and their sin, because they have defiled My land; they have filled My inheritance with the carcasses of their detestable and abominable idols.”
Jer-18: 15-17	K/V- 15.	“ Because My people have forgotten Me, They have burned incense to worthless idols. And they have caused themselves to stumble in their ways, From the ancient paths, To walk in pathways and not on a highway,
Jer-50: 1-4	K/V- 2.	“Declare among the nations, Proclaim, and set up a standard; Proclaim- do not conceal it- Say, ‘Babylon is taken, Bel is shamed. Mer’o.dach is broken in pieces; Her idols are humiliated, Her images are broken in pieces.’ ”
Jer-50: 38-39	K/V- 38.	A <u>drought</u> is against her waters, and they will be dried up. For it is the land of carved images, and they are insane with their idols.
Ezek-6: 1-14	K/V- 4.	“Then your alters shall be desolate, your incense alters shall be broken, and I will cast down your slain men before your idols.
Ezek-8: 1-12	K/V- 12.	Then He said to me, “Son of man, have you seen what the elders of the house of Israel do in the dark, every man in the room of his idols? For they say, ‘The Lord does not see us, the Lord has forsaken the land.’”
Ezek-14: 1-9	K/V- 7.	“For anyone of the house of Israel, or of the strangers who dwell in Israel, who separates himself from Me and sets up his idols in his heart and puts before him what causes him to stumble into iniquity, then comes to a prophet to inquire of him concerning Me, I the Lord will answer him by Myself.
Ezek-20: 7-39	K/V- 7.	“Then I said to them, ‘Each of you, throw away the abominations which are before his eyes, and do not defile yourselves with the idols of Egypt. I am the Lord your God.’”
Ezek-22: 1-5	K/V- 3.	“Then say, ‘Thus says the Lord God: “The city sheds blood in her own midst, that her time may come; and she makes idols within herself to defile herself. (Ezek-23:7.)”

Ezek-44: 10-12	K/V- 10.	“And the Levites who went far from Me, when Israel went astray, who strayed away from Me after their idols, they shall bear their iniquity.
Hosea-4: 12-19	K/V- 12.	My people ask counsel from their wooden idols, And their staff informs them. For the spirit of harlotry has caused them to stray, And they have played the harlot against their God. (Isaiah-44:19.) (Jer-2:27.)
Zeph-1: 1-18	K/V- 4.	“I will stretch out My hand against Judah, And against all the inhabitants of Jerusalem. I will cut of every trace of Baal from this place, The names of the Idolatrous priest with the pagan priest-. (Hosea-10:5.) (2-Kings-23:4-5.)
Jonah-2: 8	K/V- 8:	“Those who regard worthless idols Forsake their own Mercy. (Jer-10:8.)
Hab-2: 18-20	K/V- 18.	“What profit is the image that its maker should carve it, The molded image, a teacher of lies, That the maker of the mould should trust in it, To make mute idols?
Zech-10: 1-12	K/- 2.	For the idols speak delusion; The diviners envision lies, And tell false dreams; They comfort in vain. Therefore the people wend their way like sleep; They are in trouble because there is no shepherd. (2-Thess-2:7-12. ¹¹)
Zech-13: 1-5	K/V- 2:	“It shall be in that day.” Says the Lord of hosts, “that I will cut off the names of the idols from the land, and they shall no longer be remembered. I will also cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to depart from the land. (Exod-23:13.)
Acts-7: 38-43	K/V- 41.	“And they made a calf in those days, offered sacrifices to the idol, and rejoiced in the works of their own hands. (Deut-9:16.) (Exod-32:17-28.)
Acts-15: 18-20	K/V- 20.	“But that we write to them to abstain from things polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from things strangled, and from blood. (Lev-3:17.) (Acts-15:29.) (Acts-21:25.)
Acts-17: 16-34	K/V- 16.	Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was provoked within him when he saw that the city was given over to idols.
1-Cor-6: 9-11	K/V- 9. K/V- 10.	⁹ Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, ¹⁰ Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.
1-Cor-8: 1-13	K/V- 1.	Now concerning things offered to idols: We know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, but love edifies.
1-Cor-8: 4-6	K/V- 4.	Therefore concerning the eating of things offered to idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is no other God but one. (Mk-12:32.)
1-Cor-10: 1-12	K/V- .7	And do not become idolaters as were some of them. As it is written, “The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play.”
1-Cor-10: 19-22	K/V- 19. K/V- 20.	¹⁹ What am I saying then? That an idol is anything, or what is offered to idols is anything? ²⁰ Rather, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice they sacrifice to demons and not to God, and I do not want you to have fellowship with demons.
1-Cor-10: 27-33	K/V- 28.	But if anyone says to you, “This was offered to idols,” do not eat for the sake of the one who told you, and for conscience’ sake; for “the earth is the Lord’s and all its fullness.
1-Cor -12: 1-3	K/V- 2.	You know that you were Gentiles, carried away to these dumb idols, however you were led.
2-Cor- 6: 16-18	K/V- 16.	And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: “I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people.”
Gal-5: 19-21	K/V- 19. K/V- 20. K/V- 21.	¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, ²⁰ Idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outburst of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, ²¹ Envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; ---will not inherit the kingdom of God. (Eph-5:1-7. ⁵)

Col-3: 1-10	K/V- 5.	Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.
1 Thes-1: 9-10	K/V 9	Turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God.
1-Pet-1: 16-19	K/V- 18.	Knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, (Matt-15:1-9. ³)
1-Pet-4: 1-5	K/V- 3.	For we have spent enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles- when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries.
1-John-5: 21	K/V- 21.	Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.
Rev-2: 13-15	K/V- 14.	“But I have a few things against you, because you have there those who hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the children of Israel to eat, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality.
Rev-9: 20-21	K/V- 20.	²⁰ . But the rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons and idols of gold, silver, brass, stone, and wood, which can neither, see nor hear nor walk. ²¹ . And they did not repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.
Rom-1: 20-26	K/V- 24. K/V- 25.	²⁴ . Therefore God also gave them up to uncleanness, in the lust of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves, ²⁵ . Who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and serve the creature rather than the Creator who is blessed forever. Amen.
John-4: 22-24	K/V- 24.	“God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”
