

Knowledge

Luke-1: 68-80	K/V- 77.	To give knowledge of salvation to His people By the remission of their sins, (Acts-2:38.)
Luke-11: 52-54	K/V- 52.	“Woe to you lawyers! For you have taken away the key of knowledge. You did not enter in yourselves, and those who were entering in you hindered.”
Acts-24: 22-23	K/V- 22.	But when Felix heard these things, having more accurate knowledge of the Way, he adjourned the proceedings and said, “When Lys’i-as the commander comes down, I will make a decision on your case.”
Rom-1: 24-32	K/V- 28.	And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting;
Rom-2: 17-23	K/V- 20.	---an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, having the form of knowledge and truth in the law.
Rom-3: 19-23	K/V-20.	Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.
Rom-10: 1-4	K/V- 2.	For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge.
Rom-11: 32-36	K/V- 33.	Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out!
Rom-15: 13-14	K/V- 14.	Now I myself am confident concerning you, my brethren, that you are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another.
1-Cor-1: 4-6	K/V- 5.	--- that you were enriched in every thing by Him in all utterance and all knowledge.
1-Cor-8: 1-3	K/V- 1.	Now concerning things offered to idols: We know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, but love edifies.
1-Cor-8: 5-7	K/V- 7.	However, there is not in everyone that knowledge; for some, with consciousness of the idol, until now eat it as a thing offered to an idol; and their conscience, being weak, is defiled.
1-Cor-8: 9-13	K/V- 11.	And because of your knowledge shall the weak brother perish, for whom Christ died?
1-Cor-12: 7-11	K/V- 8.	--- For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit.
1-Cor-13: 1-5	K/V- 2.	And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand and all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.
1-Cor-13: 8-9	K/V- 8.	Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away.
1-Cor-15: 33-34	K/V- 34.	Awake to righteousness, and do not sin; for some do not have the knowledge of God, I speak this to your shame.
2-Cor-2: 14-17	K/V- 14.	Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place.
2-Cor-4: 5-7	K/V- 6.	For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.
2-Cor-6: 1-6	K/V- 6.	By purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love,
2-Cor-8: 7-8	K/V- 7.	But as you abound in everything- in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us- see that you abound in this grace also.

2-Cor-10: 1-6	K/V- 5.	--- casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,
2-Cor-11: 5-7	K/V- 6.	Even though I am untrained in speech, yet I am not in knowledge. But we have been thoroughly manifested among you in all things.
Eph-1: 17-23	K/V- 17.	--- that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him,
Eph-3: 13-21	K/V- 19.	---to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
Eph-4: 11-15	K/V- 13.	---till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the <u>knowledge of the Son of God,</u> to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ;
Phil-1: 9-11	K/V- 9.	And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment.
Phil-3: 8-9	K/V- 8.	Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ.
Col-1: 9-10	K/V- 9.	For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding.
Col-2: 2-3	K/V- 2.	---that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, and attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ,
Col-3: 9-11	K/V- 10.	---and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him,
1-Tim-2: 3-6	K/V- 4.	---who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.
1-Tim-6: 20-21	K/V- 20.	O Timothy! Guard what was committed to your trust, avoiding the profane and idle babblings and contradictions of what is falsely called knowledge-
2-Tim-3: 1-7	K/V- 7.	---always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.
Heb-10: 24-29	K/V- 26.	For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,
2-Pet-1: 1-8	K/V- 2.	Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord,
