Matt-4: 8-11	K/V- 9.	And he said to Him, “ All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me. ”
Matt-13: 18-23	K/V- 22.	“Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful. (Mk-4:18-19.) (Lk-8:14.)
Matt-19: 16-24	K/V- 21.	Jesus said to him, “If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me. ” (Mk-10:21.) (Acts-4:33-37.)
Matt-19: 23-26	K/V- 23.	Then Jesus said to His disciples, “Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven. (Mk-10:23.) (Lk-18:25.)
Matt-22: 17-22	K/V- 21.	They said to Him, “Caesar’s.” And He said to them, “ Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s, and to God the things that are God’s. ” (Mk-12:12-17. ¹⁷) (Lk-20:20-26. ²⁵)
Matt-25: 41-46	K/V- 42.	‘for I was hungry and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink; (Jam-2:1-8. ⁴)
Matt-26: 14-16	K/V- 14. K/V- 15.	¹⁴ . Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priest ¹⁵ . And said, “What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?” And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver. (Rev-13:11-18. ¹⁷) (Rev-14:9-11.)
Luke-1: 52-53	K/V- 53.	He has filled the hungry with good things, And the rich He has sent away empty. (Acts-11:28.)
Luke-6: 24-26	K/V- 24.	“But woe to you who are rich, For you have received your consolation.
Luke-12; 13-21	K/V- 15.	And He said to them, “Take heed and beware of covetousness, For one’s life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses. ”
Luke-12: 16-31	K/V- 20. K/V- 21.	“But God said to him, ‘Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?’ “So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich towards God.” (Rev-3:17-18.)
Luke-16: 9-13	K/V- 13.	“No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. ”
Luke-16: 10-15	K/V- 14.	Now the Pharisees, who were lovers of money, also heard all these things, and they derided Him. (1-Tim-6:10.)
Luke-16: 19-31	K/V- 19.	“There was a certain rich man who was clothed in purple and fine linen and fared sumptuously every day.
Luke-18: 18-22	K/V- 22.	So when Jesus heard these things, He said to him, “You still lack one thing. Sell all what you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me. ”
Luke-18: 23-27	K/V- 25.	“For it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.”
Acts-5: 1-11	K/V- 3.	But Peter said, “Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself? (Lk-22:3-6.) (John-8:43-44. ⁴⁴) (John-10:10.)

Acts-8: 13-24	K/V- 20.	But Peter said to him, “Your money perishes with you, because you thought that the gift of God could be purchased with money! (Matt-10:7-10.⁸)
Rom-1: 16-17	K/V- 17.	For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, The just shall live by faith.”
Rom-11: 11-12	K/V- 12.	Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness!
2-Cor-8: 1-2	K/V- 2.	---that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded in the riches of their liberality.
Phili-3: 7	K/V- 7.	But what things were gain to me, these I have counted loss for Christ.
Phil-3: 7-9	K/V- 8.	Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things , and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ.
Phili-4: 19-20.	K/V- 19.	And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. (1-Tim-6:6-8.)
1-Tim-6: 1-8	K/V- 5.	---useless wrangling of men of corrupt minds and destitute of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain, From such withdraw yourself.
1-Tim-6: 9-10	K/V- 9. K/V- 10.	⁹ But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare , and into many foolish and harmful lust which drown men in destruction and perdition. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil , for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
1-Tim:6 17-19	K/V- 17.	Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God , who gives us richly all things to enjoy.
Titus-1: 5-9	K/V- 7.	For a bishop must be blameless, as a steward of God, not self willed, not quick-tempered, not given to wine, not violent, not greedy for money ,
Titus-1: 10-16	K/V- 11.	---whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole households, teaching things that they ought not, for the sake of dishonest gain.
James-1: 9-11	K/V- 10.	--- but the rich in his humiliation, because as a flower of the field he will pass away.
James-2: 1-8	K/V- 5.	Listen, my beloved brethren: Has God not chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those who love Him?
James-5: 1-5	K/V- 1.	Come now, you rich , weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon you!
1-Jn-2: 15-17	K/V- 15.	Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (Jn-3:16.) (Gal-4:6.) (Jam-4:4.)
Rev-3: 14-18	K/V- 17.	“Because you say, ‘I am Rich, have become wealthy , and have need of nothing’- and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked- (Lk-12:21.)
Rev-13: 11-18	K/V- 16. K/V- 17. K/V- 18.	¹⁶ He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor , free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, ¹⁷ And that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast , or the number of his name. ¹⁸ Here is wisdom, let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number is 666.
Rev-14: 9-11	K/V- 11.	“And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.”
