Overcome the world.

Brothers and sisters I noticed some things in scripture, and that is that Jesus and His apostles was able to see that people had faith to be healed and that sometimes it had to do with their faith that would heal them. Scripture.

(<u>Matt-9:1-8.</u>) **2.** Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. **When Jesus saw their faith,** He said to the paralytic, "Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you."

(<u>Matt-9:27-30</u>.) **27.** When Jesus departed from there, two blind men followed Him, crying out and saying, "Son of David, have mercy on us!" **28.** And when He had come into the house, the blind men came to Him. And Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to Him, "Yes, Lord." **29. Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith let it be to you." 30.** And their eyes were opened. And Jesus sternly warned them, saying, "See that no one knows it."

(<u>Luke-17:11-19.</u>) **11.** Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. **12.** Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him **ten men who were lepers**, who stood afar off. **13.** And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" **14.** So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed. **15.** And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, **16.** and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan. **17.** So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? **18.** Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" **19.** And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

(<u>Acts-14:8-10.</u>) **8.** And in Lystra a certain man without strength in his feet was sitting, a cripple from his mother's womb, who had never walked. **9.** This man heard Paul speaking. **Paul, observing him intently and seeing that he had faith to be healed, 10.** said with a loud voice, "Stand up straight on your feet!" And he leaped and walked.

(Acts-15:8-9.) **8.** So God, who knows the heart, acknowledged them by giving them the Holy Spirit, just as He did to us, **9.** and made no distinction between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.

(Acts-26:14-18.) **14.** And when we all had fallen to the ground, I heard a voice speaking to me and saying in the Hebrew language, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me? It is hard for you to kick against the goads.' **15.** So I said, 'Who are You, Lord?' And He said, 'I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. **16.** But rise and stand on your feet; for I have appeared to you for this purpose, to make you a minister and a witness both of the things which you have seen and of the things which I will yet reveal to you. **17.** I will deliver you from the Jewish people, as well as from the Gentiles, to whom I now send you, **18. to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'**

(<u>John-16:33.</u>) **33.** These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

(1-John-5:4-5.) 4. For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world--our faith. 5. Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

(Rom-10:17.) 17. So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

(Heb-11:1.) 1. Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
