

Rod of Correction & Wrath

Matt-10: 28	K/V- 28.	And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. (<u>Matt-28:18.</u>)
Jn-5: 22-23	K/V- 22.	For the Father judges no one, but has committed all judgment to the Son,
Matt-12: 35-37	K/V. 37.	For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned."
Matt-18: 21-35	K/V. 34.	And his master was angry, and delivered him to the torturers until he should pay all that was due to him.
Luke-12: 43-48	K/V- 47.	And that servant who knew his master's will, and did not prepare himself or do according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes. (<u>Heb-5:8.</u>)
John-3: 36	K/V- 36.	He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."
Rom-1: 18-23	K/V- 18.	For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,
Rom-2: 1-9	K/V- 9.	-tribulation and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek;
Rom-3: 1-6	K/V- 5.	But if our unrighteousness demonstrates the righteousness of God, what shall we say? Is God unjust who inflicts wrath? (I speak as a man.)
Rom-4: 13-17	K/V- 15.	-because the law brings about wrath; for where there is no law there is no transgression. (<u>Rom-7:4-6.</u>) (<u>1-Tim-1:8-10.</u>)
Rom-5: 8-10	K/V- 9.	Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.
Rom-5: 17-20	K/V- 18.	Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life.
1-Cor-4: 18-21	K/V- 21.	What do you want? Shall I come to you <u>with a rod</u>, or in love and a <u>spirit of gentleness</u>?
1-Cor-11: 27-34	K/V- 30. K/V- 31. K/V- 32.	^{30.} For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep. ^{31.} For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged. ^{32.} But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord, that we may not be condemned with the world. (<u>Rev-2:20-23.</u>)
Gal-5: 7-12	K/V- 10.	I have confidence in you, in the Lord, that you will have no other mind; but he who troubles you shall bear his judgment, whoever he is.
Eph-5: 1-7	K/V- 6.	Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.
Colo-3: 1-10	K/V- 6.	Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience,
1-Thes-5: 8-11	K/V- 9.	For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,
2-Thes-1: 1-8	K/V- 6.	-since it is a righteous thing with God to repay with tribulation those who trouble you,
Heb-5: 1-10	K/V- 8.	- though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered.
Heb-10: 26-30	K/V- 27.	-but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries.

Heb-10: 29-31	K/V- 29. K/V- 30. K/V- 31.	²⁹ . Of how much worse punishment , do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? ³⁰ . For we know Him who said, " Vengeance is Mine, I will repay, " says the Lord. And again, " The Lord will judge His people. " ³¹ . It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.
Heb-12: 1-16	K/V- 6.	For whom the Lord loves <u>He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives.</u> "
1-Pet-2: 17-25	K/V- 20.	For what credit is it if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? But when you do good and suffer , if you take it patiently, this is commendable before God.
Rev-2: 20-23	K/V- 22.	Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed , and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds.
Rev-2: 26-29	K/V- 27.	'He shall rule them with a rod of iron; They shall be dashed to pieces like the potter's vessels'-- as I also have received from My Father;
Rev-3: 18-22	K/V- 19.	As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and <u>repent.</u>
