Matt-5: 7-8	K/V- 7.	Blessed are the merciful, For they shall obtain mercy.
Matt-9: 10-13	K/V- 13.	“But go and learn what this means: ‘I desire mercy and not sacrifice.’ For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance.” (Matt-12:1-8. ⁷) (Heb-10:5-8. ⁸)
Matt-9: 27-31	K/V- 27.	When Jesus departed from there, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, “Son of David, have mercy on us!” (Matt-20:29-34. ³¹)
Matt-15: 21-28	K/V- 22.	And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, “Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed.”
Matt-17: 14-21	K/V- 15.	“Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire and often into the water.
Matt-23: 23-26	K/V- 23.	“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithes of mint and anise and cummin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.
Mark-10: 46-52	K/V- 47.	Bartimaeus: And when he had heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out and say, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” (Lk-18:35-43. ³⁸)
Luke-1: 45-58	K/V- 50.	And His mercy is on those who fear Him From generation to generation. (Heb-13:8.)
Luke-1: 67-80	K/V- 72.	To perform the mercy that was promised to our fathers And to remember His holy covenant,
Luke-6: 35-36	K/V- 36.	“Therefore be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful.
Luke-10: 28-37	K/V- 37.	And He said, “He who showed mercy on him.” Then Jesus said to him “Go and do likewise.”
Luke-16: 19-31	K/V- 24.	“Then he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.’ (Heb-9:27.) (Rev-2:11.) (Rev-20:6.) (Rev-20-14-15.) (Rev-21:8.)
Luke-17: 11-19	K/V- 13.	Lepers: And they lifted up their voices and said, “Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!”
Luke-18: 9-14	K/V- 13.	“And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, ‘God, be merciful to me a sinner!’ (Rom-3:23.)
Acts-13: 33-35	K/V- 34.	“And that He raised Him from the dead, no more to return to corruption, He has spoken thus: ‘I will give you the sure mercies of David.’
Rom-9: 14-29	K/V- 18.	Therefore He has mercy on whom He wills, and whom He wills He hardens.
Rom-11: 26-36	K/V- 30. K/V- 31.	³⁰ For as you were once disobedience to God, yet have now obtained mercy through their disobedience, ³¹ Even so these also have now been disobedient, that through the mercy shown to you they also may obtain mercy.
Rom-12: 1-8	K/V- 8.	---he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.
Rom-15: 7-12	K/V- 9.	--- and that the Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy, as it is written: “For this reason I will confess to You among the Gentiles, And sing to Your name.”
1-Cor-7: 25-26	K/V- 25.	Now concerning virgins: I have no commandment from the Lord; yet I give judgment as one whom the Lord in His mercy has made trustworthy.
2-Cor-1: 2-7	K/V- 3.	Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort,
2-Cor-4: 1-2	K/V- 1.	Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we do not lose heart.

Gal-6: 15-18	K/V- 16.	And as many as walk according to this rule, peace and mercy be upon them, and upon the Israel of God.
Eph-2: 1-9	K/V- 4.	But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,
Phil-2; 1-5	K/V- 1.	Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy.
Phil-2: 25-30	K/V- 27.	For indeed he was sick almost unto death; but God had mercy on him, and not only on him but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.
Col-3: 12-15	K/V- 12. K/V- 13.	¹² Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering;
1-Tim-1: 1-2	K/V- 2.	To Timothy, a true son in the faith: Grace, mercy and peace from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord. (2-Tim-1:2.) (Titus-1:4.) (2-Jn-1:1-4.³)
1-Tim-1: 12-16	K/V- 13.	---although I was formerly a blasphemer, a persecutor, and an insolent man; but I obtained mercy because I did it ignorantly in unbelief. (Acts-3:14-21.) (Acts-17:29-32.)
Heb-2: 11-18	K/V- 17.	Therefore, in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.
Heb-4: 12-16	K/V- 16.	Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
Heb-8: 5-13	K/V- 12.	“For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more.”
Heb-9: 1-12	K/V- 5.	--- and above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail.
Heb-10: 23-30	K/V- 28. K/V- 29.	²⁸ Anyone who has rejected Moses’ law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. ²⁹ Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?
James-2: 13-17	K/V- 13.	For judgment is without mercy to the one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment.
James-3: 13-18	K/V- 17.	But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.
James-5: 9-11	K/V- 11.	Indeed we count them blessed who endure. You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end intended by the Lord is very compassionate and merciful.
1-Pet-1: 1-8	K/V- 3.	Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,
1-Pet-2: 9-11	K/V- 10.	---who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.
Jude-1: 2.	K/V- 2.	Mercy, peace, and love be multiplied in you.
Jude-1: 21-25	K/V- 21.	Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
