

One main Teacher.

What everyone who calls themselves a Christian needs to do and know, Now that we are getting closer to the end of the age, in other words last days. The Lord Jesus speaks some very straight questions and answers to what He expects from us if we claim to be Christians. I hope that I am able to encourage you to believe Him even more than you do now, hear is scripture to challenge you. Who is your teacher, and who is your master, and are you becoming more like Christ. (John-15:1-10.) (1-John-2:6.)

Matt-10: 24-27	K/V- 24.	"A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his master.
Luke-6: 39-40	K/V- 40.	"A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his teacher.
John-15: 17-20	K/V- 20.	"Remember the word that I said to you, 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

These scriptures tell me that who you are taught by, that is who you can be like, if you are taught by one who truly does not believe Jesus, then you will probably be the same as them. I have met people who say that the power of God stopped with the last apostles, the only problem with that is it is not scriptural. For example have a look at these scriptures. And let us not say that the devil moves in signs and wonders, and God doesn't.

Heb-13: 7-10	K/V- 8.	Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
Luke-1: 50	K/V- 50.	And His mercy is on those who fear Him From generation to generation.
Rev-19: 9-10	K/V- 10.	And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."
Rev-22: 17-21	K/V- 18. 18-19.	For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

Let me ask you these questions, Is Jesus the same today as before or not, is He the same for every generation, is He the spirit of prophecy today, or are you adding or taking away from the scripture. If you are you might ask God who you are in Christ, look at this scripture.

Matt-16: 8-12	K/V- 11.	"How is it you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread? - but to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees."
Matt-16: 8-12	K/V- 12.	Then they understood that He did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the (doctrine) of the Pharisees and Sadducees.

By talking to many Christians of different denominations it is not hard to see who teaches them, many of them do not believe Jesus and His power today,

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Here are more scriptures to think about.

Matt-23: 8-10	K/V- 10.	“And do not be called teachers; for One is your Teacher, the Christ.
Matt-28: 17-20	K/V- 20.	“Teaching them to observe all things that <u>(I)</u> have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen. (<u>John-12:43-50.</u> ^{48.})
Mark-12: 13-17	K/V- 14.	When they had come, they said to Him, “Teacher, we know that You are true, and care about no one; for You do not regard the person of men, but teach the way of God in truth. Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not? (<u>Jer-17:5.</u>) (<u>John-2:25.</u>) (<u>Rom-3:4.</u>) (<u>Rom-3:23.</u>)
John-3: 1-12	K/V- 2.	This man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, “Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher come from God; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him.”
John-6: 44-45	K/V- 45.	“It is written in the prophets, ‘And they shall all be taught by God.’ Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me.
John-10: 1-32	K/V- 27.	“My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. (Acts-4:13.)
John-13: 1-15	K/V- 13.	“You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. (Luke- 6:46.)
John-13: 16-20	K/V- 20.	“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who receives <u>whomever I send</u> receives Me; and he who receives Me receives Him who sent Me.”
Acts-4 8-14	K/V- 13.	Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marvelled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

It has always amazed me when I tell some people that the Holy Spirit talks with me, they look at me very strange. Even when the scriptures tell you that you will hear His voice, and that He is always the same yesterday (today) and forever, brothers and sisters it is an everlasting covenant, (Heb-13:20-21.) I still believe many people are following religious leaders and not Jesus Christ, followers of Jesus believes everything He says not bits and pieces of what He says. Hear is more scripture to show you who your main teacher is.

Luke-12: 11-12	K/V- 12.	“For the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say.”
John-14: 23-31	K/V- 26.	“But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that (I) said to you.
John-16: 13-14	K/V- 13. K/V- 14.	“However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. ^{14.} <u>“He will glorify Me,</u> for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.

So we see that the Holy Spirit will teach us, guide us into all truth which is Jesus. (John-14:6.) And He will tell us thing to come. And He will glorify Jesus. Now we will go further with more scripture that the Lord Jesus gave us. Amen.

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Rom-8: 11-16	K/V- 14.	For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. <u>(John-7:16.) (John-8:28-29.)</u>
1-Cor-2: 10-16	K/V- 13.	These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
Gal-1: 8-12	K/V- 11.	But I make known to you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. <u>(Acts-5:29-32.)</u>
Eph-4: 20-24	K/V- 20. K/V-21.	^{20.} But you have not so learned Christ, ^{21.} If indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus:
1-John-2: 20-29	K/V- 27.	But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you will abide in Him. <u>(Jn-15:5.)</u>

Now we see that the Father, the Son Jesus, and the Holy Spirit, work together as one, and they are the main teachers, so why do we believe so many doctrines when we have the word of God today, I believe that God gives us a free will to decide what we choose to believe, but if we reject Jesus and His words, it is not God's Fault its ours. Hear is more scriptures to think about. This scripture is about the power of God.

Mark-16: 15-20	K/V- 16. K/V- 18.	^{16.} "He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. ^{17.} "And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out (demons-devils;) they will speak with new tongues; ^{18.} They will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."
Acts-1: 4-9	K/V- 8.	But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
Acts-4: 27-33	K/V- 33.	And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all.
Rom-15: 13-17	K/V- 13.	Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
1-Cor-2: 1-5	K/V- 4.	And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, ^{5.} That your faith should not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God. <u>(Jer-17:5.) (1-Cor-6:12.)</u>
1-Cor-4: 19-21	K/V- 20.	For the kingdom of God is not in word but in power. xxxxxx

Ask yourself a question are we allowed to take these scriptures away and teach people that their not for today, you can if you want to but I won't. If you think about it some are saying that Satan has power and Jesus has not, stay away from these people, do you think this is just my opinion, look at this scripture. (2-Thes-2:1-11.^{9.}) But-(Matt-28:18.)

2-Tim-3: 1-7	K/V- 5.	Having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!
2-Cor-13: 5-6	K/V- 5.	Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?- unless indeed you are disqualified.
