K/V- 44.	<sup>43</sup> . “You have heard that it was said, ‘You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemies.’ <sup>44</sup> . <b>“But I say to you, love your enemies,</b> bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, ( <u>Lk-6:27-28.</u> )
Matt-6: 5-18	K/V- 5.	“And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. <b>For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets,</b> that they may be seen by men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward.
Matt-6: 24-25	K/V- 24.	“No one can serve two masters; <b>for either he will hate the one and love the other,</b> or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. ( <u>Lk-16:13.</u> ) ( <u>1-Tim-6:10.</u> )
Matt-19: 18-19	K/V- 19.	‘Honor your father and your mother,’ and, <b>‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’”</b>
Matt-22: 36-40	K/V- 37. K/V- 38. K/V- 39. K/V- 40.	<sup>37</sup> . Jesus said to him, <b>“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart,</b> with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ <sup>38</sup> . “This is the first and great commandment. <sup>39</sup> . “And the second is like it: <b>‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’</b> <sup>40</sup> . “On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.” ( <u>Mk-12:30-34.</u> ) ( <u>Lk-10:27.</u> )
Matt-23: 1-10	K/V- 6.	<b>“They love the best places at feast,</b> the best seats in the synagogues, ( <u>Mk-12:38-40.</u> ) ( <u>Lk-20:45-47.</u> )
Matt-24: 10-13	K/V- 12.	“And because lawlessness will abound, <b>the love of many will grow cold.</b> ( <u>Mat-7:21:23.</u> <sup>23.</sup> )
Luke-6: 32-35	K/V- 32.	<b>“But if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them.</b>
Luke-7: 36-50	K/V- 42.	“And when they had nothing with which to repay, he freely forgave them both. Tell Me, therefore, <b>which of them will love him more?”</b>
Luke-11: 39-44	K/V- 42.	“But woe to you Pharisees! For you tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, <b>and pass by justice and the love of God.</b> These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.
John-5: 37-42	K/V- 42.	<b>“But I know you, that you do not have the love of God in you.</b> ( <u>Matt-17:5.</u> ) ( <u>2-Cor-13:5.</u> )
John-8: 42-47	K/V- 42.	Jesus said to them, “If God were your Father, you would <b>love Me,</b> for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me. ( <u>Deut-18:18-19.</u> ) ( <u>Jn-3:16.</u> )
John-11: 1-7	K/V- 3.	Therefore the sisters sent to Him, saying, “Lord, behold, <b>he whom You love is sick.</b>
John-13: 34-35	K/V-34.	<b>“A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.</b> ( <u>1-Thes-4:9.</u> ) ( <u>2-Thes-1:3-4.</u> )
John-14: 15-21	K/V- 15.	<b>“If you love Me, keep My commandments.</b>
John-14: 23-31	K/V-23.	Jesus answered and said to him, <b>“If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him,</b> and We will come to him and make Our home with him.
John-15: 1-27	K/V- 9. K/V- 10.	<sup>9</sup> . <b>“As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love.</b> <sup>10</sup> . <b>“If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father’s commandments and abide in His love.</b>
John-15: 12-13	K/V- 13.	<b><u>Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one’s life for his friends.</u></b>
John-17: 20-26	K/V- 25. K/V- 26.	<sup>25</sup> . “O righteous Father! The world has not known You, and these have known that You sent Me. <sup>26</sup> . “And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it, <b>that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them.”</b>

John-21: 15-18	K/V- 15.	So when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon, Son of Jonah, <b>do you love Me more than these?</b> ” He said to Him, “Yes, Lord; You know that I love You.” He said to him, “Feed My lambs.”
Rom-5: 3-6	K/V- 5.	Now hope does not disappoint, <b>because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.</b>
Rom-5: 8-9	K/V- 8.	<b>But God demonstrates His own love toward us</b> , in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
Rom-8: 28-34	K/V- 28.	<b>And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God.</b> To those who are called according to His purpose.
