

Persecution.

Matt-5: 10-12	K/V- 10	Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake , For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. (<u>2-Tim-3:12.</u>) (<u>1-Pet-4:12-14.</u>)
Matt-5: 43-48	K/V- 44.	But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you ,
Matt-10: 22-24	K/V- 23.	When they persecute you in this city, flee to another. For assuredly, I say to you, you will not have gone through the cities of Israel before the Son of Man comes.
Matt-13: 20-21	K/V- 21.	-yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word , immediately he stumbles. (<u>Mk-4:17.</u>)
Matt-23: 31-36	K/V- 34.	Therefore, indeed, I send you prophets, wise men, and scribes: some of them you will kill and crucify, and some of them you will scourge in your synagogues and persecute from city to city , (<u>Luke-11:46-51.</u> ^{49.})
Matt-24: 8-10	K/V- 9. K/V- 10.	^{9.} Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. ^{10.} And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. (<u>Mark-13:13.</u>)
Mark-10: 29-31	K/V- 30.	-“who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time--houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions-- and in the age to come, eternal life.
Luke-6: 22-23	K/V- 22. K/V- 23.	^{22.} Blessed are you when men hate you, And when they exclude you , And revile you, and cast out your name as evil, For the Son of Man's sake. ^{23.} Rejoice in that day and leap for joy! For indeed your reward is great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets.
Luke-6: 26-27	K/V- 26.	Woe to you when all men speak well of you , For so did their fathers to the false prophets. (<u>Gal-1:9-10.</u> ^{10.}) (<u>1-Thes-2:4-5.</u> ^{4.})
Luke-16: 9-13	K/V- 13.	No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon."
Luke-21: 10-13	K/V- 12.	But before all these things, they will lay their hands on you and persecute you , delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons. You will be brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake. (<u>Rev-12:12-17.</u> ^{13.}) (<u>Jn-3:3-5.</u>)
Luke-21: 16-19	K/V- 17.	^{17.} And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. ^{18.} But not a hair of your head shall be lost. ^{19.} By your patience possess your souls. (<u>John-3:17-21.</u> ^{19.})
John-5: 15-18	K/V- 16.	For this reason the Jews persecuted Jesus , and sought to kill Him, because He had done these things on the Sabbath.
John-7: 6-8	K/V- 7.	The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify of it that its works are evil. (<u>James-4:4.</u>) (<u>1-Jn-2:15-17.</u>) (<u>1-Jn-5:19.</u>)
John-12: 23-26	K/V- 25.	^{25.} He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. ^{26.} If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honor.
John-15: 17-25	K/V- 19.	If you were of the world, the world would love its own. Yet because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you.
John-17: 14-17	K/V- 14. K/V- 15.	^{14.} I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. ^{15.} “I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one.

Acts-7: 51-54	K/V-52.	Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who foretold the coming of the Just One, of whom you now have become the betrayers and murderers,
Acts-8: 1-4	K/V- 1.	Now Saul was consenting to his death. At that time a great persecution arose against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles.
Acts-9: 1-7	K/V- 4.	Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?"
Acts-13: 50-52	K/V- 50.	But the Jews stirred up the devout and prominent women and the chief men of the city, raised up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region.
Acts-22: 1-7	K/V- 4.	I persecuted this Way to the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women,
Acts-26: 9-19	K/V-11.	And I punished them often in every synagogue and compelled them to blaspheme; and being exceedingly enraged against them, I persecuted them even to foreign cities.
Rom-8: 33-39	K/V- 35.	Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?
Rom-12: 14-16	K/V- 14.	Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. (<u>Jam-3:8-10.</u> ¹⁰)
1-Cor-4: 10-14	K/V- 12.	And we labor, working with our own hands. Being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we endure;
1-Cor-15: 7-10	K/V- 9.	For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.
2-Cor-4: 7-12	K/V- 9.	persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed--
2-Cor-12: 9-11	K/V- 10.	Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.
Gal-1: 23-24	K/V- 23.	But they were hearing only, " He who formerly persecuted us now preaches the faith which he once tried to destroy. "
Gal-4: 27-31	K/V- 29.	But, as he who was born according to the flesh then persecuted him who was born according to the Spirit, even so it is now.
Gal-5: 7-12	K/V- 11.	And I, brethren, if I still preach circumcision, why do I still suffer persecution? Then the offense of the cross has ceased.
Gal-6: 12-18	K/V- 12.	As many as desire to make a good showing in the flesh, these would compel you to be circumcised, only that they may not suffer persecution for the cross of Christ.
Phili-3: 1-10	K/V- 6.	-concerning zeal, persecuting the church; concerning the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.
1-Thes-2: 13-16	K/V- 15.	who killed both the Lord Jesus and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they do not please God and are contrary to all men,
2-Thes-1: 1-6	K/V- 4.	so that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure,
2-Tim-3: 10-11	K/V- 11.	-Persecutions, afflictions, which happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra-- what persecutions I endured. And out of them all the Lord delivered me.
