

# Owe – Borrow - Lend

Deut-15: 3-6	K/V- 3.	Of a foreigner you may require it; but you shall give up your claim to what is owed by your brother,
Matt-18: 24-28	K/V- 28	But that servant went out and found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii; and he laid hands on him and took him by the throat, saying, 'Pay me what you owe!'
Luke-7: 40-50	K/V- 41.	"There was a certain creditor who had two debtors. One owed five hundred denarii, and the other fifty.
Luke-16: 1-13	K/V- 5.	So he called every one of his master's debtors to him, and said to the first, 'How much do you owe my master?'
Rom-13: 5-8	K/V- 8.	Owe no one anything except to love one another, for he who loves another has fulfilled the law.

## Borrow

Exo-22: 14	K/V- 14.	"And if a man borrows anything from his neighbor, and it becomes injured or dies, the owner of it not being with it, he shall surely make it good.
Deut -15: 6	K/V- 6.	For the Lord your God will bless you just as He promised you; you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow; you shall reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over you. ( <u>Deut-28:12.</u> )
2 Kin-4: 3	K/V- 3	Then he said, "Go, borrow vessels from everywhere, from all your neighbors--empty vessels; do not gather just a few.
Nehe-5: 4-6	K/V-4.	There were also those who said, "We have borrowed money for the king's tax on our lands and vineyards.
Ps-37: 21	K/V- 21.	The wicked borrows and does not repay, But the righteous shows mercy and gives.
Prov-22: 7	K/V- 7.	The rich rules over the poor, And the borrower is servant to the lender. ( <u>Isa 24:2</u> )
Matt-5: 42	K/V- 42.	Give to him who asks you, and from him who wants to borrow from you do not turn away.

## Lend

Exo-22: 25	K/V- 25.	"If you lend money to any of My people who are poor among you, you shall not be like a moneylender to him; you shall not charge him interest.
Lev-25: 35-38	K/V- 37.	You shall not lend him your money for usury, nor lend him your food at a profit.
Deut-15: 6-8	K/V- 6.	For the Lord your God will bless you just as He promised you; you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow; you shall reign over many nations, but they shall not reign over you.
Deut-24: 10-13	K/V- 11.	You shall stand outside, and the man to whom you lend shall bring the pledge out to you.
Deut-28: 44	K/V- 44.	He shall lend to you, but you shall not lend to him; he shall be the head, and you shall be the tail.
Luke-6: 34-35	K/V- 35.	But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil.
Luke-11: 5-13	K/V- 5.	And He said to them, "Which of you shall have a friend, and go to him at midnight and say to him, 'Friend, lend me three loaves;
