Hosea-2: 11-12	K/V- 11.	I will also cause all her mirth to cease, Her feast days, Her New Moons, Her Sabbaths- All her appointed feasts. (Colo-2:13-17.K/V-16.)¹⁶. So <u>let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or Sabbaths,</u> (Jer-31:31-34.K/V-31.)³¹. "Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah—³². -not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord.
Deut-18: 15-19	K/V- 18.	¹⁸ . I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their brethren, and will put My words in His mouth , and He shall speak to them all that I command Him. ¹⁹ . And it shall be that whoever will not hear My words , which He speaks in My name, I will require it of him. (Matt-17:5.) (Jn-5:42-47.) (Jn-14:8-15. ¹⁰ .) (Acts-3:22-23.)
Jer-31: 31-34	K/V- 31.	"Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah— (Matt-26:28.) (Mk-14:24.) (Lk-22:20.) (1-Cor-11:25.) (Heb-8:7-13. ⁷ .) (Heb-9:15-17.)
Matt-12: 1-8	K/V- 5.	Or have you not read in the law that on the Sabbath the priests in the temple profane the Sabbath, and are blameless? (1-Sam-21:5-6.) (Mk-2:23-28.) (Lk-6:1-5.) (1-Pet-2:9-10.)
Matt-12: 7-8	K/V- 8.	For the Son of Man is Lord even of the Sabbath. " (Lk-6:6-10.)
Matt-12: 9-10	K/V- 10.	And behold, there was a man who had a withered hand. And they asked Him, saying, " Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath? "--that they might accuse Him. (Lk-6:6-10.)
Matt-12: 11-14	K/V- 11.	Then He said to them, "What man is there among you who has one sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will not lay hold of it and lift it out? (Mk-3:1-5.) (Lk-6:9-10.)
Matt-24: 20-22	K/V- 20.	And pray that your flight may not be in winter or on the Sabbath. (Rev-3:15-16.)
Mark-1: 21-22	K/V- 21. K/V- 22.	²¹ . Then they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath He entered the synagogue and taught. ²² . And they were astonished at His teaching, for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.
Mark-1: 21-22	K/V- 22.	And they were astonished at His teaching, for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes. (Mk-6:1-2.)
Mark-1: 23-28	K/V- 23.	Now there was a man in their synagogue with an unclean spirit . And he cried out,
Mark 2: 23-28	K/V- 27.	And He said to them, " The Sabbath was made for man, and not man for the Sabbath.
Mark-6: 1-6	K/V- 2.	And when the Sabbath had come , He began to teach in the synagogue. And many hearing Him were astonished, saying, "Where did this Man get these things? And what wisdom is this which is given to Him, that such mighty works are performed by His hands!
Luke-13: 10-17	K/V- 15.	The Lord then answered him and said, " Hypocrite! Does not each one of you on the Sabbath loose his ox or donkey from the stall, and lead it away to water it?
Luke-14: 1-6	K/V- 3.	And Jesus, answering, spoke to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, " Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath? "
Luke-14: 1-6	K/V- 5.	Then He answered them, saying, " Which of you, having a donkey or an ox that has fallen into a pit, will not immediately pull him out on the Sabbath day? "
Luke-23: 50-56	K/V- 54.	That day was the Preparation, and the Sabbath drew near. (John-19:31.)
John-5: 1-14	K/V- 9.	And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked. And that day was the Sabbath.

John-5: 15-17	K/V- 16.	For this reason the Jews persecuted Jesus, and sought to kill Him, because He had done these things on the Sabbath.
John-5: 18-22	K/V- 18.	Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God. (Phili-2:5-6.) (Rom-8:14.) (Gal-4:5-6.)
John-7: 21-24	K/V- 23.	If a man receives circumcision on the Sabbath , so that the law of Moses should not be broken, are you angry with Me because I made a man completely well on the Sabbath?
John-9: 1-41	K/V- 14.	Now it was a Sabbath when Jesus made the clay and opened his eyes.
Acts-2: 46-47	K/V- 46.	So continuing <u>daily</u> with one accord in the temple , and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, (Acts-5:41-42.)
Acts-13: 14-16	K/V- 14.	But when they departed from Perga, they came to Antioch in Pisidia, and went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day and sat down. (Acts-13:27.) (Acts-15:21.) (Acts-16:13.) (Acts-18:4.)
Rom-14: 1-23	K/V- 5.	One person esteems one day above another; another esteems every day alike. Let each be fully convinced in his own mind. (Gal-4:9-10) (Rom-14:4.)
Colo-2: 13-17	K/V- 16.	So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or Sabbaths,
John-1: 16-17	K/V- 17.	For the law was given through Moses , but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. (John-14:6.) (Acts-4:10-12.) (Eph-2:8-9.)
Acts-13: 38-39	K/V- 39.	-and by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses. (Acts-15:8-12.) (Rom-3:23.) (Rom-3:10-18.) (Gal-3:10-17.)
Acts-15: 24	K/V- 24.	Since we have heard that some who went out from us have troubled you with words, unsettling your souls, saying, "You must be circumcised and keep the law"-- to whom we gave no such commandment- (Lk-5:36-39.)
Rom-7: 1-6	K/V- 4.	Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ , that you may be married to another--to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God. (John-3:3.) (Rom-6:1-5.) (Eph-2:15.)
2-Cor-3: 1-8	K/V- 3.	-clearly you are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written not with ink but by the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of flesh , that is, of the heart.
Gal-2: 11-21	K/V- 16.	-knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified.
Gal-5: 1-5	K/V- 4.	You have become estranged from Christ , you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace.
Gal-5: 12-26	K/V- 18.	But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. (Rom-8:14.) Gal-4:6.)
Col-2: 18-23	K/V- 20.	Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world , why, as though living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations--
Titus-3: 9-11	K/V- 9.	But avoid foolish disputes, genealogies, contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and useless.
Heb-7: 1-28	K/V- 12.	For the priesthood being changed, of necessity there is also a change of the law. (Heb-8:4-13. ⁶) But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises.
James-2: 10-13	K/V- 10.	For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all. (Deut-27:26.)
2-Pet-3: 7-13	K/V- 8.	But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. (Rev-20:4.)
