Matt-2: 9-11	K/V- 10.	When they saw the star, <b>they rejoiced with exceedingly great joy.</b>
Matt-5: 11-12	K/V- 11. K/V- 12.	<sup>11</sup> . “Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. <sup>12</sup> . <b>“Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.</b>
Matt-13: 44	K/V- 44.	“Again, the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and hid; <b>and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.</b>
Matt-25: 14-30	K/V- 21.	“His lord said to him, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. <b>Enter into the joy of your Lord.’</b>
Matt-28: 1-11	K/V- 9.	Went to tell His disciples, behold, <b>Jesus met them, saying, “Rejoice!”</b> So they came and held Him by the feet and worshiped Him.
Luke-1: 26-33	K/V- 28.	And having come in, the angel said to her, <b>“Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among woman!”</b>
Luke-1: 47-56	K/V- 47.	<b>And My spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior. (Lk-1:58.)</b>
Luke-6: 22-23	K/V- 23.	<b>Rejoice in that day and leap for joy!</b> For indeed your reward is great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets.
Luke-10: 17-22	K/V- 20.	“Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, <b>but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.”</b>
Luke-13: 15-17	K/V- 17.	And when He said these things, all His adversaries were put to shame; <b>and all the multitude rejoiced for all the glorious things that were done by Him.</b>
Luke-15: 3-7	K/V- 6.	“And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, <b>saying to them, ‘Rejoice, with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!’ (Lk-15:9-10.)</b>
Luke-19: 35-40	K/V- 37.	Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, <b>the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen,</b>
John-3: 29-30	K/V- 29.	“He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, <b>rejoices greatly because of the bridegroom’s voice.</b> Therefore this joy of mine is fulfilled.
John-4: 34-38	K/V- 36.	“And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, <b>that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together.</b>
John-5: 31-37	K/V- 35.	“He was the burning and shining lamp, <b>and you were willing for a time to rejoice in his light.</b>
John-8: 54-59	K/V- 56.	<b>“Your father Abraham rejoiced to see Me day, and he saw it and was glad.</b>
John-14: 28-31	K/V- 28.	“You have heard Me say to you, ‘I am going away and coming back to you.’ <b>If you loved Me, you would rejoice because I said, ‘ I am going to the Father,’ for My Father is greater than I.</b>
John-15: 1-15	K/V- 11.	“These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, <b>and that your joy may be full.</b>
John-16: 19-24	K/V- 22.	“Therefore you now have sorrow; <b>but I will see you again and your heart will rejoice, and your joy no one will take from you.</b>
John-17: 13-14:	K/V- 13.	“But now I come to you, and these things I speak in the world, <b>that they may have My joy fulfilled in themselves.</b>
Acts-2: 25-28	K/V- 26.	<b>Therefore my heart rejoiced,</b> and my tongue was glad; Moreover my flesh also will rest in hope.

Acts-7: 39-43	K/V- 41.	“And they made a calf in those days, offered sacrifices to the idol, <b>and rejoice in the works of their own hands.</b>
Acts-8: 6-8	K/V- 8.	<b>And there was great joy in that city.</b>
Acts-13: 48-52	K/V- 52.	<b>And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.</b>
Acts-16: 31-34	K/V- 34.	Now when he had brought them into his house, he set food before them; <b>and he rejoiced, having believed in God with all his household.</b>
Acts-20: 18-24	K/V- 24.	“But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, <b>so that I may finish my race with joy</b> , and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.
Rom-5: 1-4	K/V- 2.	---through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, <b>and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. (Rom-5:11-12)</b>
Rom-12: 9-14	K/V- 12.	--- <b>Rejoicing in hope</b> , patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;
Rom-14: 16-18	K/V- 17.	---for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, <b>but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy spirit.</b>
1-Cor-12: 23-28	K/V- 26.	And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, <b>all the members rejoice with it.</b>
1-Cor-13: 1-8	K/V- 6.	--- <b>does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth;</b>
2-Cor-1: 20-24	K/V- 24.	Not that we have dominion over your faith, <b>but are fellow workers for your joy; for by faith you stand.</b>
2-Cor-8: 1-5	K/V- 2.	---that in a great trial of affliction the <b>abundance of their joy</b> and their deep poverty abounded in the riches of their liberality.
Gal-5: 22-26	K/V- 22. K/V- 23.	<sup>22</sup> . <b>But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy</b> , peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> . Gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.
Phil-2: 1-5	K/V- 2.	<b>Fulfill My joy by being like-minded</b> , having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. (Phil-2:16-18.) (Acts-2:1-5. <sup>2</sup> )
Phil-4: 4-7	K/V- 4.	<b>Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I say rejoice! (1-Thes-5:16.)</b>
Col-1; 24-26	K/V- 24.	<b>I now rejoice in my sufferings for you</b> , and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church,
1-Thes-2: 19-20	K/V- 20.	<b>For you are our glory and joy.</b>
1-Thes-3: 9-11	K/V- 9.	For what thanks can we render to God for you, <b>for all the joy with which we rejoice for your sake before our God,</b>
2-Tim-1: 3-4	K/V- 4.	---greatly desiring to see you, being mindful of your tears, <b>that I may be filled with joy.</b>
Phile-1: 1-8	K/V- 7.	<b>For we have great joy and consolation in your love</b> , because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed by you brother.
Heb-10: 32-39	K/V- 34.	---for you had compassion on me in my chains, <b>and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods</b> , knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven.
Heb-12: 1-4	K/V- 2.	---looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, <b>who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross</b> , despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
Heb-12: 1-13	K/V- 11. K/V- 12.	<sup>11</sup> . <b>Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present</b> , but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. <sup>12</sup> . Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees,

James-1: 2-6	K/V- 2.	<sup>2</sup> <b>My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,</b> <sup>3</sup> Knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.
1-Pet-1: 5-9	K/V- 6.	<b>In this you greatly rejoice,</b> though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials,
1 Pet 4: 12-14	K/V 13	<b>But rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's suffering.</b>
1-John-1: 1-4	K/V- 4.	<b>And these things we write to you that your joy may be full.</b>
2-John-1: 1-4	K/V- 4.	<b>I rejoice greatly that I have found some of your children walking in truth,</b> as we received commandment from the Father.
Jude-1: 24-25	K/V- 24.	Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, <b>And to present you faultless Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy.</b>
