Repent: Greek-3340= to think differently or afterwards, reconsider (Mor. Feel compunction):
 repent. 3341= metanoia (for guilt, include. Reformation); by impl. Reversal (of
 (another's) decision):- repentance.

Matt-3: 1-3	K/V- 1. K/V- 2.	1. In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea, 2. -and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" (Mk-1:4.)
Matt-3: 5-10	K/V- 8.	Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance, (Lk-3:8.) (Acts-26:20.)
Matt-3: 11-12	K/V- 11.	I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. (Lk-3:3.) (Eph-5:26.)
Matt-4: 17-20	K/V- 17.	From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." (Mk-1:15.)
Matt-9: 10-13	K/V- 13.	But go and learn what this means: 'I desire mercy and not sacrifice.' For I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance. " (Mk-2:17.) (Lk-5:31-32.) (1-Tim-1:15.)
Matt-11: 20-24	K/V- 20.	Then He began to rebuke the cities which most of his mighty works had been done, because they did not repent.
Mark-1: 14-15	K/V- 15.	-and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."
Mark-6: 10-13	K/V- 12.	So they went out and preached that people should repent.
Luke-10: 10-16	K/V- 13.	"Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes.
Luke-13: 1-5	K/V- 3.	I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish.
Luke-15: 3-7	K/V- 7.	I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.
Luke-16: 19-31	K/V- 30.	And he said, 'No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.'
Luke-17: 1-5	K/V- 3.	Take heed to yourselves. If your brother sins against you, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him.
Luke-24: 46-49	K/V- 47.	-and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. (Acts-4:8-12.)
Acts-2: 38-39	K/V- 38.	Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
Acts-3: 13-21	K/V- 19.	Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord,
Acts-5: 39-32	K/V- 31.	Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.
Acts-8: 18-24	K/V- 22.	Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you.

Acts-17: 26-34	K/V- 30.	Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent,
Acts-20: 20-23	K/V- 21.	^{21.} -testifying to Jews, and also to Greeks, repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. ^{22.} And see, now I go bound in the spirit to Jerusalem, not knowing the things that will happen to me there,
Rom-2: 1-11	K/V- 4.	Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?
2-Cor-7: 9-10	K/V- 9.	Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly manner, that you might suffer loss from us in nothing.
2-Cor-12: 20-21	K/V- 21.	- lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and I shall mourn for many who have sinned before and have not repented of the uncleanness, fornication, and lewdness which they have practiced.
2-Tim-2: 23-26	K/V- 25.	-in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth,
Heb-6: 1-8	K/V- 1.	Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,
Heb-12: 14-20	K/V- 16. K/V- 17.	^{16.} -lest there be any fornicator or profane person like Esau, who for one morsel of food sold his birthright. ^{17.} For you know that afterward, when he wanted to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no place for repentance, though he sought it diligently with tears.
2-Pet-3: 8-9	K/V- 9.	The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
Rev-2: 12-17	K/V- 16.	Repent, or else I will come to you quickly and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth.
Rev-2: 18-29	K/V- 21.	^{20.} Nevertheless I have a few things against you, because you allow that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and seduce My servants to commit sexual immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols. ^{21.} And I gave her time to repent of her sexual immorality, and she did not repent.
Rev-3: 1-6	K/V- 3.	Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.
Rev-3: 14-22	K/V- 19.	As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent.
Rev-9: 15-21	K/V- 21.	And they did not repent of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.
Rev-16: 8-11	K/V- 9.	And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not repent and give Him glory.