Rom-8: 35-36	K/V- 35.	<b>Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?</b> Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
Rom-12: 9-10	K/V- 9.	<b>Let love be without hypocrisy.</b> Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.
Rom-13: 8-14	K/V- 8.	<b>Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law.</b>
Rom-14: 13-16	K/V- 15.	Yet if your brother is grieved because of your food, <b>you are no longer walking in love.</b> Do not destroy with your food the one for whom Christ died.
Rom-15: 29-33	K/V- 30.	Now I beg you, brethren, through the Lord Jesus Christ, <b>and through the love of the Spirit</b> , that you strive together with me in prayers to God for me,
1-Cor-2: 9-11	K/V- 9.	But as it is written: “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, <b>Nor have entered onto the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him.</b> ”
1-Cor-4: 18-21	K/V- 21.	What do you want? Shall I come to you with a rod, <b>or in love and a spirit of gentleness?</b> (1-Cor-11:31-32.) (Heb-12:5-8.)
1-Cor-8: 1-3	K/V- 1.	Now concerning things offered to idols: We know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, <b>but love edifies.</b>
1-Cor-11 1-13	K/V- 1.	Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, <b>but have not love</b> , I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.
1-Cor-14: 1-5	K/V- 1.	<b>Pursue love</b> , and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.
1-Cor-16: 22-24	K/V-22.	<b>If anyone does not love the Lord Jesus Christ, let him accursed. O Lord, come!</b>
2-Cor-2: 1-9	K/V- 8. K/V- 9.	<sup>8</sup> . <b>Therefore I urge you to reaffirm your love to him.</b> <sup>9</sup> . For to this end I also wrote that I might put you to the test, whether you are obedient in all things.
2-Cor-6: 1-12	K/V- 6.	--- By purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, <b>by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love.</b> (1-Cor-16:13-16. <sup>14</sup> )
2-Cor-8: 1-9	K/V- 8.	I speak not by commandment, <b>but I am testing the sincerity of your love by the diligence of others.</b>
2-Cor-8: 23-24	K/V- 24.	Therefore show them, and before the churches the <b>proof of your love</b> and of our boasting on your behalf.
2-Cor-13: 8-14	K/V- 11.	Finally, brethren, farewell. Become complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; <b>and the God of love and peace will be with you.</b>
Gal-5: 5-9	K/V- 6.	For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision avails anything, <b>but faith working through love.</b>
Gal-5: 13-14	K/V- 13.	For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, <b>but through love serve one another.</b>
Gal-5: 22-26	K/V- 22.	<sup>22</sup> . <b>But the fruit of the Spirit is love</b> , joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> . Gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.
Eph-1: 2-18	K/V- 4.	--- Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, <b>that we should be Holy and without blame before Him in love.</b>

Eph-2: 1-6	K/V- 4. K/V- 5.	<sup>4</sup> . But God, who is rich in mercy, <b>because of His great love with which He loved us.</b> <sup>5</sup> . Even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),
Eph-3: 14-20	K/V- 17.	---that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, <b>being rooted and grounded in love.</b> (Gal-4:6.)
Eph-4: 1-6	K/V- 1. K/V- 2.	<sup>1</sup> . I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, <sup>2</sup> . With all lowliness and gentleness, <b>with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love.</b>
Eph-4: 11-16	K/V- 15.	--- <b>but speaking the truth in love,</b> may grow up in all things into Him who is the head- Christ-
Eph-5: 1-2	K/V- 2.	<b>And walk in love, as Christ as also has loved us and given Himself for us,</b> an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet- smelling aroma.
Eph-5: 25-33	K/V- 28.	<b>So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself.</b> (Col-3:19.)
Eph-6: 23-24	K/V- 23. K/V- 24.	<sup>23</sup> . <b>Peace to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.</b> <sup>24</sup> . <b>Grace be with all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.</b>
Phil-1: 9-11	K/V- 9.	<b>And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment.</b> (1-Thes-3:12.)
Phil-1: 16-19	K/V- 17.	--- <b>but the latter out of love,</b> knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the gospel.
