

## Jesus & Holy Spirit inside us

Matt-10: 17-20	K/V- 20.	“For it is not you who speak, <b>but the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you.</b> (Mk-13:11.)
Matt 28: 20	K/V- 20.	“Teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, <b>I am with you always,</b> even to the end of the age.” Amen. (Luke-6:46.)
Mark-13: 9-11	K/V- 11.	“But when they arrest you and deliver you up, do not worry beforehand, or premeditate what you will speak. But whatever is given you in that hour, speak that; <b>for it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit.</b>
Luke-17: 20-21	K/V- 21.	“Nor will they say, ‘See here!’ or ‘See there!’ For indeed, <b>the kingdom of God is within you.</b> ”
John-3: 13	K/V- 13.	“No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, that is, the Son of Man who is in heaven. (John-3:30.)
John-6: 62-63	K/V- 63.	“ <b>It is the Spirit who gives life;</b> the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life. (John-15:3.) (Eph-5:25-26. <sup>26.</sup> )
John-8: 14-19	K/V- 18.	“I am One who bears witness of Myself, <b>and the Father who sent Me bears witness of Me.</b> ” (Deut-18:15-19.) (Jer-31:31-34.)
John-14: 12-15	K/V- 12.	“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, <b>the works that I do he will do also;</b> and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.
John-14: 16-17	K/V- 16.	“And I will pray the Father, <b>and He will give you another helper, that He may abide with you forever-</b>
John-14: 23-26	K/V- 26.	“But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, <b>He will teach you all things,</b> and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.
John-15: 1-12	K/V- 4. K/V- 5.	<sup>4.</sup> “ <b>Abide in Me, and I in you.</b> As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. <sup>5.</sup> “I am the vine, you are the branches. <b>He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit;</b> for without Me you can do nothing.
John-16: 32-33	K/V- 33.	“These things I have spoken to you, <b>that in Me you may have peace.</b> In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”
John-17: 19-26	K/V- 21.	“ <b>That they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us,</b> that the world may believe that You sent Me.
Acts-15: 8-11	K/V- 8.	“So God, who knows the heart, <b>acknowledged them by giving them the Holy Spirit,</b> just as He did to us.
Rom-5: 1-6	K/V- 5.	Now hope does not disappoint, <b>because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.</b>
Rom-8: 1-11	K/V- 9.	But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, <b>If indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.</b>
Rom-8: 12-16	K/V- 14.	<b>For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are Sons of God.</b>
1-Cor-3: 16-17	K/V- 16.	Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the <b>Spirit of God dwells in you?</b>
1-Cor-6: 19-20	K/V- 19.	<b>Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you,</b> whom you have from God, and you are not your own? (Acts-20:28.)
2-Cor-1: 20-22	K/V- 22.	<b>Who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.</b>
2-Cor-3: 1-4	K/V- 3.	Clearly you are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written not with ink <b>but by the Spirit of the living God,</b> Not on tablets of stone but on tablets of flesh, that is, of the heart.
2-Cor-4: 6-12	K/V- 11. K/V- 12.	<sup>11.</sup> For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus’ sake, <b>that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh.</b> <sup>12.</sup> So then death is working in us, but life in you. (1-Cor-15:31.)

2-Cor-13: 5-6	K/V- 5.	Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. <b>Do you not know yourselves that Jesus Christ is in you?</b> - Unless indeed you are disqualified.
Gal-1: 15-16	K/V- 16.	<b>To reveal His Son in me</b> , that I may preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately confer with flesh and blood,
Gal-1: 23-24	K/V- 24.	<b>And they glorified God in me.</b>
Gal-4: 1-6	K/V- 6.	And because you are sons, <b>God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son <u>into your hearts</u>, crying out, “Abba, Father!”</b> (Rev-3:20.)
Gal-4: 18-20	K/V- 19.	My little children, for whom I labor in birth again until <b>Christ is formed in you.</b> (1-John-2:6)
Gal-5; 22-26	K/V- 25.	<b>If we live in the Spirit</b> , let us also walk in the Spirit. (Rom-8:14.)
Eph-3: 13-21	K/V- 16. K/V- 17.	<sup>16</sup> . That He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, <b>to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man,</b> <sup>17</sup> . <b>that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith;</b> that you, being rooted and grounded in love,
Col-1: 27-27	K/V- 27.	To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: <b>which is Christ in you</b> , the hope of glory.
Col-3: 14-17	K/V- 16.	<b>Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom</b> , teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
2-Thes-1: 10-12	K/V- 12.	<b>That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you</b> , and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
Heb-10: 15-17	K/V- 16.	“This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord: <b>I will put My laws into their hearts</b> , and in their minds I will write them,” (1-Cor-2:16.) (Phil-2:5.)
Heb-13: 5-6	K/V- 5.	Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, <b>“I will never leave you nor forsake you.”</b>
James-4: 4-10	K/V- 8	Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; <b>and purify your hearts</b> , you double –minded. (John-15:3.) (1-Peter-3:15.)
1-Pet-3: 15-17	K/V- 15.	<b>But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts</b> , and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who ask you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;
2-Pet-1: 19-21	K/V- 19.	And so we have the prophetic word confirmed, which you do well to heed as a light that shines in a dark place, <b>until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts;</b> (Acts-5:14-15.) (Rev-2:26-29. <sup>28</sup> ) (Rev-22:16.)
1-John-2: 5-6	K/V- 6.	<b>He who says He abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.</b>
1-John-2: 27		<b>But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you</b> , and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him. (Matt-23:8.) (Luke-12:11-12.) (John-14:26.) (Gal-1:12. Gal-3:25.)
1-John-3: 1-3	K/V- 2.	Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, <b>we shall be like Him</b> , for we shall see Him as He is. (Rom-13:14.)
1-John-4: 1-3	K/V- 2.	By this you know the Spirit of God: <b>Every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is of God.</b> (John-1:10-14.) (Rom-8:1-8. <sup>3</sup> ) (2-Cor-13:5.) (Heb-13:8.)
1-John-4: 4-6	K/V- 4.	You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, <b>because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.</b>
1-John-4: 15-17	K/V- 15.	Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, <b>God abides in him, and he in God.</b>
1-John-5: 1-10	K/V- 10.	<b>He who believes in the Son of God has the witness in himself;</b> he who does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed the testimony that God has given of His Son. (Deut-18:18-19.) (Matt-17:5.) (John-3:16-17.) (John-3:36.) (John-10:27-30.)

Rev-3: 20-22	K/V- 20.	“Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and open the door, <u>I will come in to him and dine with him</u> , and he with Me.
Mark-16: 15-20	K/V- 17. K/V- 18.	<sup>17.</sup> “And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; <sup>18.</sup> “They will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”
Heb-13: 8-10	K/V- 8.	<b>Jesus Christ is the <u>same</u></b> yesterday, today, and forever. ( <u>Luke-1:50.</u> )
