Deut-18: 15-19	K/V- 18.	“I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth, and He speak to them all that I command Him. (<u>Jn-5:46-47.</u>) (<u>Jn-14:10-11.</u>) (<u>Acts-3:22-26.</u>)
Jer-31: 31-34	K/V- 31.	“Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a <u>new covenant</u>. With the house of Israel and with and with the house of Judah- “ <u>not</u> according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord. (<u>Matt-26:28.</u>) (<u>Mk-14:24.</u>) (<u>Lk-22:20.</u>) (<u>Acts-2:38.</u>) (<u>1-Cor-11:28.</u>)
Matt-5: 19-20	K/V- 20.	“For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven. (<u>Job-32:8.</u>) (<u>Matt-11:11.</u>) (<u>Lk-16:15-17.^{16.}</u>) (<u>John-3:3-10.^{10.}</u>) (<u>Rom-10:3-4.</u>)
Matt-5: 21-24	K/V- 22.	“But I say to you that whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment. And whoever says to his brother, ‘Ra’ ca!’ shall be in danger of the council. But whoever says, ‘You fool!’ shall be in danger of hell fire. (<u>1-Jn-4:20-21.</u>)
Matt-5: 27-28	K/V- 28.	“But I say to you that whoever looks at a woman to lust for her has already committed adultery with her in his heart.
Matt-5: 31-32	K/V- 32.	“But I say to you that whoever divorces his wife for any reason except sexual immorality causes her to commit adultery; and whoever marries a woman who is divorced commits adultery. (<u>Rom-7:1-3.</u>) (<u>1-Cor-7:27.</u>)
Matt-5: 33-37	K/V- 34.	“But I Say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God’s throne;
Matt-5: 38-42	K/V- 39.	“But I tell you not to resist an evil person, But whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also. (<u>Lk-6:29.</u>)
Matt-5: 43-48	K/V- 44.	“But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, (<u>Lk-6:27-28.</u>)
Matt-22: 23-33	K/V- 25.	“Now there were with us seven brothers. The first died after he had married, and having no offspring, left his wife to his brother. (<u>Deut-25:5-6.</u>)
Luke-6: 37-38	K/V- 37.	“Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. (<u>Lk-6:28.</u>) (<u>Isa-54:17.</u>)
John-6: 31-36	K/V- 32.	Then Jesus said to them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread from heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread from heaven. (Jn-6:48.) (Exod-16:4-5.) (Neh-9:15.)
Acts-13: 33-41	K/V- 39.	“And by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses.
Heb-7: 11-14	K/V- 12.	For the priesthood being changed, of necessity there is also a change of the law.
Heb-8: 6-13	K/V- 6.	But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises. (<u>Jer-31:31-34.</u>)
Heb-8: 7	K/V- 7.	For if that first covenant had been <u>faultless</u>, then no place would have been sought for a second.
