Matt-3: 7-8.	KV-8.	7. But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come? 8. Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:
Matt-5: 19-22.	KV-20.	20. For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall <u>exceed</u> the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.
Matt-6: 22-24.	KV-24.	24. No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon. (1-Tim-6:6-11.KV-10.)
Matt-7: 13-14.	KV-14.	13. Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide <i>is</i> the gate, and broad <i>is</i> the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14. And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. (MT-17:5) (MK-9:7.) (LK-9:35.)
Matt-8: 5-13.	KV-12.	11. And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven. 12. But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. (Luke-18:8.)

Matt-25: 31-46.	KV-41. KV-45.	41. Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels: 45. Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did <i>it</i> not to one of the least of these, ye did <i>it</i> not to me.

Luke-6: 43-45.	KV-43.	43. For a good tree bringeth not forth corrupt fruit; neither doth a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit. (Matt-15:13.) (Gal-5:19-26.)
Luke-6: 46-49.	KV-46.	46. And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which <u>I say?</u> (Matt-7:24-27.KV-24.) (Jam-1:22.)
Luke-11: 20-26.	KV-23.	23. He that is not with me is against me: and he that gathereth not with me scattereth.
Luke-12: 45-48.	KV-45. KV-46.	45. But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken; 46. The lord of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for <i>him</i>, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.
Luke-13: 6-9.	KV-9.	9. And if it bear fruit, <i>well:</i> and if not, <i>then</i> after that thou shalt cut it down.
Luke-21: 33-36.	KV-36.	36. Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.
John-3: 16-21.	KV-18. KV-19.	18. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

		19. And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. (JN-8:12.)
John-6: 35-40.	KV-36.	36. But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not.
John-6: 63-69.	KV-66.	66. From that <i>time</i> many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him. Comment: His disciples left Him, saved or not?
John-15: 1-10.	KV-6.	6. If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast <i>them</i> into the fire, and they are burned.
Acts-4: 10-12.	KV-12.	10. Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth , whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, <i>even</i> by him doth this man stand here before you whole. 11. This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. 12. Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
Rom-6: 1-7.	KV-1. KV-2.	1. What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin , that grace may abound? 2. God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
Rom-6: 20-23.	KV-23.	23. For the wages of sin <i>is</i> death; but the gift of God <i>is</i> eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.
Rom-11: 16-24.	KV-20. KV-22.	20. Well; because of unbelief they were broken off , and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear: (Heb-4:1-3. KV-2.) 22. Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou <u>continue</u> in <i>his</i> goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off.
Rom-12: 1-2.	KV-2.	1. I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, <i>which is</i> your reasonable service. 2. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what <i>is</i> that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (Jam-4:4.) (1-JN-2:15-17.) (1-JN-5:19.)
1-Cor-1: 17-21.	KV-18.	18. For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.
1-Cor-6: 9-11.	KV-9.	9. Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10. Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. 11. And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye

		are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. (2-Cor-6:17-18.) (Rev-21:8.)
1-Cor-10: 1-11.	KV-9. KV-10. KV-11.	9. Neither let us tempt Christ , as some of them also tempted, and were destroyed of serpents. 10. Neither murmur ye , as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer. 11. Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.
1-Cor-15: 33-34.	KV-33.	33. Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners. 34. Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak <i>this</i> to your shame. (Eph-4:29-30.)
2-Cor-6: 14-18.	KV-14.	14. Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
Eph-4: 17-20.	KV-17.	17. This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, (2-Cor-4:4.)
Phili-2: 9-13.	KV-12.	12. Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.
1-Thes-4: 7-8.	KV-7.	7. For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness. 8. He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit. (1-Peter-1:15-16.)
2-Thes-2: 1-5.	KV-3.	3. Let no man deceive you by any means: for <i>that day shall not come, except there come a <u>falling away first</u>, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;</i>
1-Tim-4: 1-7.	KV-1.	1. Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith , giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; (John-6:66.) (Rev-13:15-18.) (Rev-14:9-11.) (1-Tim-6:10-11.)
Titus-1: 15-16.	KV-15. KV-16.	15. Unto the pure all things <i>are</i> pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving <i>is</i> nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled. 16. They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.
Heb-3: 7-19.	KV-6. KV-11. KV-12. KV-14.	6. But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope <u>firm unto the end.</u> 11. So I swear in my wrath, They shall not enter into my rest.) 12. Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God. 14. For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our <u>confidence stedfast unto the end;</u>

Heb-4: 1-6.	KV-2.	2. For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard <i>it</i> .
Heb-6: 1-8.	KV-8.	8. But that which beareth thorns and briars is rejected , and <i>is</i> nigh unto cursing; whose end <i>is</i> to be burned. (Gen-3:18-19.) (John-15:1-6.)
Titus-1: 15-16.	KV-16.	16. They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.
Heb-10: 25-31.	KV-29.	29. Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?
Heb-12: 5-20.	KV-15.	15. Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled;
2-Pet-1: 1-11.	KV-10.	10. Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:
2-Peter-2: 18-22.	KV-20. KV-22.	20. For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. 22. But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire. (Proverbs-26:11.)
2-Peter-3: 16-18.	KV-17.	17. Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know <i>these things</i> before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness.
1-John-1: 5-9.	KV-6.	6. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: (Rev-21:8.)
1-John-1: 10.	KV-10.	10. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us. (Rom-3:23.)
1-John-2: 15-17.	KV-15.	15. Love not the world , neither the things <i>that are</i> in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the (Father-Jesus) is not in him. 16. For all that <i>is</i> in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. (2-Cor-13:5.) (Gal-4:6.) (1-John-5:19.)
1-John-2: 18-19.	KV-19.	18. Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.

		19. They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would <i>no doubt</i> have continued with us: but <i>they went out</i> , that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.
Rev-2: 1-5.	KV-5.	5. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
Rev-3: 1-6.	KV-5.	5. He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. (Rev-21:7.) <u>Comment: So we see that our name can be blotted out.</u>
Rev-21: 5-8.	KV-7.	7. <u>He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. (John-16:33.) (1-John-5:1-6. KV-5.)</u>
Rev-21: 26-27.	KV-27.	26. And they shall bring the glory and honour of the nations into it. 27. And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither <i>whatsoever</i> worketh abomination, or <i>maketh</i> a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.
Rev-22: 18-19.	KV-18. KV-19.	18. For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: 19. And if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and <i>from</i> the things which are written in this book. (2-Tim- 3:16-17.) 16. All scripture <i>is</i> given by inspiration of God, and <i>is</i> profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17. That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works. <u>2-Pet-1:21.</u> (For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake <i>as they were</i> moved by the Holy Ghost.
