Rom-13: 12-14.	K/V- 12.	<b>12. The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. 13.</b> Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. <b>14. But put on</b> the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfil its lusts.
Eph- 4: 17-24	K/V- 22.	<b>17.</b> This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, <b>18.</b> having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; <b>19.</b> Who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. <b>20.</b> But you have not so learned Christ, <b>21.</b> If indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: <b>22. That you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, 23.</b> And be renewed in the spirit of your mind, <b>24.</b> and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.
Colo-2: 11-15	K/V- 11.	<b>11. In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, 12.</b> Buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. <b>13.</b> And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, <b>14.</b> having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. <b>15.</b> Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.
Colo-3: 1-10	K/V- 5.	<b>1.</b> If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. <b>2.</b> Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth. <b>3.</b> For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. <b>4.</b> When Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. <b>5. Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. 6.</b> Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience, <b>7.</b> in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them. <b>8.</b> But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth. <b>9.</b> Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, <b>10.</b> and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him,
