

Only believe.

Friends I believe that many of us have been robbed of the simplicity of Jesus Christ, look at this scripture. (2-Cor-11:3.) But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. Watch and pray brothers and sisters. Let us look at the scriptures and return to the simplicity in Jesus Christ.

Mat-8: 5-13	K/V- 13.	Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have <u>believed</u> , so let it be done for you." And his servant was healed that same hour.
Mat- 9: 27-31	K/V- 28.	And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And Jesus said to them, " Do you <u>believe</u> that I am able to do this? " They said to Him, "Yes, Lord."
Mk-5: 25-34	K/V- 34.	And He said to her, " Daughter, <u>your faith</u> has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction."
Mk-5: 21-24 35-43	K/V- 23. K/V- 36.	^{23.} And begged Him earnestly, saying, "My daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed, and she will live. ^{36.} As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, He said to the ruler of the synagogue, " Do not be afraid; <u>only believe.</u> " (Lk-8:50.)
Mk-9: 14-29	K/V- 23.	Jesus said to him, " If you can believe, all things are possible to him who <u>believes.</u> "
Mk-11: 20-26	K/V- 24.	"Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, <u>believe</u> that you receive them, and you will have them. (Mat-7:7.) (Mat-21:22.)
Mk-16: 15-20	K/V- 17. K/V- 18.	" And these signs will follow those who <u>believe</u>: In My name they will cast out (demons-devils ;) they will speak with new tongues; ^{18.} "They will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover." (1-Thes-2:13.)
Jn-1: 9-14	K/V- 12.	But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who <u>believe</u> in His name:
Jn-2: 11-12	K/V- 11.	This beginning of signs Jesus did in Cana of Galilee, and manifested His glory; and His disciples <u>believed</u> in Him. (Jn-14:21.)
Jn-3: 16-21	K/V- 18.	" He who <u>believes</u> in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
Jn-3: 33-36	K/V- 36.	" He who <u>believes</u> in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him." (Acts-17:31.)
Jn-4: 46-54	K/V- 50.	Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your son lives." So the man <u>believed</u> the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he went his way.
Jn-5: 22-27	K/V- 24.	"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and <u>believes</u> in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgement, but has passed from death into life. (Jn-6:63.) (Jn-14:10.)
Jn-6: 28-29.	K/V- 29.	Jesus answered and said to them, " This is the work of God, that you <u>believe</u> in Him whom He sent. " (Jn-3:16.) (Jn-6:47-51. ^{48.})
Jn-6: 64-71	K/V- 69.	" Also we have come to <u>believe</u> and know that You are the Christ, the Son of the living God. "

Only believe.

Jn-7: 37-40	K/V- 38.	“He who <u>believes</u> in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his (Belly- Heart-) will flow rivers of living water.”
Jn-8: 28-32	K/V- 30.	As He spoke these words, many <u>believed</u> Him.
Jn-9: 1-41	K/V- 35.	Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him, “Do you <u>believe</u> in the Son of God?” (Jn-9:38.) (Jn-16:1-3.)
Jn-10: 32-42	K/V- 38.	---“but if I do, though you do not believe Me, <u>believe</u> the works , that you may know and believe that the Father is in Me, and I in Him.”
Jn-11: 25-27	K/V- 26.	“And whoever lives and <u>believes</u> in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?”
Jn-11: 38-50.	K/V- 40.	Jesus said to her, “Did I not say to you that if you would <u>believe</u> you would see the glory of God?”
Jn-12: 33-42	K/V- 36.	“While you have the light, <u>believe</u> in the light , that you may become sons of light.” These things Jesus spoke, and departed, and was hidden from them.
Jn-12: 41-50	K/V- 44.	Then Jesus cried out and said, “He who <u>believes</u> in Me, <u>believes</u> not in Me but in Him who sent Me.
Jn-14: 1-7	K/V- 1.	“Let not your heart be troubled; you <u>believe</u> in God, believe also in Me.
Jn-14: 8-11	K/V- 10.	“Do you <u>believe</u> that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. (Jn-10:30.)
Jn-14: 12-15	K/V- 12.	“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who <u>believes</u> in Me , the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. (Phili-4:13.)
Jn-16: 22-33	K/V- 27.	---“for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have <u>believed</u> that I came forth from God. (Jn-3:16.) (Jn-17:8.) (Deut-18:18-19.)
Jn-17: 20-26.	K/V- 20.	“I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will <u>believe</u> in Me through their word; (Mat-10:32-33.)
Acts-4: 1-4	K/V- 4.	However, many of those who heard the word <u>believed</u> ; and the number of the men came to be about ten thousand.
Acts-8: 26-40	K/V- 37.	Then Philip said, “If you believe with all your heart, you may.” And he answered and said, “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.”
Acts-11: 15-18	K/V- 17.	“If therefore God gave them the same gift as He gave us when we <u>believed</u> on the Lord Jesus Christ , who was I that I could withstand God?”
Acts-13: 36-39	K/V- 39.	---“and by Him everyone who <u>believes</u> is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses. (Gal-2:15-16.)
Acts-15: 5-11	K/V- 11.	“But we <u>believe</u> that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved in the same manner as they.” (Eph-2:8-9.)
Acts 16: 30-35	K/V- 31.	So they said, “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household.”
Rom-1: 16-17	K/V- 16.	For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who <u>believes</u> , for the Jew first and also for the Greek. (Acts-4:10-12.)

Only believe.

Rom-9 25-33	K/V- 33.	As it is written: "Behold, I lay in Zion a stumbling stone and rock of offense, And whoever <u>believes</u> on Him will not be put to shame."
Rom-10 8-16	K/V- 9.	That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and <u>believe</u> in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. (Gal-4:6.)
Eph-1: 1-14	K/V- 13.	In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having <u>believed</u>, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,
Eph-1: 15-23	K/V- 19. K/V- 20.	-- ¹⁹ . And what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who <u>believe</u>, according to the working of His mighty power ²⁰ . Which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places. (1-Cor-2:4-5.) (1-Cor-4:19-21.)
1-Thes-2: 9-20	K/V- 13.	For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men , but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who <u>believe</u>.
2-Thes-2: 13-14	K/V- 13.	But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth, (Jn-6:63.) (Jn-14:6.) (Jn-15:3.)
Heb-4: 1-6	K/V- 3.	For we who have believed do enter that rest, as He has said: "So I swore in My wrath, "They shall not enter My rest,"" although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.
Heb-11: 6	K/V- 6.	But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
Heb-13: 5-8	K/V- 8.	Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.
Mk-1: 15	K/V- 15.	And saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."
2-Cor-6: 14-18	K/V- 15.	And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?
1-Cor-15: 33-34	K/V- 33.	Do not be deceived: "Evil company corrupts good habits."