Phil-2: 1-6	K/V- 1.	Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, <b>if any comfort of love,</b> If any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy,
Col-1: 1-5	K/V- 4.	--- <b>since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus and your love for all the saints;</b> (Col-1:8-10. <sup>8</sup> ) (Col-2:2.)
Col-1: 10-15	K/V- 13.	<b>He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,</b>
Col-2: 1-3	K/V- 2.	---that their hearts may be encouraged, <b>being knit together in love,</b> and attaining to all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ,
Col-3: 12-16	K/V- 14.	<b>But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.</b>
1-Thes-1: 1-6	K/V- 3.	---remembering without ceasing your work of faith, <b>labor of love,</b> and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father, (1-Thes-3:6.)
1-Thes-5: 8-11	K/V- 8.	But let us who are of the day be sober, <b>putting on the breastplate of faith and love,</b> and as a helmet the hope of salvation. (1-Thes-5:12-15. <sup>13</sup> )
2-Thes-2: 9-12	K/V- 10.	---and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, <b>because they did not receive the love of the truth,</b> that they might be saved. (Jn-3:16.) (Jn-14:6.)
2-Thes-3: 5-7	K/V- 5.	<b>Now may the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God and into the patience of Christ.</b>
1-Tim-1: 5-8	K/V- 5.	<b>Now the purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart,</b> from a good conscience, and from sincere faith,
1-Tim-1: 12-15	K/V- 14.	And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, <b>with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.</b>
1-Tim-2: 11-15	K/V- 15.	<b>Nevertheless she will be in saved in childbearing if they continue in faith, love, and holiness, with self-control.</b> (Gen-3:16.) (1-Cor-14:34-36.) (Rev-2:20.)
1-Tim-4: 12-13	K/V- 12.	Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, <b>in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, and in purity.</b> (2-Tim-1:13.) (2-Tim-2:22.)
1-Tim-6: 6-10	K/V- 10.	For the <b>love of money</b> is the root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. (Mat-13:22.)

2-Tim-1: 6-10	K/V- 7.	For God has not given us a spirit of fear, <b>but of power and of love and of a sound mind.</b>
2-Tim-2: 21-23	K/V- 22.	Flee also youthful lust; <b>but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.</b>
2-Tim-3: 8-12	K/V- 10.	But you have carefully followed my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, <b>Faith, longsuffering, love, perseverance,</b>
Titus-2: 1-5	K/V- 4.	---that they admonish the young woman to love their husbands, <b>to love their children,</b>
Titus-3: 4-6	K/V- 4.	<b>But when the kindness and the love of God our Savoir toward man appeared,</b>
Titus-3: 14-15	K/V- 15.	All who are with me greet you. <b>Greet those who love us in the faith.</b> Grace be with you all. Amen.
Phile-1: 4-7	K/V- 7.	<b>For we have great joy and consolation in your love,</b> because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed by you, brother.
Heb-6: 9-11	K/V- 10.	For God is not unjust to forget your work and <b>labor of love</b> which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.
Heb 10: 23-25	K/V- 24. K/V- 25.	<sup>24.</sup> <b>And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works,</b> <sup>25.</sup> Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.
Heb-13: 1-2	K/V- 1. K/V- 2.	<sup>1.</sup> <b>Let brotherly love continue.</b> <sup>2.</sup> Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have unwittingly entertained angels.
Jam-1: 12-16	K/V- 12.	Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, <b>he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.</b>
Jam-2: 1-10	K/V- 8.	If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, <b>“You shall love your neighbor as yourself,” you do well;</b>
1-Pet-1: 3-10	K/V- 8.	<b>Jesus Christ:</b> <sup>8.</sup> <b>Whom having not seen you love.</b> Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory,
1-Pet-1: 22-25	K/V- 22.	<b>Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, (Jn-13:34-35.)</b>
1-Pet-2: 13-19	K/V- 17.	<b>Honor all people. Love the brotherhood, Fear God. Honor the king.</b>
1-Pet-3: 8-12	K/V- 10.	<b>For “He who would love life And see good days, Let him refrain his tongue from evil, And his lips from speaking deceit.</b>
1-Pet-4: 8-9	K/V- 8.	<b>And above all things have fervent love for one another, for “love will cover a multitude of sins.”</b>
1-Pet-5: 14	K/V- 14.	<b>Greet one another with a kiss of love.</b> Peace to you all who are in Christ Jesus. Amen. (Rom-16:16.) (1-Cor-16:20.) (2-Cor-13:12.) (1-Thes-5:26.) (2-Pet-1:7.)
