

Lose salvation.

(Matt-4:4.) (2-Tim-3:16-17.) (Heb-13:8.) (Rev-22:18-21.)

Matt-3: 1-18	K/V- 8.	Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance. (<u>Lk-3:7-9.^{8.}</u>)
Matt-5: 20	K/V- 20.	“For I say to you, that unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.
Matt-6: 22-24	K/V- 24.	“ No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. (<u>1-Tim-6:10.</u>) (<u>Jam-4:4.</u>) (<u>1-Jn-2:15-17.</u>) (<u>1-John-5:19.</u>)

Mark-3: 21-30	K/V- 29.	“ But he who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is subject to eternal condemnation”-
Mark-7: 5-9	K/V- 9.	He said to them, “ All to will you reject the commandments of God, that you may keep your traditions. (Matt-17:5.)
Mark-8: 34-38	K/V- 38.	“ For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words in this adulterous and sinful generation, of him the Son of Man also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels.” (Matt 24:35)
Luke-6: 43-45	K/V- 43.	“ For a good tree does not bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. (Matt-15:13.) (Gal 5:19-26.)
Luke-6: 46-49	K/V- 46.	“ But why do you call Me, ‘Lord, ‘Lord,’ and do not do the things I say? (Matt-7:24-27. ^{24.}) (Jam-1:22.)
Luke-11: 23	K/V- 23.	“ He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters.
Luke-13: 6-9	K/V- 9.	---‘ And if it bears fruit, well. But if not, after that you can <u>cut it down.</u>’ ”
Luke-13: 23-30	K/V- 24.	“Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I say to you, will seek to enter and will not be able. (Jn-10:9.) (Jn-14:6)
John-3: 16-21	K/V- 19.	“And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. (Jn-8:12.)

John-15: 1-12	K/V- 6.	“If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. (1-Jn-2:6.)
Acts-4: 10-12	K/V- 12.	“ Nor is there salvation in any other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved. ”
Rom- 2: 23-29	K/V- 24.	For “ the name God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you, ” as it is written. (Rom-6:23.)
Rom-6: 1-7	K/V- 1.	^{1.} What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? ^{2.} Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it? (Gal-2:11-21. ^{14.})
Rom-6: 22-23	K/V- 23.	--- For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
Rom-11: 16-23	K/V- 22.	Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off. (Jn-15:6.)
Rom-12: 1-2	K/V- 2.	And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (James 4: 4) (1-Jn-2:15-17.) (1-Jn-5:19.)
Rom-13: 10-14	K/V- 12.	The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.
1-Cor-6: 9-11	K/V- 9.	^{9.} Do you not know that the unrighteous <u>will not inherit the kingdom of God?</u> Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, ^{10.} Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God. (2-Cor-6:17-18.) (Rev-21:8.)

1-Cor-15: 334	K/V- 33.	Do not be deceived: “Evil company corrupts good habits.”
2-Cor-6: 14-18	K/V- 14.	Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness?
Eph-4: 17-20	K/V- 17.	This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk , in the futility of their mind, (1-Cor-2:16.) (Phili-2:5.)
Eph-4: 29-30	K/V- 29.	Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth , but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers. (Matt 12:37)
Phili-2: 12-13	K/V- 12.	Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling;
1-Thes-4: 7-8	K/V- 7.	For God did not call us to uncleanness, but to holiness. (1-Peter-1:16.) (1-Jn-2:1-5. ⁴)
1-Thes-5: 1-9	K/V- 6.	Therefore let us not sleep , as others do, but let us watch and be sober. (Matt-26:41.) (Mk-13:33.) (Mk-14:38.) (Lk-21:36.)
Titus-1: 15-16	K/V- 16.	They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him , being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work. (2-Tim-3:5.)
Heb-3: 7-19	K/V- 12	Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God;
Heb-3: 18-19	K/V- 19.	So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.
Heb-4: 1-3	K/V- 2.	² For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them , not being mixed with faith in those who heard it. ³ For we who have believed do enter that rest , as He has said: “So I swore in My wrath, ‘They shall not enter My rest,’”
Heb-6: 1-8	K/V- 8.	But if it bears thorns and briars, it is rejected and near to being cursed, whose end is to be burned. (Gen-3:18-19)
Heb-10: 26-31	K/V- 29.	Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, Will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God under foot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?
Heb-12: 5-20	K/V- 15.	Looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled;
1-John-1: 5-9	K/V- 6.	If we say we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. (1-Jn-2:6.)
1-John-1: 10	K/V- 10.	If we say that we have not sinned , we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. (Rom-3:4.) (Rom-3:23.)
1-John-2: 9-11	K/V- 9.	He who says he is in the light, and hates his brother, is in darkness until now.
1-John-2: 15-18	K/V- 15.	Do not love the world or the thing in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in Him. (Jn-3:16.) (Gal-4:6.) (2-Cor-13:5.) (1-Jn-5:19.)
Rev-2: 1-5	K/V- 5.	“Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lamp stand from its place- unless you repent.
Rev-3: 5	K/V- 5.	“ He who overcomes shall be clothed in white garments, and I will not blot out his name from the Book of life; but I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels. (Jn-16:33.) (Rom-12:21.) (1-Jn-2:14.) (1-Jn-4:4.) (1-Jn-5:4-5.) (Rev-2:7.) (Rev-2:11.) (Rev-2:17.) (Rev-2:26.) (Rev-12:11.) (Rev-21:7.)

2-Tim-3: 16-17	K/V- 16.	^{16.} All Scripture is given by God , and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, ^{17.} That the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.
Rev-22: 18-19	K/V- 18. K/V- 19.	^{18.} For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; ^{19.} And if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophesy, God shall take away his part from the Book of life , from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.
2-Pet-1: 17-21	K/V- 21	For prophecy never came by the will of man, but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

So then you can see that if you do not believe people can lose their salvation you would have to remove many of these scriptures, and you can if you like but I will not. God bless you.
