Matt-10: 32-33	K/V- 32.	"Therefore whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven.
Mark-16: 15-18	K/V- 16.	He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. (Mk-1:15.) (John-6:68.) (Acts-16:30-32.)
Luke 1: 67-69	K/V- 69.	And has raised up a <u>horn of salvation</u> for us In the house of His servant David,
Luke-1: 76-78	K/V- 77.	To give <u>knowledge of salvation</u> to His people By the remission of their sins,
Luke-2: 25-34	K/V- 30.	For my eyes have seen Your salvation
Luke 3: 2-6	K/V- 6.	And all flesh shall see the salvation of God.' <u>“(Acts-4:10-12.)</u>
Luke-19: 9-10	K/V- 9. K/V- 10.	⁹ . And Jesus said to him, "Today <u>salvation</u> has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham; ¹⁰ . -for the Son of Man has come to seek and to <u>save</u> that which was lost."
John-3: 1-8	K/V- 3.	Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."
John 3: 14-17	K-V- 16.	For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
John-4: 21-24	K/V- 22.	You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. (Gal-4:26.) (Rev-3:12.)
John-13: 3-15	K/V- 8.	Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me." (John-15:3.) (Eph-5:26.)
Acts-4: 10-12	K/V- 12.	Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." (Deut-18:18-19.) (Matt-17:5.) (John-14:6.)
Acts-11: 13-16	K/V- 14.	-who will tell you words by which you and all your household will be <u>saved.</u> ' (Acts-16:30-31. ³¹ .)
Acts-13: 24-26	K/V- 26.	Men and brethren, sons of the family of Abraham, and those among you who fear God, to you the word of this <u>salvation</u> has been sent.
Acts-13: 46-47	K/V- 47.	For so the Lord has commanded us: 'I have set you as a light to the Gentiles, That you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth.' <u>“(Mark-16:15.)</u>
Acts-16: 16-18	K/V- 17.	This girl followed Paul and us, and cried out, saying, "These men are the servants of the Most High God, who proclaim to us the way of salvation."
Acts-28: 25-28	K/V- 28.	"Therefore let it be known to you that the salvation of God has been sent to the Gentiles, and they will hear it!" (John-10:27.)
Rom-1: 16-17	K/V- 16.	For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. (Mark-8:38.)
Rom-10: 8-13	K/V- 10.	For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. (Matt-10:32-33.) (1-Cor-1:18-21. ¹⁸ .)
Rom-11: 8-11	K/V- 11.	I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles.
Rom-13: 10-14	K/V- 11.	And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. (1-Peter-4:7-8.)
2-Cor-5: 17-21	K.V. 17	Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. (Matt-26:28.) (John-3:3.) (Rom-7:4-6.)

2-Cor-6: 1-10	K/V- 2.	For He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
2-Cor-7: 9-10	K/V- 10.	For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation , not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.
Eph-1: 11-14	K/V- 13.	In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,
Eph-5: 25-27	K/V- 26.	-that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, (<u>Jn-15:3.</u>)
Eph-6: 13-19	K/V- 17.	And take the helmet of salvation , and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; (<u>1-Cor-2:16.</u>) (<u>1-Thes-5:7-9.⁸</u>)
Phili-1: 27-30	K/V- 28.	-and not in any way terrified by your adversaries, which is to them a proof of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that from God.
Phili-2: 5-13	K/V- 12.	Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling;
2-Thes-2: 13-14	K/V- 13.	But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth, (<u>John-1:17.</u>) (<u>John-14:6.</u>)
2-Tim-2: 8-13	K/V. 10	Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.
2-Tim-3: 14-17	K/V. 15	-and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
Titus-2: 11-15	K/V- 11.	For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, (<u>Lk-2:11.</u>)
Heb-1: 13-14	K/V- 14.	Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?
Heb-2: 1-4	K/V- 3.	-how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation , which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him,
Heb-2: 9-13	K/V- 10.	For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.
Heb-5: 8-10	K/V- 9.	And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,
Heb-9: 27-28	K/V- 28.	-so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.
1-Pet-1: 1-7	K/V- 5.	-who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.
1-Pet-1: 8-12	K/V- 9.	-Receiving the end of your faith-- the salvation of your souls.
1-Jn-5: 10-13	K/V- 11.	And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.
Rev-7: 10	K/V- 10.	-and crying out with a loud voice, saying, " Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb! "
Rev-19: 1	K/V- 1.	After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God!
