

Leave Work – Follow Jesus

Matt-4: 18-25	K/V- 20.	They immediately left their nets and followed Him. (Mk-1:18.)
Matt-8: 19-23	K/V- 22.	But Jesus said to him, “Follow Me, and let the dead bury their own dead.”
Matt-9: 9-11	K/V- 9.	As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, “Follow Me.” So he arose and followed Him. (Mk-2:14.) (Lk-5:27.)
Matt-9: 37-38	K/V- 38.	“Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to Send out laborers into His harvest.”
Matt-16: 23-28	K/V- 24.	Then Jesus said to His disciples, :If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.
Matt-16: 25-26	K/V- 26.	“For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?”
Matt-19: 16-30	K/V- 27.	Then Peter answered and said to Him, “See; we have left all and followed You. Therefore what shall we have?” (Mk-10:17-31. ²⁸) (Lk-18:28.)
Luke-9: 22-27	K/V- 23.	Then He said to them all, “If anyone desires to come after Me, let him <u>deny himself</u>, and take up his <u>cross daily</u>, and follow Me.
Luke-12: 16-21	K/V- 20.	“But God said to him, ‘Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?’
John-6: 26-27	K/V-27.	“Do not labor for the food that perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him.”
John-6: 28-29	K/V- 29.	Jesus answered and said to them, “This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent.” (Lk-6:46.)
John-10: 1-5	K/V- 4.	“And when He brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice.
John-10: 24-30	K/V- 27.	“My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.
John-12: 23-26	K/V- 26.	“If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honor.
John-15: 1-10	K/V- 4.	“Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. ⁵ “I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.
Rom-1: 1-3	K/V- 1.	Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated to the gospel of God.
Rom-1: 16-17	K/V- 17.	For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, “The just shall live by faith.”
Rom-4: 1-8	K/V- 4.	Now to him who works, the wages are not counted as grace but as debt.
Rom-15: 25-27	K/V- 27.	It pleased them indeed, and they are their debtors. For if the Gentiles have been partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister to them in material things.
1-Cor-9: 6-27	K/V- 7.	Who ever goes to war at his own expense? Who plants a vineyard and does not eat of its fruit? Or who tends a flock and does not drink of the milk of the flock?

1-Cor-9: 8-12	K/V- 9.	For it is written in the law of Moses, “You shall not muzzle an ox while it treads out the grain.” Is it oxen God is concerned about?
1-Cor-9: 13-15	K/V- 14.	Even so the Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should live from the gospel. (Isa-61:6-7.)
Phil-4: 17-20	K/V- 19.	And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
2-Tim-2: 1-6	K/V- 4.	No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier. (1-Cor-2:2.)
1-Pet-4: 1-11	K/V- 7.	But the end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers.
1-John-2: 4-6	K/V- 6.	He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.
1-John-2: 15-17	K/V- 15.	Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (James-4:1-6. ⁴) (1-Jn-5:19.)

Luke-22: 35-36	K/V- 35.	And He said to them, “When I sent you without money bag, knapsack, and sandals, did you lack anything? ” So they said, “Nothing.”
John-8: 34-36	K/V- 36.	“Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. (Gal-3:10.)
Rom-7: 4-6	K/V- 6.	But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter.
Gal-3: 10-14	K/V- 13.	Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”),
Gen-3: 17-24	K/V- 17.	Then to Adam He said, “Because you have heeded the voice of your wife, and have eaten from the tree of which I commanded you, saying, ‘You shall not eat of it’: “Cursed is the ground for your sake; In toil you shall eat of it All the days of your life.
Jer-17: 5-7	K/V- 5.	Thus says the Lord: “Cursed is the man who trusts in man And makes flesh his strength, Whose heart departs from the Lord. (John-2:24-25.) (John-10:27-30.) (Rom-3:23.) (Rom-8:14.)
