Lev-26: 18-20	K/V- 19.	<b>I will break the pride of your power;</b> I will make your heavens like iron and your earth like bronze.
2-Chr-32: 25-26	K/V- 26.	<b>Then Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart,</b> he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the Lord did not come upon them in the days of Hezekiah.
Job-35: 10-13	K/V- 12.	There they cry out, but He does not answer, <b>Because of the pride of evil men.</b>
Job 41: 15-17	K/V- 15.	<b>His rows of scales are his pride,</b> Shut up tightly as with a seal;
Job-41: 32-34	K/V- 34.	He beholds every high thing; <b>He is king over all the children of pride."</b> ( <u>Eph-2:2.</u> )
Psalms-10: 1-4	K/V- 2.	<b>The wicked in his pride persecutes the poor;</b> Let them be caught in the plots which they have devised.
Psalms-36: 11-12	K/V- 11.	<b>Let not the foot of pride come against me,</b> And let not the hand of the wicked drive me away.
Psalms-59: 11-13	K/V- 12.	For the sin of their mouth and the words of their lips, <b>Let them even be taken in their pride,</b> And for the cursing and lying which they speak.
Psalms-73: 5-6	K/V- 6.	<b>Therefore pride serves as their necklace;</b> Violence covers them like a garment.
Prov-8: 13-14	K/V- 13.	The fear of the Lord is to hate evil; <b>Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate.</b>
Prov-11: 1-3	K/V- 2.	<b>When pride comes, then comes shame;</b> But with the humble is wisdom.
Prov-13: 10-11	K/V- 10.	<b>By pride comes nothing but strife,</b> But with the well-advised is wisdom.
Prov-14: 2-3	K/V- 3.	<b>In the mouth of a fool is a rod of pride,</b> But the lips of the wise will preserve them.
Prov-16: 18-19	K/V- 18.	<b>Pride goes before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall.</b>
Prov-21: 23-24	K/V- 24.	<b>A proud and haughty man--"Scoffer" is his name;</b> He acts with arrogant pride.
Prov-29: 22-23	K/V- 23.	<b>A man's pride will bring him low,</b> But the humble in spirit will retain honor.
Isai-16: 6-7	K/V- 6.	<b>We have heard of the pride of Moab--</b> He is very proud-- Of his haughtiness and his pride and his wrath; But his lies shall not be so.
Isa-23: 8-9	K/V- 9.	The Lord of hosts has purposed it, <b>To bring to dishonor the pride of all glory,</b> To bring into contempt all the honorable of the earth.
Isa-25: 11-12	K/V- 11.	And He will spread out His hands in their midst As a swimmer reaches out to swim, <b>And He will bring down their pride Together with the trickery of their hands.</b>
Isa-28: 1-3	K/V- 3.	<b>The crown of pride, the drunkards of Ephraim, Will be trampled underfoot;</b>

Jer-49: 15-16	K/V- 16.	Your fierceness has deceived you, <b>The pride of your heart</b> , O you who dwell in the clefts of the rock, Who hold the height of the hill! Though you make your nest as high as the eagle, I will bring you down from there," says the Lord.
Ezek-7: 9-12	K/V- 10.	'Behold, the day! Behold, it has come! Doom has gone out; The rod has blossomed, <b>Pride has budded.</b>
Ezek-30:	K/V- 6.	"Thus says the Lord: "Those who uphold Egypt shall fall, <b>And the pride of her power shall come down.</b> From Migdol to Syene Those within her shall fall by the sword," Says the Lord God.
Dan-4: 36-37	K/V- 37.	Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, all of whose works are truth, and His ways justice. <b>And those who walk in pride He is able to put down.</b>
Oba-1: 3-4	K/V- 3.	<b>The pride of your heart has deceived you</b> , You who dwell in the clefts of the rock, Whose habitation is high; You who say in your heart, 'Who will bring me down to the ground?'
Zeph-2: 9-11	K/V- 10.	<b>This they shall have for their pride</b> , Because they have reproached and made arrogant threats Against the people of the Lord of hosts.
Zech-9: 6-7	K/V- 6.	"A mixed race shall settle in Ashdod, <b>And I will cut off the pride of the Philistines.</b>
Zech-10: 11-12	K/V- 11.	He shall pass through the sea with affliction, And strike the waves of the sea: All the depths of the River shall dry up. <b>Then the pride of Assyria shall be brought down</b> , And the scepter of Egypt shall depart.
Zech-11: 3-6	K/V- 3.	There is the sound of wailing shepherds! For their glory is in ruins. There is the sound of roaring lions! <b>For the pride of the Jordan is in ruins.</b>