1-John-2: 1-6	K/V- 5.	But whoever keeps His word, <b>truly the love of God is perfected in him.</b> By this we know that we are in Him.
1-John-2: 15-17	K/V- 15.	<b>Do <u>not</u> love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is <u>not</u> in him. (Jn-3:16.) (2-Cor-13:5.) (Gal-4:6.) (1-Jn-5:19.)</b>
1-John-3: 1-2	K/V- 1.	<b>Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us,</b> that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.
1-John-3: 10-12	K/V- 10.	In this the children of God and the children of the devil are manifest: Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, <b>nor is he who does not love his brother.</b>
1-John-3: 13-21	K/V- 14.	<b>We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love his brother abides in death. (Rom-6:23.)</b>
1-John-3: 22-24	K/V- 23.	<b>And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment. (Jn-13:34.)</b>

1-John-4: 1-7	K/V- 7.	<b>Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.</b>
1-John-4: 8-14	K/V- 12.	<b>No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us. (1-Jn-4:15-16.)</b>
1-John-4: 15-21	K/V- 18.	<b>There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear</b> , because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.
1-John-5: 1-5	K/V- 2.	<b>By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and keep His commandments. (Lk-6:46.)</b>
3-John-1: 1-14	K/V- 6.	<b>---who have borne witness of your love before the church.</b> If you send them forward on their journey in a manner worthy of God, you will do well,
Jude-1: 2	K/V- 2.	<b>Mercy, peace, and love be multiplied to you.</b>
Jude-1: 9-14	K/V- 12.	<b>These are spots in your love feasts</b> , while they feast with you without fear, serving only themselves. They are clouds without water, carried about by the winds; late autumn trees without fruit, twice dead, pulled up by the roots;
Jude-1: 20-21	K/V- 20. K/V- 21.	<sup>20</sup> . But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, <sup>21</sup> . <b>Keep yourselves in the love of God</b> , looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
Rev-2: 1-7	K/V- 4.	“Nevertheless I have this against you, <b>that you have left your first love.</b> (Matt-10:37-38.)
Rev-2: 18-29	K/V- 19.	“ <b>I know your works, love</b> , service, faith, and your patience; and as for your works, the last are more than the first.
Rev-3: 19-22	K/V- 19.	“ <b>As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten.</b> Therefore be zealous and repent.
Rev-12: 10-12	K/V- 11.	“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, <b>and they did not love their lives to the death.</b> (Mat-16:25-26.)

Mark-10: 17-27	K/V- 21.	<b>Then Jesus, looking at him, loved him</b> , and said to him, “One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, take up the cross, and follow Me.”
Luke-7: 40-50	K/V- 47.	“Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, <b>for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little.</b>
John-3: 16-21	K/V- 16.	“ <b>For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son</b> , that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
John-11: 33-43	K/V- 36.	<b>Then the Jews said, “See how He loved him!”</b>
John-12: 42-43	K/V- 43.	<b>---for they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God.</b> (Luke-6:26.) (Luke-16:15.)
John-13: 1	K/V- 1.	Now before the feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, <b>having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.</b> (Jn-13:23.)
John-16: 25-28	K/V- 27.	“ <b>For the Father himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God.</b>
John-19: 25-27	K/V- 26.	When Jesus therefore saw His mother, <b>and the disciple whom He loved standing by</b> , He said to His mother, “Woman, behold your son!”
